




### PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

#### **BEFORE YOU START:**


- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads






Step 1: Insert Dowel (D) into Headboard (1) and Stretcher (2) to help align position of the Headboard (1) and Stretcher (2) on Posts (8). And then, using bolt (A), Spring washer (B), Flat washer (C) attach Posts (8) to Headboard (1) and Stretcher (2) using Allen key (E) to tighten.





Step 2: Insert Dowel (D) into Footboard (3) to help align position of the Footboard on Posts (9). And then, using bolt (A), Spring washer (B), Flat washer (C) attach Posts (9) to Footboard (3) using Allen key (E) to tighten.






Step 3: Fasten the side rails (4) to the Headboard (1) and Footboard (3). Using Bolt (F), Spring washer (G) and Flat washer (H). Tighten with Allen key (E).





Step 4: Insert Dowel (D) into Support Leg (6). Using Bolts (A) attach the support legs (6) to the center support Rail (5). Tighten with Allen key (E). (E) 6 5 D. DOWEL A. BOLTS E. ALLEN M6x50: 3PCS Ø8x30: 6PCS M4: 1PC


Step 5: Using screw (I), attach the slats (7) to the side rails (4). A screw is to be placed on each side of the slat, securing each slat to the side rail. The first, middle and end slat attach to the center support rail (5) using screw (I).




I. FLAT HEAD SCREW

Step 6: Place the long canopy rails (11) at top of posts between headboard and footboard first. And then, place the short canopy rails (10) upper to the long canopy rails at both ends (half-lap joints). Using Bolt (A), Spring washer (B), Flat washer (C) and tighten with Allen key (E).

### **Product Care:**

As you timber is supplied from sustainable forests there will be natural variations in surface texture and grain like knots, mineral streaks and sap runs that may affect the finish. These differences in character are not defects, but distinctions that make each piece of furniture unique. Our furniture is built to last. Following these steps for basic care should protect your investment for years to come.

- <u>Dust frequently with a clean damp lint-free cloth</u>. This will help remove abrasive build up which can damage a finish over time.
- <u>Do not place hot obiects on any furniture surface</u>. Always use a hot plate or placemat. Laminate and lacquer finishes on table tops provide added scratch and heat resistance to our furniture, but they can still be damaged without proper care.
- Avoid exposing your furniture to strong sunlight, heat outlet, open windows or dampness. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can fade the finish of your furniture, while extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause cracking or splitting.
- <u>Do not expose your furniture to any liquids</u>. Never allow water to sit on your furniture. Alcohol, nail polish and perfume are also dangerous as they will dissolve the lacquer finish on contact and may require professional repairs.
- <u>Do not allow plastic to come in direct contact with your furniture</u>. Chemicals in the plastic of placemats etc may soften and mark the finish if left in contact with the furniture for a period of time.
