



PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:

- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads








STEP 1 : Attach (6) to (1) and (2) with (C) Using a Allen Key M5 (B) as shown




STEP 2 : Attach (5) to (4) with (D) Using a Allen Key M4 (A) as shown




STEP 3 : Attach Assembled Center Support to Assembled Bed with (F) using a Screwdriver as shown



STEP 4 : Attach Assembled Bed Slats to Assembled Bed Frame with (E) Using a Allen Key M4 (A) as shown.



STEP 5 : Attach Assembled Bed Slats to Assembled Bed Frame with (G) using a Screwdriver as shown.



PRODUCT CARE:

REGULAR CARE:

- Protect from direct sunlight
- Vacuum regularly using low suction
- Do not place sharp materials (knife, fork, etc.) directly onto your furniture as sharp material may scrape and damage the finish.
- Do not place material with high temperature directly onto the surface of your furniture.

CLEANING:

- Protect from direct sunlight
- Vacuum regularly using low suction
- Do not place sharp materials (knife, fork, etc.) directly onto your furniture as sharp material may scrape and damage the finish.
- Do not place material with high temperature directly onto the surface of your furniture.

SPOT CLEANING:

- Do not rub
- Do not spot clean with any solvent
- Treat spills and stains as soon as possible
- Gently scrape off any soil or blot any liquid from the surface of the fabric before applying cleaner
- Apply proprietary cleaning agents strictly according to instructions to remove the residue of the spill
- Do not saturate the fabric or interior with water or other cleaning liquids

WARNING:

Apply only water-based soil resist (fabric protection) treatments. Do not use aerosol products
