




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
PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

Before you start:


- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads




1	BACK

8	CASTOR




STEP 1:

Push castors 8 into place in wheel base 7 .Turn and apply pressure at the same time to each castor until it slots into place.




STEP 2:

Attach gas lift ⑤ to wheel base ⑦, as shown. Ensure part 5 is secure and unable to be removed.Remove gas lift cover ⑥ before assembly.




STEP 3:

Connect bar support $\ \ \,$ and back $\ \ \,$, using plastic C and bolt B fasten with Allen Key D.




STEP 4:

Separate mechanism ④ asinstruction shown, then insert bar support ② into mechanism④ and connected using mechanism spare part 4-1,4-2,4-3,4-4,4-5 4-6,4-7.




STEP 5:

Complete mechanism ④ using4-8,4 -9.




STEP 6:

Connect mechanism ④ and seat ③ using bolt A and fasten with Allen Key D




STEP 7:

Fix assembled chair seat to base, as shown. Please note: You may need sit carefully on the assembled chair and use your weight to lock the gas lift fully into place. Please note: the maximum recommended weigh or this chair is 120kg.



Height Adjustment Instructions: To lower the height of the chair sit in chair and pull lever upwards. To increase height of chair remove yourselffrom chair and pull the lever upwards.



IMPORTANT NOTE:

BEFORE FINALLY TIGHTENING THE BOLTS, PLACE THE ASSEMBLED CHAIR UPRIGHT ON A LEVEL SURFACE AND SIT CAREFULLY ON THE CHAIR TO ENSURE THE CHAIR LEGS ARE ALIGNED AND LEVEL. THEN TIGHTEN ALL BOLTS AND YOUR CHAIR IS READY TO USE.

STEP 8:

Assembly is complete



CAUTION:

DO NOT

- USE CHAIR/ STOOL AS A LADDER
- CLIMB ON THE CHAIR/STOOL
- STAND ON THE FOOT REST OF THE CHAIR, AS THIS COULD LEAD TO THE STOOL BECOMING UNBALANCED AND OVERTURNING.

GENERAL PRODUCT CARE



REGULAR CARE:

- Protect from direct sunlight
- Vacuum regularly using low suction
- Rotate reversible cushions regularly
- Avoid exposure to new clothing, cushions or throws as this may lead to dye transfer and permanent staining

CLEANING:

- Do not remove cushion covers for separate cleaning even though they may have zippers
- Do not wash, Do not dry clean, Do not shampoo clean
- Clean only with hot water extraction machine. Professional cleaning recommended
- Do not use dishwashing liquid or laundry detergent. Use only upholstery detergents
 Do not wet filling
- Dry in shade away from direct heat and sunlight
- Allow to dry thoroughly before re-use

SPOT CLEANING:

- Do not rub
- · Do not spot clean with any solvent
- Treat spills and stains as soon as possible
- Gently scrape off any soil or blot any liquid from the surface of the fabric before applying cleaner
- Apply proprietary cleaning agents strictly according to instructions to remove the residue of the spill
- Do not saturate the fabric or interior with water or other cleaning liquids

WARNING:

Apply only water-based soil resist (fabric protection) treatments. Do not use aerosol products

- * PILLING IS NOT A FABRIC DEFECT OR FAULT AND IS NOT COVERED BY WARRANTY
- * PILLING IS A NORMAL OCCURRENCE IN WOVEN FABRICS AND DOES NOT AFFECT THE DURABILITY OR FUNCTIONALITY OF THE FABRIC. IT IS EASILY REMOVED
