

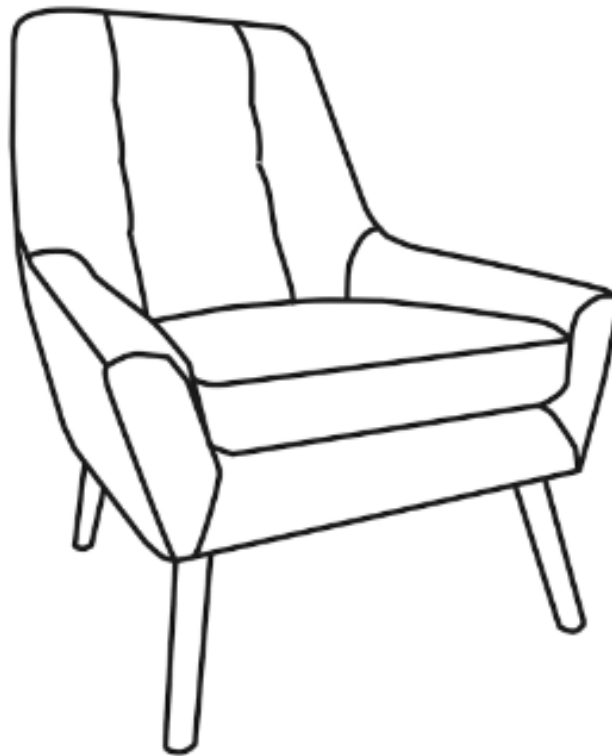

PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:

1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

PRODUCT CARE:

Protect from direct sunlight, direct heat and weather.

All covers will fade over time.

Do not remove covers for cleaning.

Vacuum regularly using low suction.

Professional cleaning recommended.

Blot food and liquid spills immediately with a dry, white, clean cloth. Do not rub.

If required for further cleaning, use a mild non-coloured pure soap solution made from soap flakes mixed with warm water.

Dry in shade away from direct heat and sunlight.

Allow to dry thoroughly.

CHAIRS AND STOOLS

•Do not:

- Use chair/stool as a ladder
- Climb on the chair/stool
- Stand on the foot-rest of the chair, as this could lead to the stool becoming unbalanced and overturning
