
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PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION





Before you start:

1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product.
2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use.
3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly.
4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads.






EXPLODED VIEW




CAM LOCK INSTALLATION





Step 1: E1 is the slide of drawer. E2 is the slide of panel. Below is a sketch of E1 with E2.





Step 2: Use screw C to lock the slides E1 with panel 3 & 4 .





Step 3: Use A Cam-bolt and Cam-lock to lock panel 2 with panel 5.




Step 4: Put the wood dowel F into the related holes. Then use cam-bolt and cam-lock A to lock panels 2&3&4&5&6 together.




Step 5: Put wood dowel F into the related holes. Use cam-bolt and cam-lock A to lock panel 1 with panel 3&4 together.





Step 6: Use Bolt B to lock left and right frames with panel 1.




Step 7: Use screw D to lock panels 8 & 9 & 10. Then slide the panel 11 along with the track.




Step 8: Use cam-bolt and cam-lock A to lock panel 7 with panel 8 & 9 as shown.



Step 9: Use screw C to lock slide E2 with panels 8 & 9 as shown.
Use Bolt G to lock the handles with drawer.



Step 10: Put the drawers along with slides.

SAFETY BRACKETS INSTRUCTIONS

This furniture poses a tipping risk and as such must be secured to a wall using the provided tipping kit.

1. Attach one Mounting Plate to the wall with the Large Screws. Make sure to attach the Mounting Plate into a stud. If mounting into brick or masonry you will need to acquire wall anchors. Please enquire with your local hardware supplier for appropriate fixings.
2. Attach the second Mounting Plate to the furniture frame with the Short Screws.
3. Move the furniture to its final position. Thread a Wall Strap through the both Mounting Plates and tighten until snug. Do not over tighten.
4. Make sure that the Mounting Plates are firmly attached to the wall and furniture and that the Wall Strap is snug.



CARE AND MAINTENANCE

As our timber is supplied from sustainable forests there will be natural variations in surface texture and grain like knots, mineral streaks and sap runs that may affect the finish. These differences in character are not defects, but distinctions that make each piece of furniture unique

Our furniture is built to last. Following these steps for basic care should protect your investment for years to come

Dust frequently with a clean damp lint-free cloth. This will help remove abrasive build up which can damage a finish over time

Do not place hot objects on any furniture surface. Always use a hot plate or placemat. Laminate and lacquer finishes on table tops provide added scratch and heat resistance to our furniture, but they can still be damaged without proper care

Avoid exposing your furniture to strong sunlight, heat outlet, open windows or dampness. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can fade the finish of your furniture, while extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause cracking or splitting

Do not expose your furniture to any liquids. Never allow water to sit on your furniture. Alcohol, nail polish and perfume are also dangerous as they will dissolve the lacquer finish on contact and may require professional repairs

Do not allow plastic to come in direct contact with your furniture. Chemicals in the plastic of placemats etc. may soften and mark the finish if left in contact with the furniture for a period of time
