




Hardware and Legs are located in dust cover zipper compartment underneath the lounge.



PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION


Before you start:

- 1.Choose a clean, level and spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2.Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as close as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children
- 6.Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads



STEP 1: Turn over onto blanket or carpet to ensure no damage to item. Attach Metal Leg (A) to sofa base using bolt(B) and washers(D) turning clockwise until 90% tightened by hand. Use Allen Key (C) to tighten securely. Place washer (E) and plastic leg (F) in the centre hole and rotate until secure.



STEP 2: Lift the backrest of the sofa upwards and place cushions in front of the backrest.



STEP 3:Assembly complete



IMPORTANT: PLEASE ENSURE FEET ARE TIGHTENED SECURELY BEFORE USE! WARNING – Do not drag lounge on any surface due to timber base, must be lifted.

Fabric Care and Maintenance



REGULAR CARE:

- · Protect from direct sunlight
- Vacuum regularly using low suction
- Rotate reversible cushions regularly

CLEANING:

- Do not remove cushion covers for separate cleaning even though they may have zippers
- · Do not wash, Do not dry clean, Do not shampoo clean
- Clean with hot water extraction machine. Professional cleaning recommended
- Do not use dishwashing liquid or laundry detergent
- · Use only upholstery detergents
- Do not wet filling
- · Dry in shade away from direct heat and sunlight
- · Allow to dry thoroughly before re-use

SPOT CLEANING:

- Do not rub
- · Do not spot clean with any solvent
- Treat spills and stains as soon as possible
- Gently scrape off any soil or mop any liquid from the surface of the fabric
- Apply proprietary cleaning agents strictly according to instructions to remove the residue of the spill
- · Do not saturate the fabric or interior with water or other cleaning liquids

WARNING:

Apply only water-based soil resist (fabric protection) treatments. Do not use aerosol products

Pilling is a natural occurrence in woven fabrics and is not a product fault. You can maintain your

sofa by the use of a battery operated de-pilling machine as the need arises.
