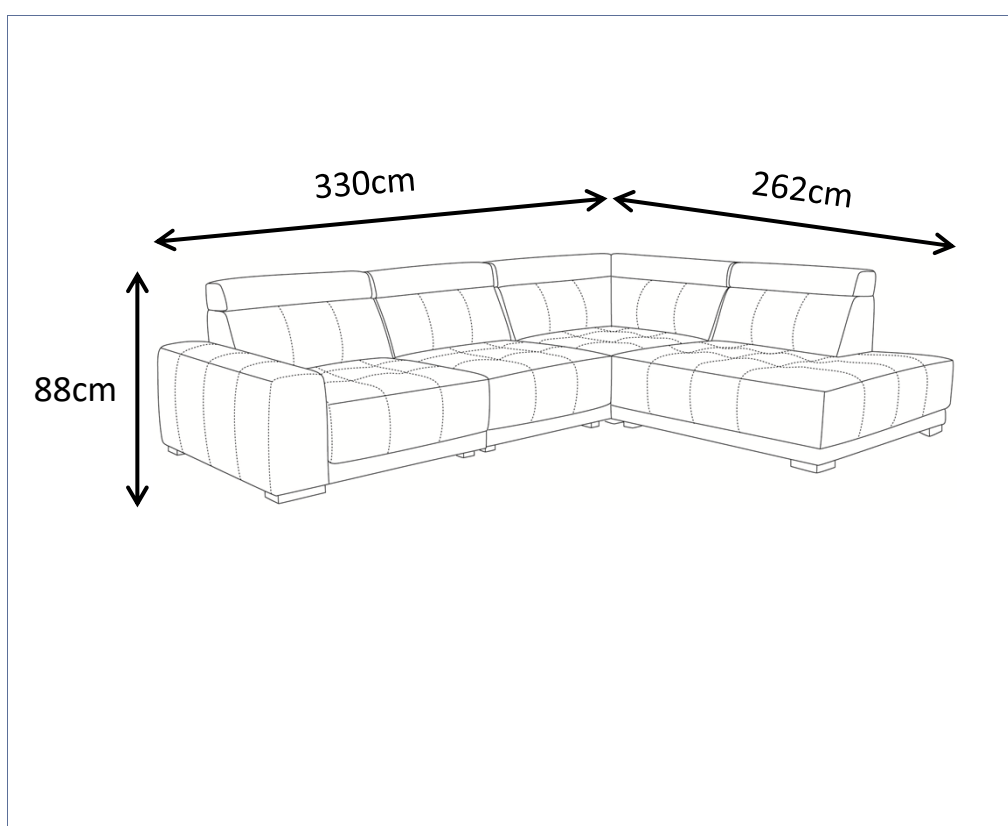

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PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:

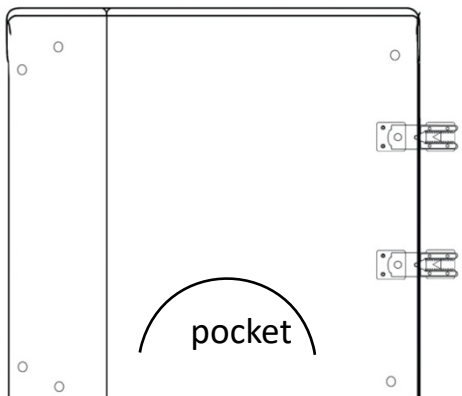
1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads










WARNING

- KEEP ALL BODY PARTS CLEAR FROM UNDER THE MOVING BACKREST MECHANISM TO AVOID INJURY.

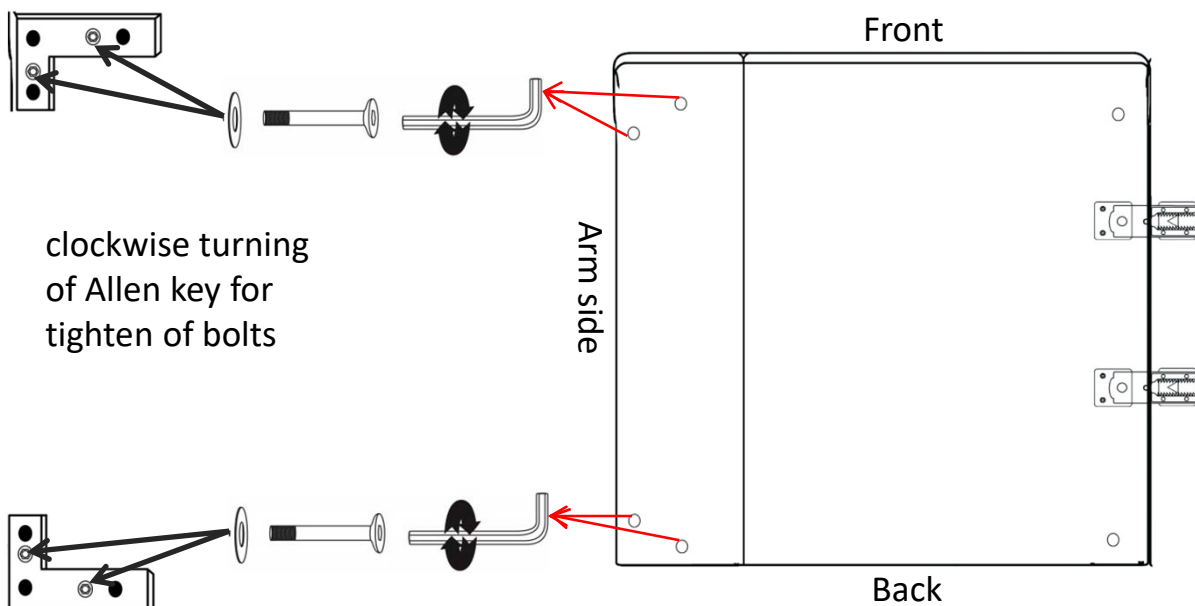
Step1: Locate package of sofa legs with fittings and hardware for assembly of adjustable backrest that are placed into zipper pocket at the bottom of left hand facing chair.



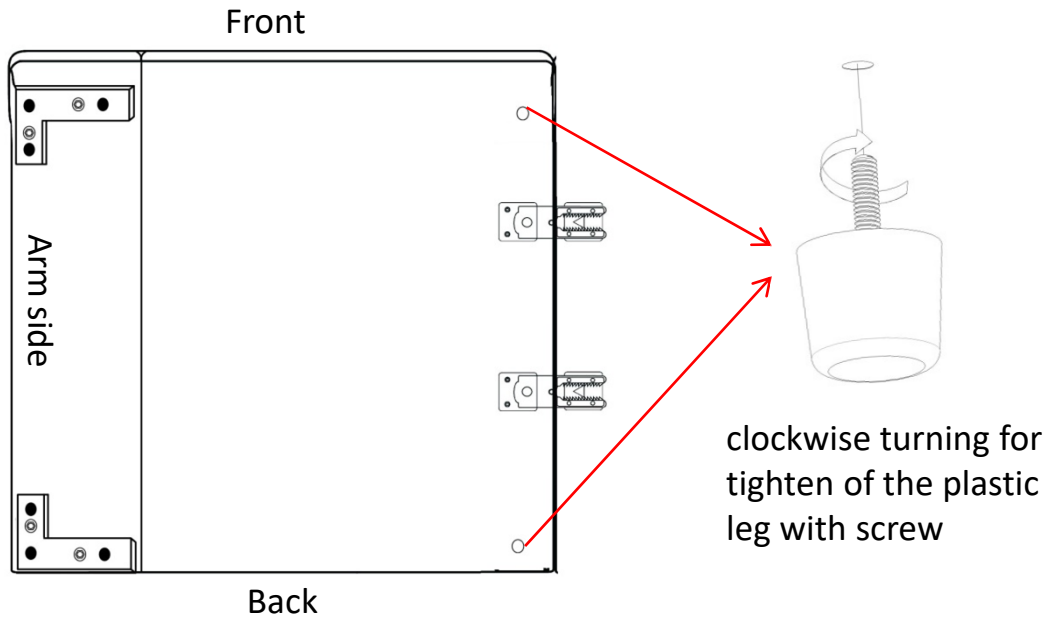
 With 2 people carefully turn onto back on piece of cardboard or carpet to protect covering

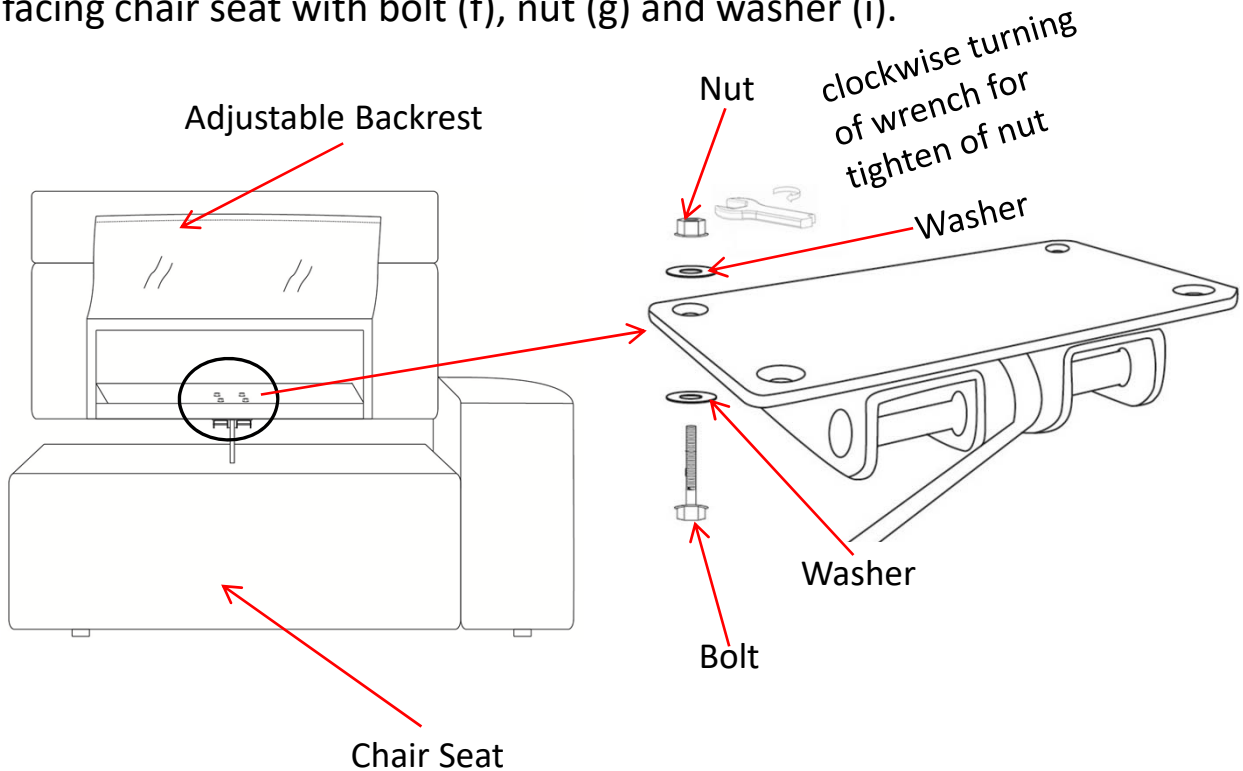
STEP2: Tighten the pair of timber leg (a) to the bottom of left hand facing chair at arm side with bolt (c) and washer (d) by Allen key (e).



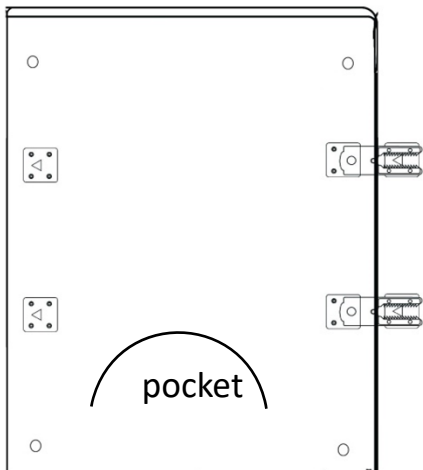
STEP3: Screw two plastic legs (b) into holes at bottom of armless side of the left hand facing chair.








STEP4: Use wrench (h) to fix the adjustable backrest at the left hand facing chair seat with bolt (f), nut (g) and washer (i).



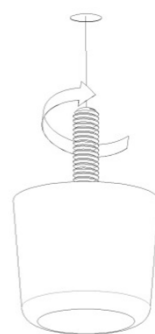
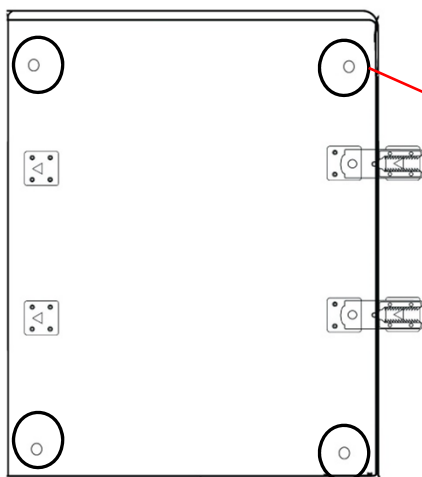
Step5: Locate package of sofa legs and hardware for assembly of adjustable backrest that are placed into zipper pocket at the bottom of armless chair.



 With 2 people carefully turn onto back on piece of cardboard or carpet to protect covering

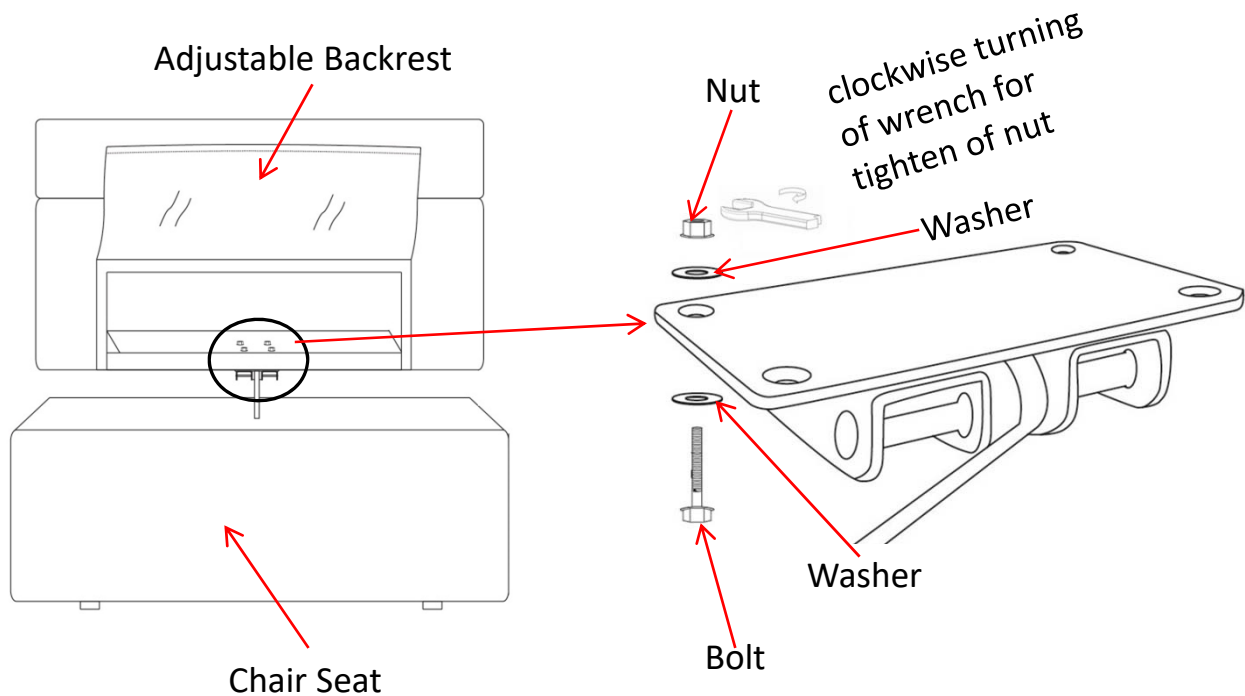

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STEP6: Screw four plastic legs (b) into holes at bottom of the armless chair.

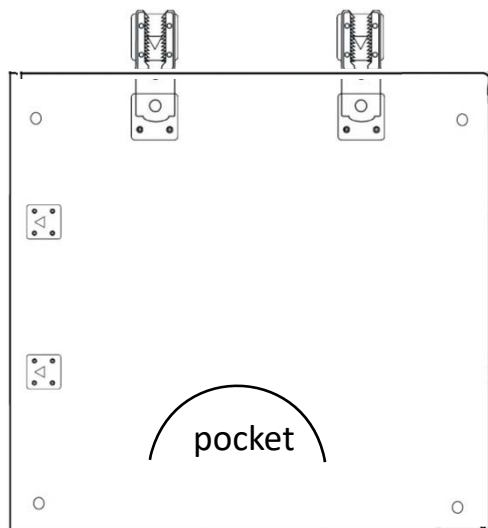



clockwise turning for tighten of the plastic leg with screw





Step7: Use wrench (h) to fix the adjustable backrest at the armless chair seat with bolt (f), nut (g) and washer (i).



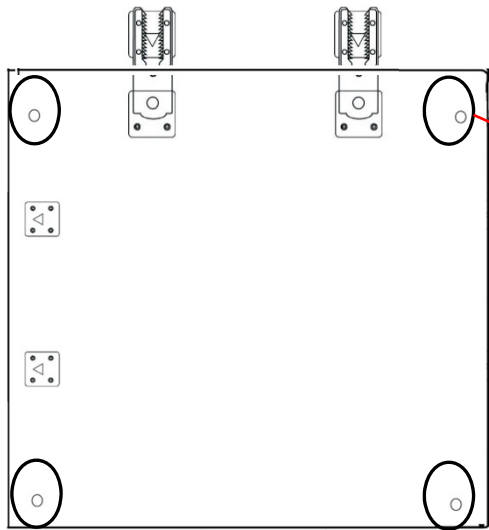
STEP8: Locate package of sofa legs and hardware for assembly of backrest that are placed into zipper pocket at the bottom of wedge piece.



 With 2 people carefully turn onto back on piece of cardboard or carpet to protect covering

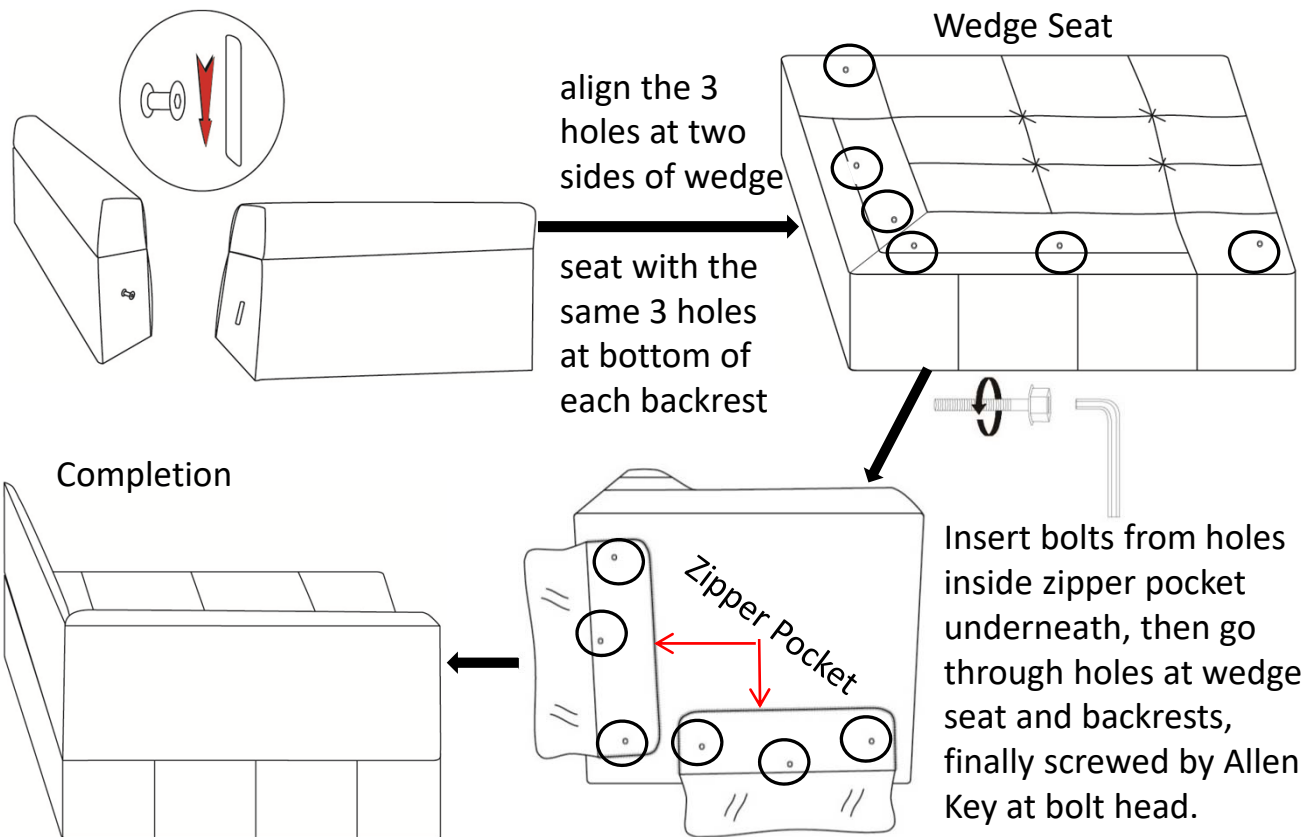

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Step9: Screw four plastic legs (b) into holes at bottom of the wedge piece.

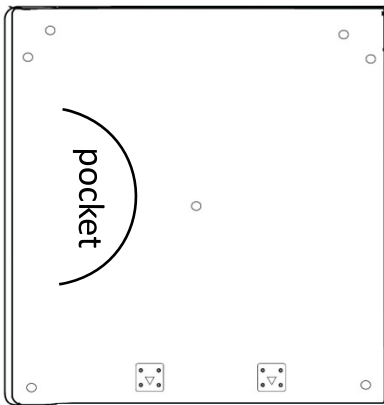









STEP10: Connect the two backrests of the wedge piece by slotting, then fix them at the wedge piece seat with bolt (c) and washer (d) by Allen key (e).



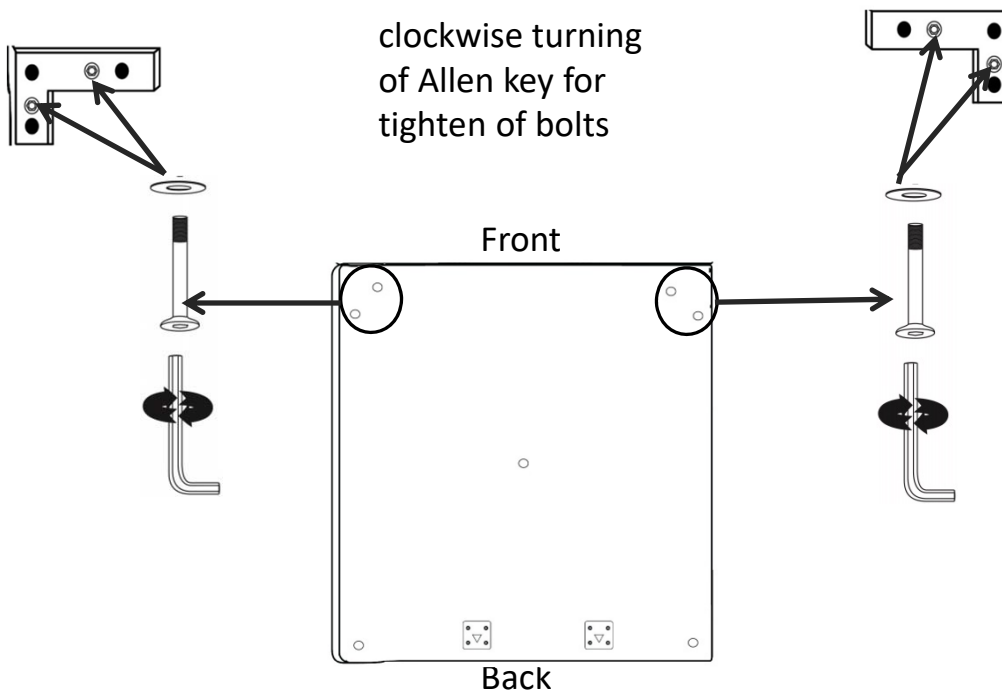
Step11: Locate package of sofa legs with fittings and hardware for assembly of adjustable backrest that are placed into zipper pocket at the bottom of right hand facing end chair.



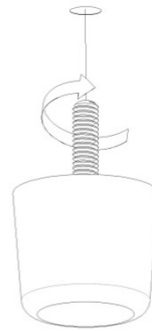
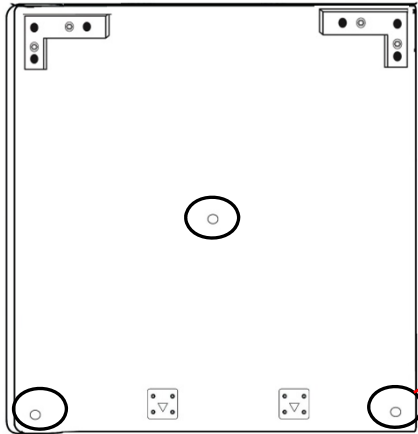
 With 2 people carefully turn onto back on piece of cardboard or carpet to protect covering

a. Timber leg  2pcs	b. Plastic leg  3pcs	c. Bolt M8X60  4pcs	d. Washer 18*8.5*2mm  4pcs
e. Allen key  1pcs	f. Bolt M8X40  4pcs	g. Nut  4pcs	i. Washer 25*8.5*2mm  8pcs

STEP12: Tighten the pair of timber leg (a) to the bottom of right hand facing end chair at front with bolt (c) and washer (d) by Allen key (e).

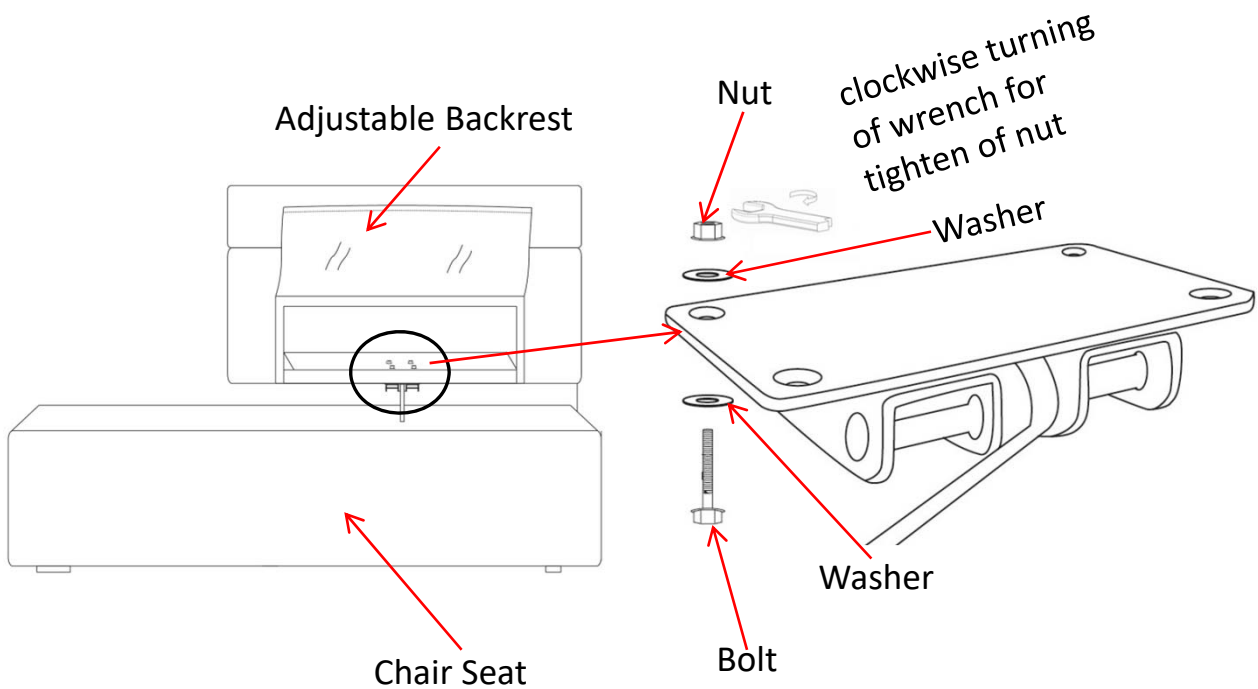


STEP13: Screw three plastic legs (b) into holes at the bottom of right hand facing end chair.

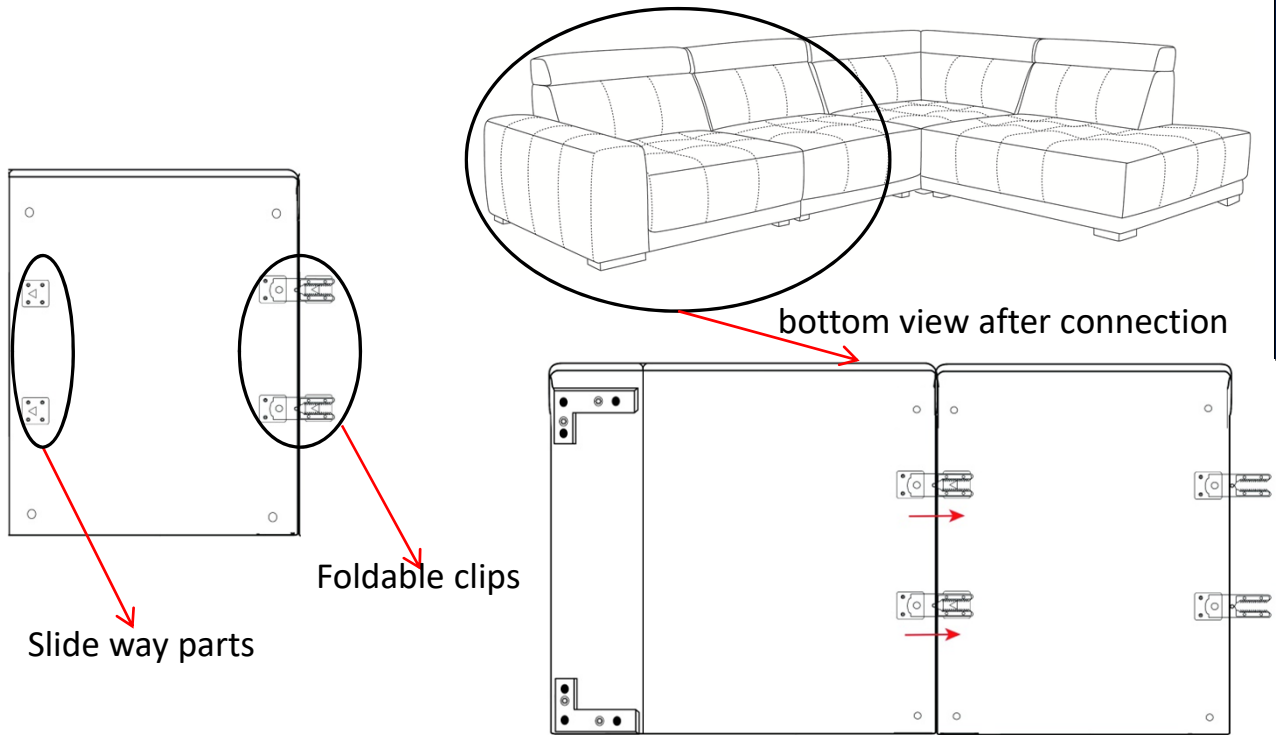

STEP14: Use wrench (h) to fix the adjustable backrest at the right hand facing end chair seat with bolt (f), nut (g) and washer (i).

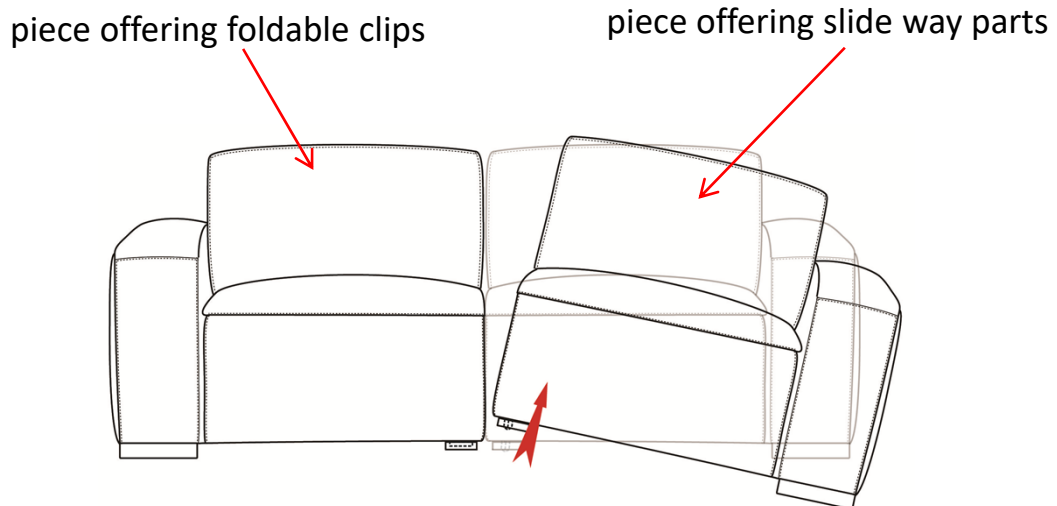


STEP15: Connect 4 pieces of the corner chaise by sliding foldable clips into slide way parts at the bottom of every piece.



To Separate Two Lounge Pieces

Use two people to lift the lounge and move clear of the connection clips.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

FABRIC CARE

REGULAR CARE: PROTECT FROM DIRECT SUNLIGHT.
VACUUM REGULARLY USING LOW SUCTION.
ROTATE REVERSIBLE CUSHIONS REGULARLY.

CLEANING:

DO NOT REMOVE CUSHION COVERS FOR SEPARATE
CLEANING EVEN THOUGH THEY HAVE ZIPPERS.
