

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


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
## PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

## Before you start:

- 1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
- 2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
- 3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
- 4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
- 5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
- 6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads





STEP 1: With two people carefully lay the Footboard on to a sheet or piece of cardboard. Attach adhesive felt pad ( H ) onto the legs.


With two people carefully stand the Footboard upright.



STEP 2: Attach the drawer handle








Remove handles from inside drawers using a screwdriver to undo the bolts.




Attach handles to drawer fronts by connecting the handle to the bolt through the pre-drilled hole and tighten with a screwdriver


STEP 3: Tighten the headboard leg ( 2A ), ( 2B ) to headboard ( 1 ) with bolts ( B ), spring washer ( D ) and flat washer ( E ).



STEP 4: Attach side rails (4) to headboard legs (2A), (2B) and footboard (3) by interlocking the brackets on the side rails with the bolt (C) on the headboard/footboard and then push down to lock in place.




STEP 5: Tighten the slats (7) and slat support bar (5) to all support legs (6) with bolt (A). Assemble these parts into an **I frame** bed frame.




STEP 6: Use two people to place **I frame** onto the side rail.


Attach **I frame** onto the side rail ( 4 ) using bolt ( B ),tighten it up by using an allen key ( F ).



STEP 7: Attach the middle slats ( 8 ) onto the side rail ( 4 ) using the screws ( G ), tighten it up by using an screwdriver.

## IMPORTANT: CARE GUIDE FOR YOUR TIMBER FURNITURE

Congratulations! You have just purchased a quality product from Amart furniture.

Please read on for important information regarding your purchase...

A multi-step finish is applied to all our furniture, but all wood comes from nature. Because of this, there will be natural variations in surface texture and grain like knots, mineral streaks and sap runs that may affect the finish.

These differences in character are not defects, but distinctions that make each piece of furniture unique.

Our furniture is built to last. Following these steps, basic care should protect your investment for years to come.

- <u>Dust frequently with a clean damp lint-free cloth</u>. This will help remove abrasive build up which can damage a finish over time.
- Do not place hot objects on any Furniture surface. Always use a suitable placemat. Laminate and lacquer finishes on table tops provide added scratch and heat resistance to our furniture, but they can still be damaged without proper care.
- Avoid exposing your furniture to strong sunlight, heat, open windows or dampness. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can fade the finish of your furniture, and sudden extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause cracking or splitting.
- <u>Do not expose your furniture to any liquids</u>. Never allow water to sit on your furniture. Alcohol, nail polish and perfume are also dangerous as they will dissolve the lacquer finish on contact and may require professional repairs.
- <u>Do not allow plastic to come in direct contact with your furniture</u>. Chemicals in the plastic of placemats etc may soften and mark the finish if left in contact with the furniture for a period of time.
