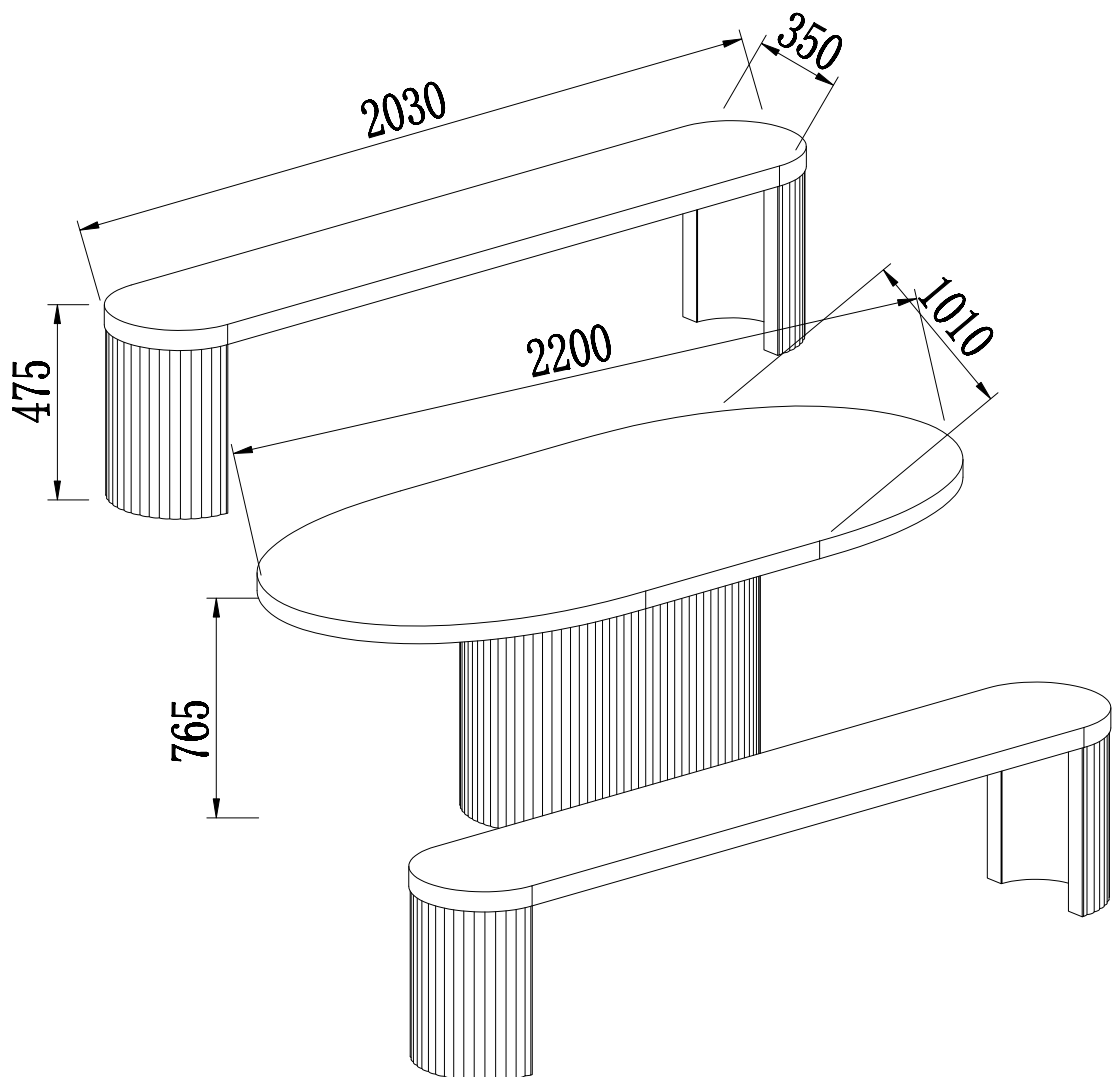

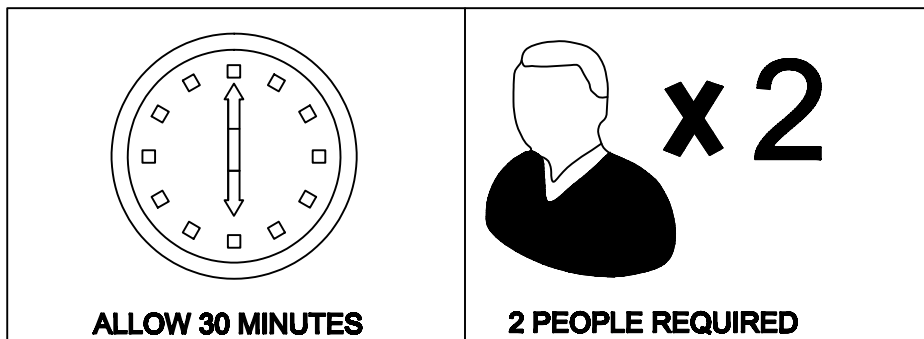

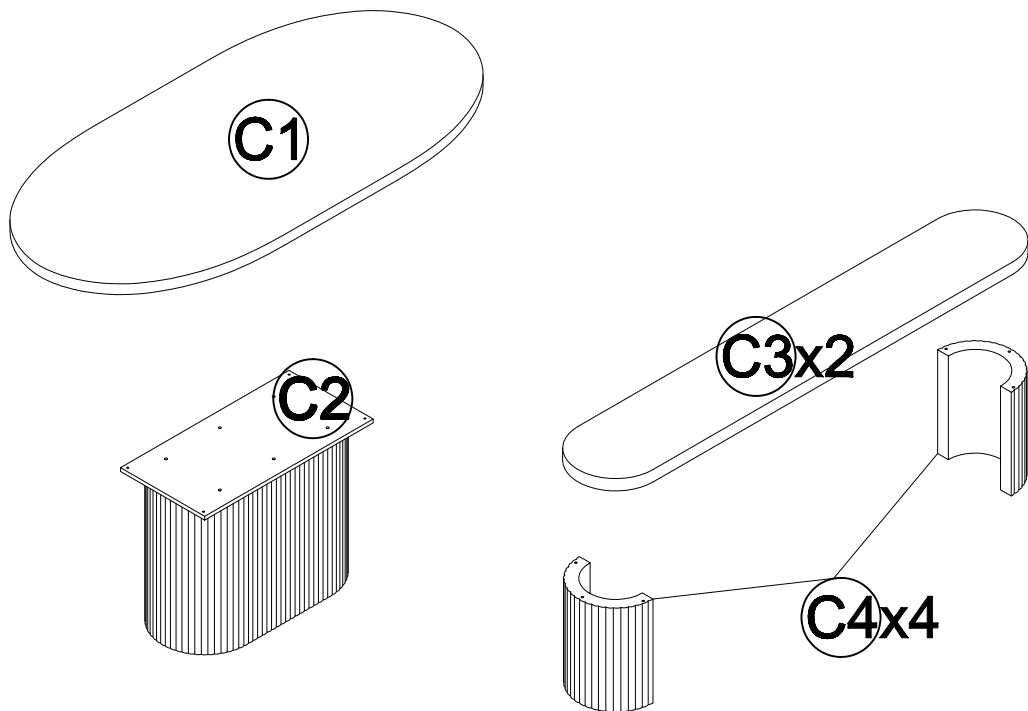
# PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

## Before you start:

1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly.
4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads






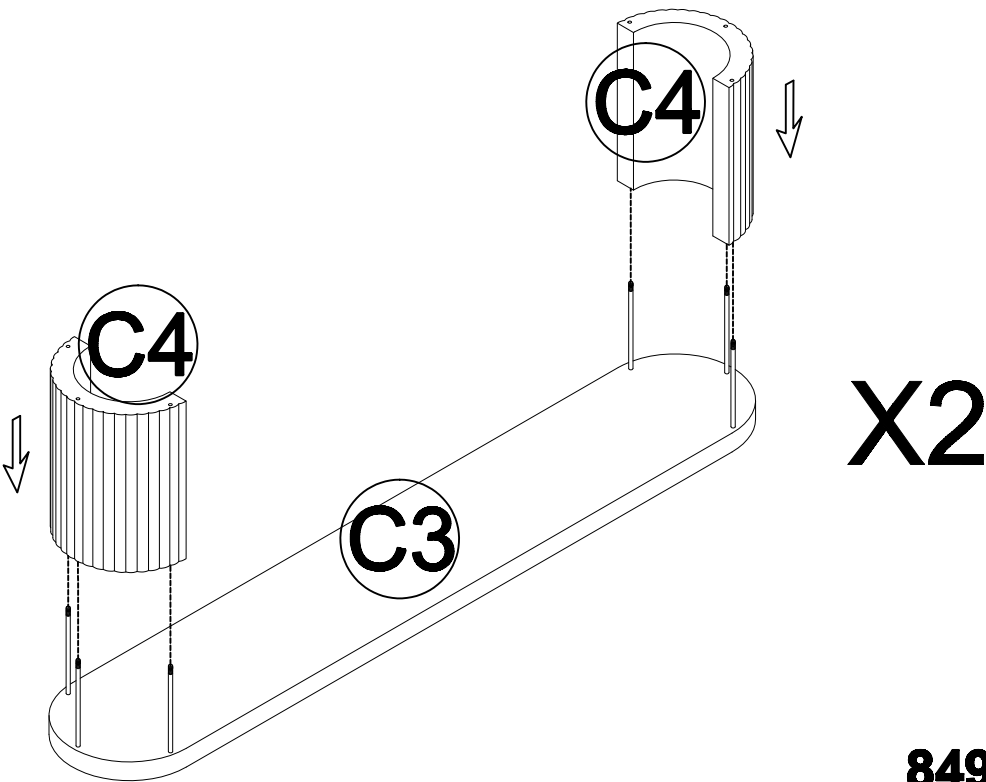
**STEP 1:** Use Hex Key(B)to assemble the Table Base(C2) to the Top Panel(C1)with Bolt(A),  
Use Phillips Head Screwdriver to attached the Rubber Feet(D) to the Table base(C2)  
with Bolt(C).



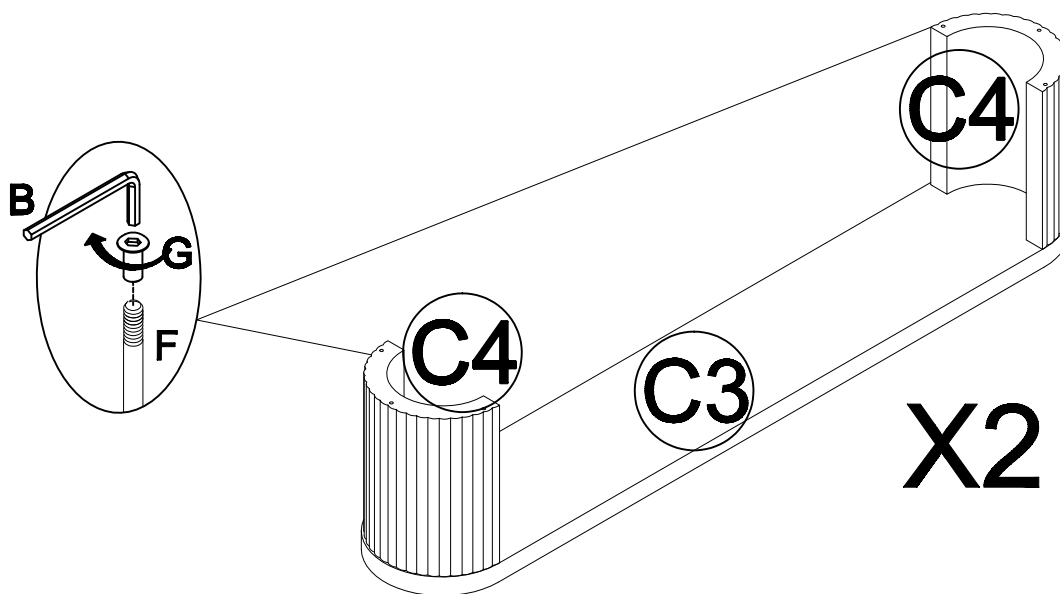
**STEP 2:** Insert the Bolt(F) to the Bench Top Panel(C3).



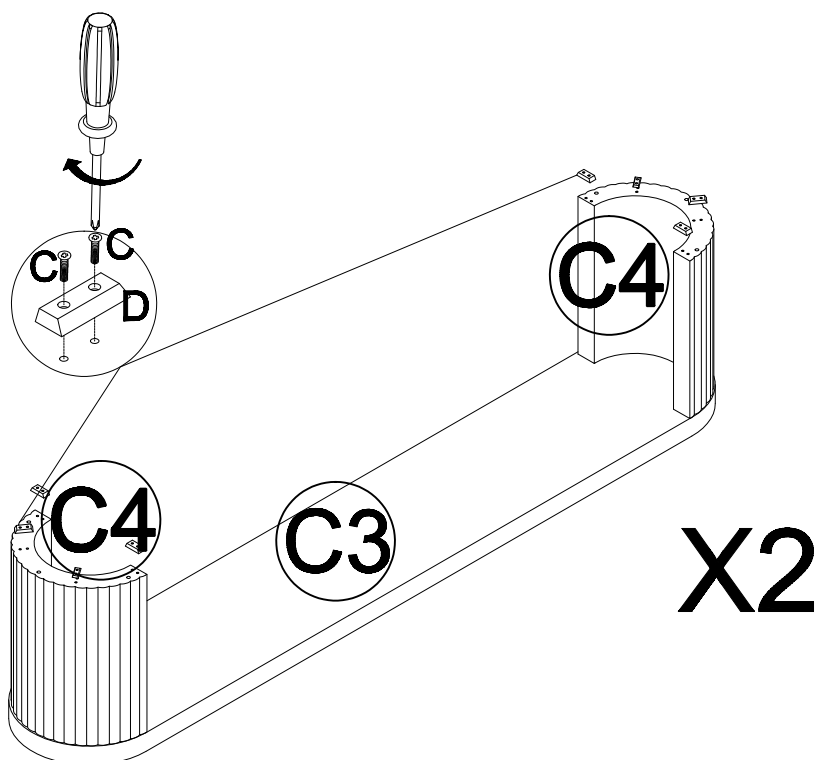
**STEP 3:** Insert the Bench Base(C4) to the Bolt(F).



**STEP 4:** Use Hex Key(B) to assemble the Bench Base(C4) to the Bench Top Panel(C3) with T Nut (G).

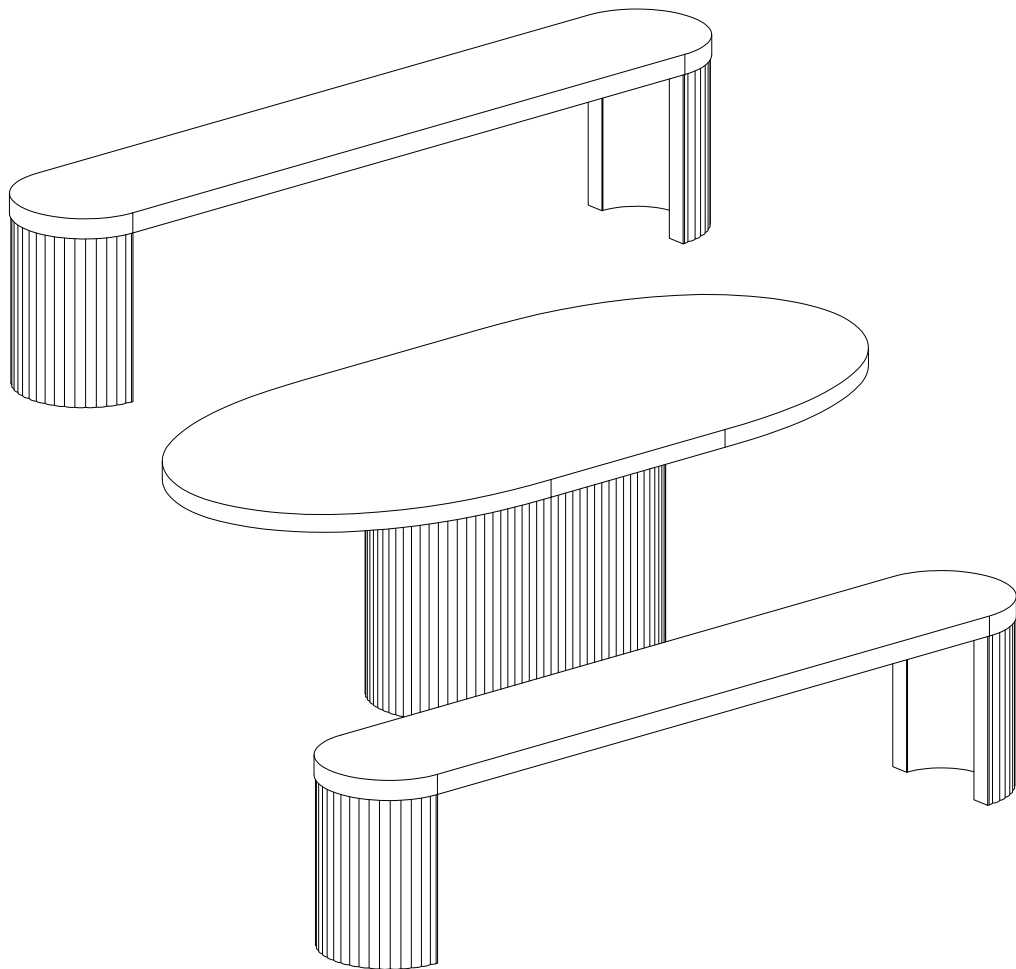


**STEP 5:** Use Phillips Head Screwdriver to attached the Rubber Feet(D) to the Bench Base(C4) with Bolt(C).

**Important note: Please use this furniture under covered patio to avoid rain and extreme constant direct sunlight.**



### **Note -**

**Do not drag the furniture as this may cause damage to the legs. Instead, use 2 persons to lift carefully from either end.**

# Micro-cement Outdoor Furniture Maintenance

## 1. Daily Cleaning Basics

- **Gentle Wipe-Down:** Use a soft, damp cloth to remove surface dust, leaves, or debris. Avoid abrasive materials (e.g., steel wool) that may scratch the micro-cement finish.
- **Mild Detergent:** For stains, mix a small amount of neutral pH soap with water. Gently scrub the area in circular motions, then rinse with clean water and dry with a soft towel.

## 2. Stain Removal Guide

Stain Type	Treatment Steps
Organic (Food/Wine)	Blot the stain immediately with a damp cloth. Apply a mixture of baking soda and water, let sit for 10 minutes, then rinse.
Oil/Grease	Use a degreaser suitable for concrete surfaces. Test on a small area first, then wipe with a cloth and rinse.
Mold/Mildew	Mix 1 part water with 1 part white vinegar. Spray the area, scrub gently, and rinse thoroughly. Ensure good ventilation to prevent recurrence.

## 3. Long-Term Maintenance Tips

- **Regular Inspections:** Check for signs of wear, such as peeling sealant or surface discoloration, and address issues promptly.
- **Avoid Heavy Impact:** Micro-cement is durable but can chip under severe force. Prevent damage by placing cushions on hard surfaces and avoiding dragging furniture. Use felt pads under legs to reduce abrasion.

## 4. Storage Recommendations

- If storing furniture for extended periods:
  - Clean and dry it thoroughly.
  - Apply a fresh layer of sealant.
  - Cover with a breathable fabric cover to prevent dust and moisture buildup.

By following these steps, micro-cement outdoor furniture can maintain its aesthetic and durability for years, even in harsh weather conditions. Always test new cleaning products on a small, inconspicuous area first to avoid damage.
