



PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:

- Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads
- 7. Do not use a knife when opening
- 8. Read carefully all electricial safety usage warning
- 9. Please battery back up advice is followed



WARNING

Do Not allow children to play on this mechanised furniture or operate the mechanism. Leg rest folds down on closing so that a child could possibly be injured. Always leave in an upright and closed position. Keep hands and feet clear of mechanism. Only the occupant should operate it.




You may need a screwdriver to remove back of recliner 4 Part is transformer and battery back up (batteries not included) in case of power outage

Caution! Do not allow children to play on motion furniture or operate the mechanisms, Serious injury or death may result. Leg rest folds down upon closing potentially causing crushing, pinching or severing of limbs, The furniture may be unstable in its extended position. If unattended always leave in an upright and closed position. Only adults should operate this mechanism. Always keep hands and feet clear of the mechanism.

STEP 1: Attach back ①to seat ② by placing bracket B into sleeve A and press down firmly to lock retailing clip into place. listen for the clip to pop into place securely.




STEP 2: Connect wire



Warning – Place transformer with battery back up well away from mechanism base.

STEP 3: The function display after power on is shown in the following figure.










Back-up Power Option: This electric lift chair has been equipped with a Safety Battery Back-up Option. This battery back-up function is important to use when the electricity supply stops (power outage). Please ensure you place 2 X 9 volt batteries into the transformer piece during assembly.

The battery back-up will deliver enough power to return the lift chair back to the beginning position – please note that the batteries will only provide enough power for ONE MOTION back to the original position and is not for continued use. This is to ensure you are able to get out of chair safely in the event of a power outage.

Please ensure to replace the batteries after each power outage event and use with the battery motion.





Safety Note: Transformer and cables are not to be placed under or within the recliner structure.

READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE USE:

DANGER: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF ELECTRIC SHOCK:
Always unplug from electric outlet before cleaning.

Always place transformer well away from recliner mechanism base.

BACK ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS RECLINER/MOTION UPHOLSTERY


CAUTION:PLEASE READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING THE ASSEMBLYPROCESS

IT IS RECOMMENDED TO USET WO PEOPLE WHEN ASSEMBLING AND REMOVING THE INSIDE BACKS TO AND FROM THE BASE OF THE FURNITURE

STEP1: Slide inside back receivers into the steel mechanism posts in the base of the furniture(Figure A).

STEP2: Press both sides of the inside back firmly into place The inside back automatically locks in place

STEP3: To remove the inside backs, use a screwdriver pressing outward on the black tab in the metal sleeve (Figure B) on both sides of the inside back and lift the inside back from the base of the furniture.

FABRIC CARE AND MAINTENANCE



REGULAR CARE:

- · Protect from direct sunlight.
- · Vacuum regularly using low suction.
- Rotate reversible cushions regularly.

CLEANING:

- Do not remove cushion covers for separate cleaning even though they may have zippers.
- Do not wash, Do not dry clean, Do not shampoo clean.
- Clean only with hot water extraction machine. Professional cleaning recommended.
- Do not use dishwashing liquid or laundry detergent.
- Use only upholstery detergents.
- Do not wet filling.
- Dry in shade away from direct heat and sunlight.
- Allow to dry thoroughly before re-use.

SPOT CLEANING:

- Do not rub.
- Do not spot clean with any solvent.
- Treat spills and stains as soon as possible.
- Gently scrape off any soil or blot any liquid from the surface of the fabric before applying cleaner.
- Apply proprietary cleaning agents strictly according to instructions to remove the residue of the spill.
- Do not saturate the fabric or interior with water or other cleaning liquids.

WARNING:

Apply only water-based soil resist (fabric protection) treatments. Do not use aerosol products

- * PILLING IS NOT A FABRIC DEFECT OR FAULT AND IS NOT COVERED BY WARRANTY.
- *PILLING IS A NORMAL OCCURRENCE IN WOVEN FABRICS AND DOES NOT AFFECT THE DURABILITY OR FUNCTIONALITY OF THE FABRIC. IT IS EASILY REMOVED BY USE OF A BATTERY OPERATED DE-PILLING MACHINE AS THE NEED ARISES.
