




PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:

- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use

- 10. Please keep the instructions for future reference.







SAFETY BRACKETS INSTRUCTIONS

This furniture poses a tipping risk and as such must be secured to a wall using the provided tipping kit.

- 1. Attach one Mounting Plate to the wall with the Large Screws. Make sure to attach the Mounting Plate into a stud. If mounting into brick or masonry you will need to acquire wall anchors. Please enquire with your local hardware supplier for appropriate fixings.
- 2. Attach the second Mounting Plate to the furniture frame with the Short Screws.
- 3. Move the furniture to its final position. Thread a Wall Strap through the both Mounting Plates and tighten until snug. Do not over tighten.
- 4. Make sure that the Mounting Plates are firmly attached to the wall and furniture and that the Wall Strap is snug.








STEP 1:

1. Insert parts A and B into panel 6 and 7.




STEP 2:

1. Attach panels 14 and 15 to panels 6 and 7 with parts A and B.




STEP 3:


- 1. Slide panel 17 along slots of panels 6 and 7.
- 2. Attach panel 12 to panels 4 and 5 with part A.




STEP 4:


- 1. Attach panel 9 to panel 10 with part A.
- 2. Attach panel 10 to panel 8 with part A.







- Attach panel 4 to panel 5 with part A.
 Insert part A into panel 3.









- 1. Attach panels 8 and 9 to panel 3 with part A.
- 2. Attach panel 8 to panel 4 side from component in Step 5.1.




- Attach panel 11 to panel 5 with part A.
 Attach panels 10 and 11 to panel 6 with part A.





- 1. Insert parts A & B into panel 1.
- 2. Flip over panel 1 and attach to left side of desk and secure with part A cam locks.




- 1. Insert parts A & B into panel 2.
- 2. Flip over panel 2 and attach to right side of desk and secure with part A cam locks.









1. Attach part J to panel 6 with part D.





- 1. Attach the right side of part E to panel 16 with part D.
- 2. Attach the left side of part E to panel 7 with part D.




1. Insert part I inside panels 6 and 7, then place panel 13 on top. Adjust shelf height to personal preference.








Install Tip Kit 1. Attach part L to the back of panel 1 with part D. 2. Attach part L to the wall with part K.

To protect your furniture, we suggest the following:
