




PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:


- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product

- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads








STEP 1: Attach the (2) to (1) and (3) by using (G),(C),(H),(J),(E) and (I) with Allen Key M4 (A)as shown.




STEP 2: Attach the (6) to (5) and (3) by using (G),(C),(H),(J),(E) and (I) with Allen Key M4 (A)as shown.




STEP 3: Attach (4L) and (4R) to (9) With (F) Using a Allen Key M4 (A) as shown.




STEP 4: Attach to Assembled Headboard and Assembled Footboard with the pre-attached bolt using a Allen Key M5 (B) as shown.



STEP 5: Attach (8) and (10) to (7) With (D) Using a Allen Key M4 (A) as shown.




STEP 6: Attach Assembled Bed Slats to Assembled Bed Frame with (F) Using a Allen Key M4 (A) as shown.
