## PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

## Before you start:

1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads

STEP 1: Attach leg frames (9) onto the headboad (1) using the bolts (C), tighten it up by using an allen key (E).


STEP 2: Attach crossbar (8) onto the leg frame (9) using the bolts (C), tighten it up by using an allen key (E). Later, attach adhesive felt pad (G) onto the legs.


STEP 3: Attach side rails (3) onto leg frames (9) and footboard (2) using the bolts (B), tighten it up by using an allen key (E).

STEP 4: Attach support legs (5) onto support slats (4) and slats (6) using the bolts (A), tighten it up by using an allen key (E).


STEP 5: Use two people to place $\mathbf{H}$ frame onto side rails (3).
Attach H frame onto side rails (3) using the bolt (C), tighten it up by using an allen key (E).


STEP 6: Once the bed is positioned and the support legs are adjusted to touch floor, the slats can then be laid down and secured before putting on the mattress.

Attach middle slats (7) onto side rails (3) using the screws (D), tighten it up by using an screwdriver.

## IMPORTANT NOTE:

DO NOT push or pull the bed if there is a need for re-positioning as this may result in broken support legs for the centre rail.

## WARNING:

Always unplug from electric outlet before cleaning.
Unplug and remove power cord from wall when not in use and store out of reach of children.

## Congratulations! You have just purchased a quality product from Amart furniture. <br> Please read on for important information regarding your purchase...

A multi-step finish is applied to all our furniture, but all wood comes from nature. Because of this, there will be natural variations in surface texture and grain like knots, mineral streaks and sap runs that may affect the finish.

These differences in character are not defects, but distinctions that make each piece of furniture unique.

Our furniture is built to last. Following these steps, basic care should protect your investment for years to come.

- Dust frequently with a clean damp lint-free cloth. This will help remove abrasive build up which can damage a finish over time.
- Do not place hot objects on any furniture surface. Always use a suitable placemat. Laminate and lacquer finishes on table tops provide added scratch and heat resistance to our furniture, but they can still be damaged without proper care.
- Avoid exposing your furniture to strong sunlight, heat, open windows or dampness. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can fade the finish of your furniture, and sudden extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause cracking or splitting.
- Do not expose your furniture to any liquids. Never allow water to sit on your furniture. Alcohol, nail polish and perfume are also dangerous as they will dissolve the lacquer finish on contact and may require professional repairs.
- Do not allow plastic to come in direct contact with your furniture. Chemicals in the plastic of placemats etc may soften and mark the finish if left in contact with the furniture for a period of time.
