


PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:


- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product

- 10. Please keep the instructions for future reference.






1	Back	5	Gas lift

4	Mechanism	8	Caster




STEP 1: Insert caster 8 into base 7.




STEP2: Put gas lift 5 into base 7, and then put three cups of 6 in gas lift 5.




STEP 3: Connect armrest 2 to back 1 and twist in screws B and C with inner hexagon wrench G.




STEP 4: Connect mechanism 4 to seat 3 and twist screw A with an inner hexagon wrench G.



STEP 5: Connect armrest 2 to seat 3 and twist in screws C, D and gasket F with inner hexagon wrench G. Finally tighten all the screws.



STEP 6: Press the rubber plug E into the armrest.



STEP 7: Place the mechanism 4 on gas lift 5.



Complete the assembly.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

REGULAR CARE:

Protect from direct sunlight Vacuum regularly using low suction

CLEANING:

Do not wash, Do not dry clean, Do not shampoo clean Clean only with hot water extraction machine. Professional cleaning recommended

Do not use dishwashing liquid or laundry detergent. Use only upholstery detergents

Do not wet filling

Dry in shade away from direct heat and sunlight Allow to dry thoroughly before re-use

SPOT CLEANING:

Do not rub

Do not spot clean with any solvent

Treat spills and stains as soon as possible

Gently scrape off any soil or blot any liquid from the surface of the fabric before applying cleaner

Apply proprietary cleaning agents strictly according to instructions to remove the residue of the spill

Do not saturate the fabric or interior with water or other cleaning liquids
