






PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION


Before you start:


- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product.
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use.
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly.
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads.











Step 1:




- Attach leg(2) to table frame (1) using bolt (A) with washer (B).
- Tighten with hexagon key (C).




Step 2:




- Attach fixed ring(3) to leg (2) using bolt (A) with washer (B).
- Tighten with hexagon key (C).




Step 3:



- Turn over the table frame.
- Place glass (5) on top of table.
- Glass is secured on table with suckers.

Care and maintenance



Cushions

Glass

- If the glass is chipped or broken, stop using the product and consult place of purchase.
- Do not drop, drag or strike glass.
- Do not sit or stand upon the glass surface.
- Do not place very hot or cold items on the glass surface unless adequately thick table mats are used to prevent such items coming in contact with the glass.
- Do not place heavy objects on glass .
- Avoid scratching the glass or using as a chopping surface.
- Do not strike the glass with hard or pointed items.
- When cleaning the glass panels use a damp cloth with washing up liquid or soft soap if necessary. Do not use washing powders or any other substances containing abrasives since these may scratch the glass.






1 Seat panel		1	2	Side	2
3 Connecting rod	—	2			




Step 1:




- Attach side(2) to seat panel (1) using bolt (A) with washer (C).
- Tighten with hexagon key (D).




Step 2:



- Attach connecting rod(3) to side (2) using bolt (B) with washer (C).
- Tighten with hexagon key (D).
