



- 10. Please keep the instructions for future reference.








#### STEP 1:

- Prepare a protected surface with a blanket or cardboard.
- Attach drawer back panel(11) to drawer side panel(9),(10),support rail(12) using hardware (D); Then attach the bottom panel(16) before assembly the drawer front panel(8); Attach the drawer front panel(8) by hardware (A,B);and then,assemble the handle(E) with screw(F);




#### STEP 2:

Open the metal runner as shown in the diagram below;
 Then,attach the runner(H) on left&right side panel(9),(10) by hardware (G);




#### STEP 3:

• Attach the runner(I) to the left&right side panel(1),(2) by hardware (G).




### STEP 4:

• Assemble the connect panel (5) with support rail (14),(13) by hardware (C, L). Then assemble the connect rail (4) (5) (14) (13), back rail (6), connect panel (7) to the side panel (2) by hardware (A,B,C).




### STEP 5:

• Attach the back panel (15).




#### STEP 6:

• Attach the side panel(1) with the frame by hardware (A,B,C);




# STEP 7:

• Attach the top panel (3) with the chest frame by hardware (A,B,C,L).




### STEP 8:

• Attach the hardware (K) on the back of the item. Attach the hardware pad (J).




# STEP 9:

#### SAFETY BRACKETS INSTRUCTIONS

This furniture poses a tipping risk and as such must be secured to a wall using the provided tipping kit.

- 1. Attach one Mounting Plate to the wall with the Large Screws. Make sure to attach the Mounting Plate into a stud. If mounting into brick or masonry you will need to acquire wall anchors. Please enquire with your local hardware supplier for appropriate fixings.
- 2. Attach the second Moun ng Plate to the furniture frame with the Short Screws.
- 3. Move the furniture to its final position. Thread a Wall Strap through the both Mounting Plates and tighten until snug. Do not over tighten.
- 4. Make sure that the Mounting Plates are firmly attached to the wall and furniture and that the Wall Strap is snug.



# **PRODUCT CARE:**
