## PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

STEP 1:Insert castor (8) to base (7).


STEP 2: Put gas lift (5) into base (7) as instruction shown, then put gas lift cover (6) on gas lift (5).


STEP 3:Connect the armrest 2 to seat 3 and back 1, and use allen wrench $D$ to turn into screw $C$.

Donn't tighten


STEP 4: Connect mechanism 4 to seat 3, twist screws A and $B$ with allen wrench $D$, and finally tighten all screws.


STEP 5: Place mechanism 4 on gas lift 5.


STEP 6:Complete the assembly.

## REGULAR CARE:

Protect from direct sunlight
Vacuum regularly using low suction

## CLEANING:

Clean only with hot water extraction machine. Professional cleaning recommended
Do not use dishwashing liquid or laundry detergent. Use only upholstery detergents
Do not wet filling
Dry in shade away from direct heat and sunlight
Allow to dry thoroughly before re-use
SPOT CLEANING:
Do not rub
Do not spot clean with any solvent
Treat spills and stains as soon as possible
Gently scrape off any soil or blot any liquid from the surface of the fabric before applying cleaner
Apply proprietary cleaning agents strictly according to instructions to remove the residue of the spill
Do not saturate the fabric or interior with water or other cleaning liquids
