



PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:

- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of retach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads
- 7. Assembly is to be carried out by a competent adult(s) ONLY
- 8. During assembly, children should be kept away from the product due to possible risk to injury.
- 9. Do not use this item if any components are missing or damaged.
- 10. Please keep the instructions for future reference.






SAFETY BRACKETS INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Install Plastic Screw Anchor in the wall and attach one Mounting Plate to the anchors with the Large Screws. Make sure to attach the Mounting Plate into a stud.
- 2. Attach the second Mounting Plate to the furniture frame with the Short Screws.
- 3. Move the furniture to its final position. Thread a Wall Strap through the both Mounting Plates and tighten until snug. Do not over tighten.
- 4. Make sure that the Mounting Plates are firmly attached to the wall and furniture and that the Wall Strap is snug.
- 5. NOTE: Please adjust the installation mode of the safety bracket according to the actual situation.






PAD INSTRUCTIONS

To protect your product and floor, we provide pads to customers. As the picture show, customer could paste pads on the bottom of product feet.

NOTE: Please adjust the pastelocation of pads according to the actual situation.



PRODUCT CARE:

If the glass is chipped or broken, stop using the product and consult place of purchase.

WARNING:

- Do not place very hot or cold items on the glass surface unless adequately thick table mats are used to prevent such items coming in contact with the glass
- · Do not sit or stand upon the glass surface
- Do not use the glass as a chopping surface
- Do not strike the glass with hard or pointed items
- When cleaning the glass panels use a damp cloth or leather with washing up liquid or soft soap if necessary. Do not use washing powders or any other substances containing abrasives since these may scratch the glass
