






## PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

### Before you start:

1. Choose a clean, level, spacious assembly area. Avoid hard surfaces that may damage the product
2. Take care when lifting. Product should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use
3. Ensure that you have all required contents for complete assembly
4. Always read the assembly instructions carefully before beginning assembly.
5. Keep all hardware parts and packaging out of reach of small children.
6. Do not over tighten the screws and bolts as this may damage the threads










**Do not allow children to play on this mechanised furniture or operate the mechanism. This lift bed base raises at the rear - do not place objects under it and make sure area is clear of obstructions including pets and small children. Ensure that the mattress and lift mechanism has been returned to the lowered position before lying or sitting on the mattress. Always ensure that your body is clear of the lift mechanism when lifting and lowering the mechanism**

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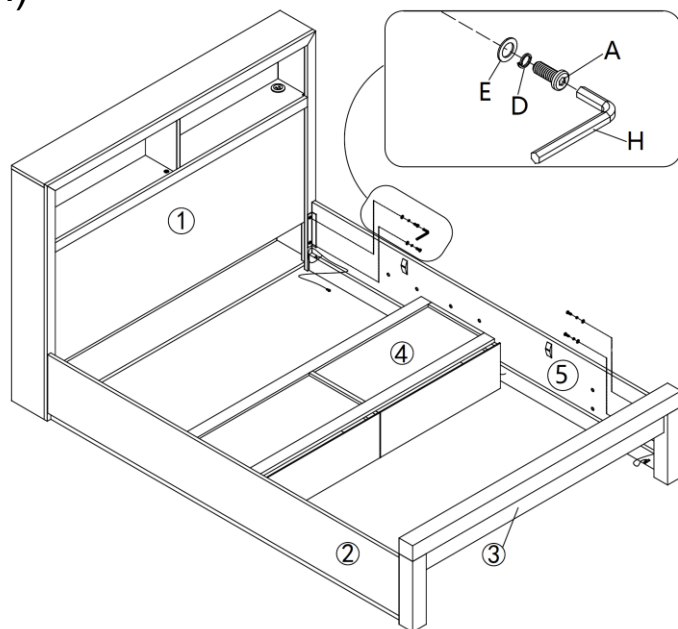
- Attach the siderail (2) to headboard (1) and footboard (3) with flat washer (E), lock washer (D) and bolt (A).
- Note: Do not tighten the bolts.
- Move the drawer(4) into the bed frame, with the drawer facing the footboard(3).

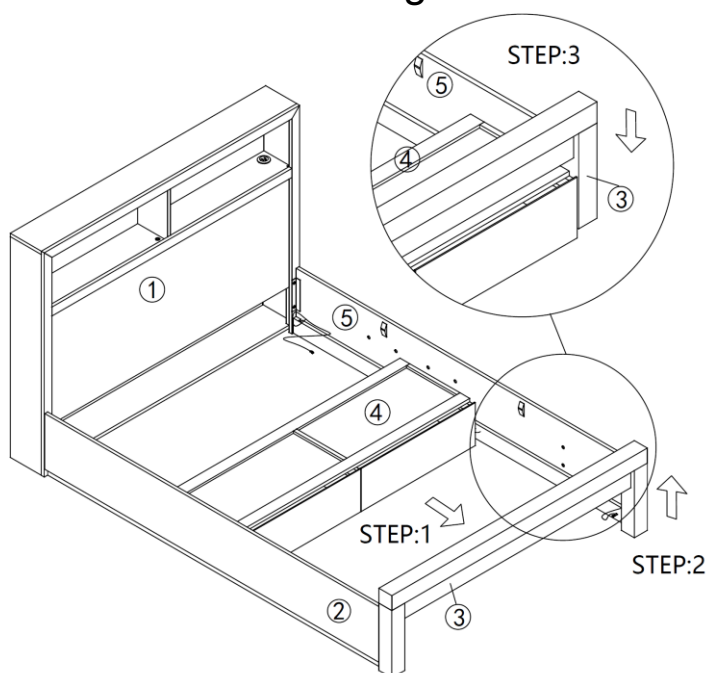

- Tighten all bolts with allen key (H)

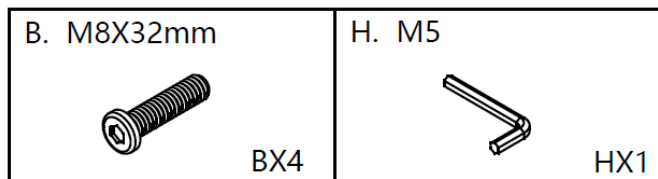

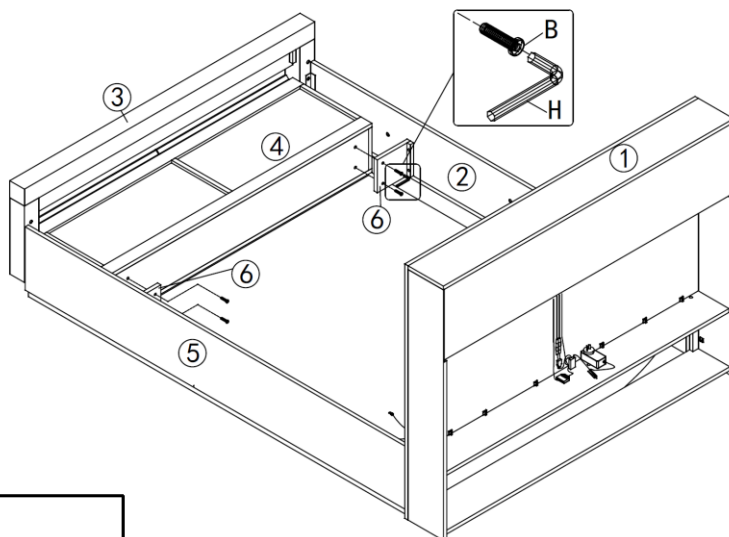
- Move the drawer (4) close to the footboard (3).
- One person lifted the footboard(3) more than 2CM, and the other person pushed the drawer(4) outward to align the drawer surface with the outside of footboard before lowering the footboard.



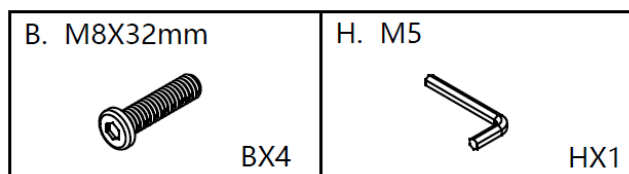

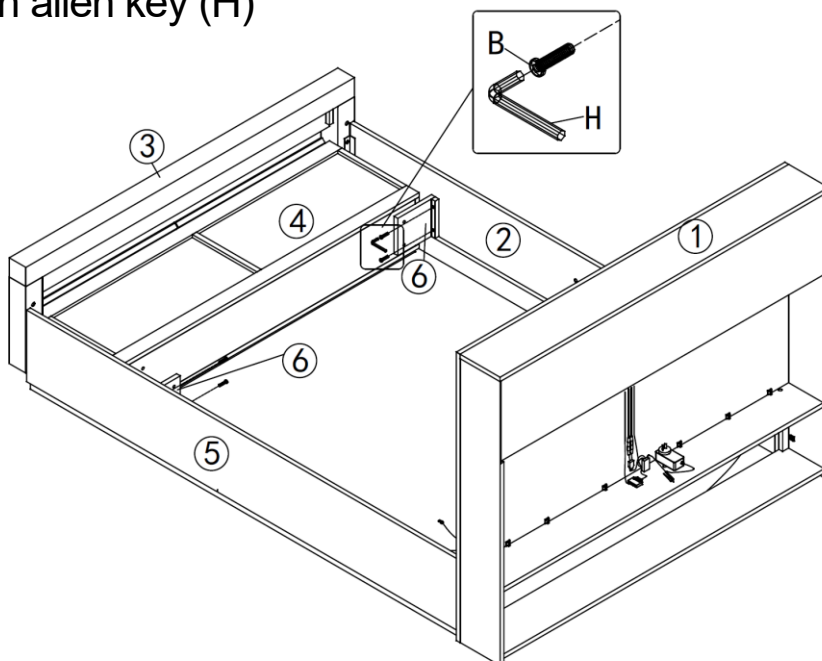
- Attach the connecting board (6) to the drawer (4) with bolt (B).
- Note: Do not tighten the bolts.

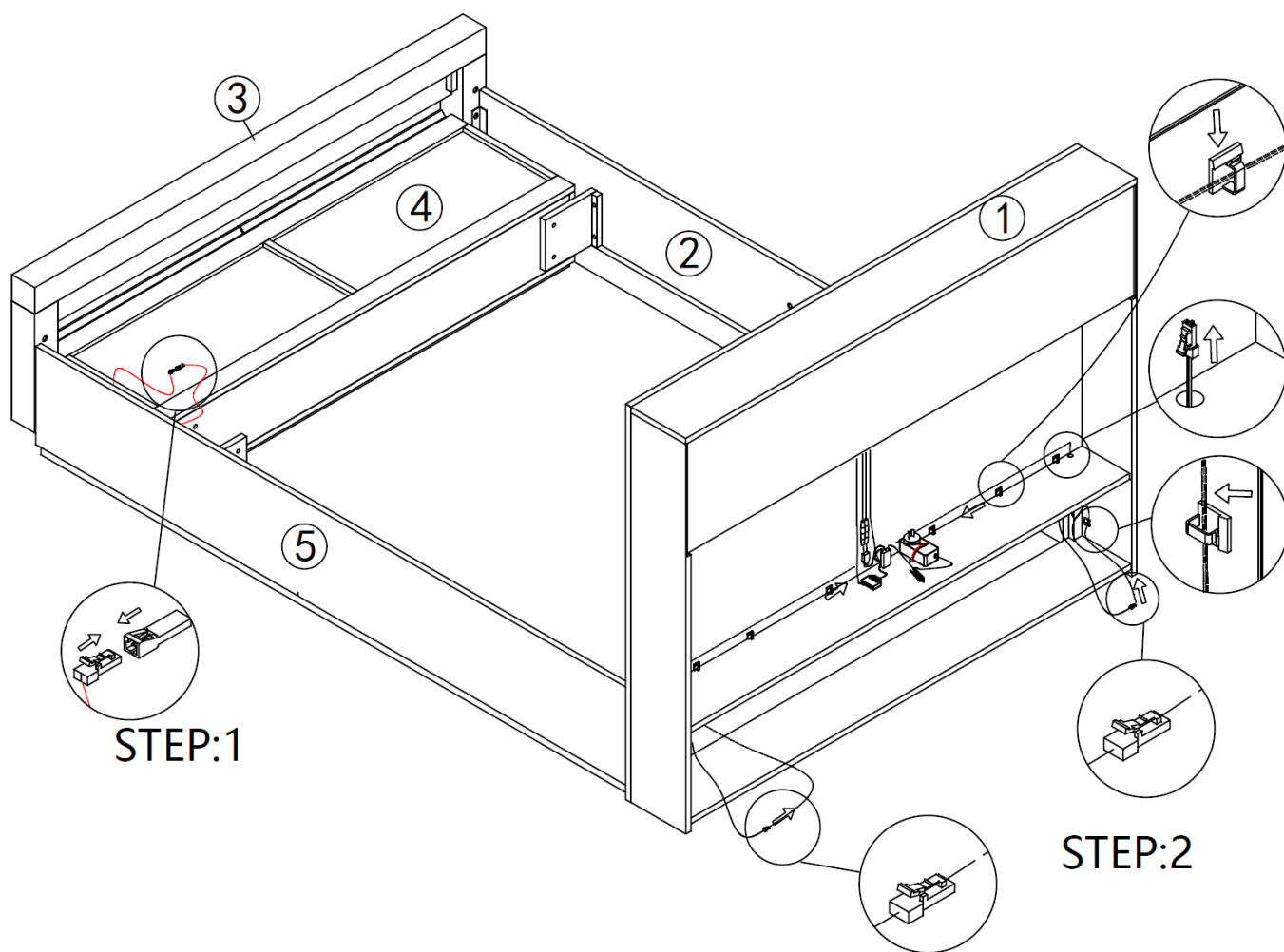


- Fix the connecting board (6) to siderail (2) (5) with bolt (B).
- Tighten all bolts with allen key (H)



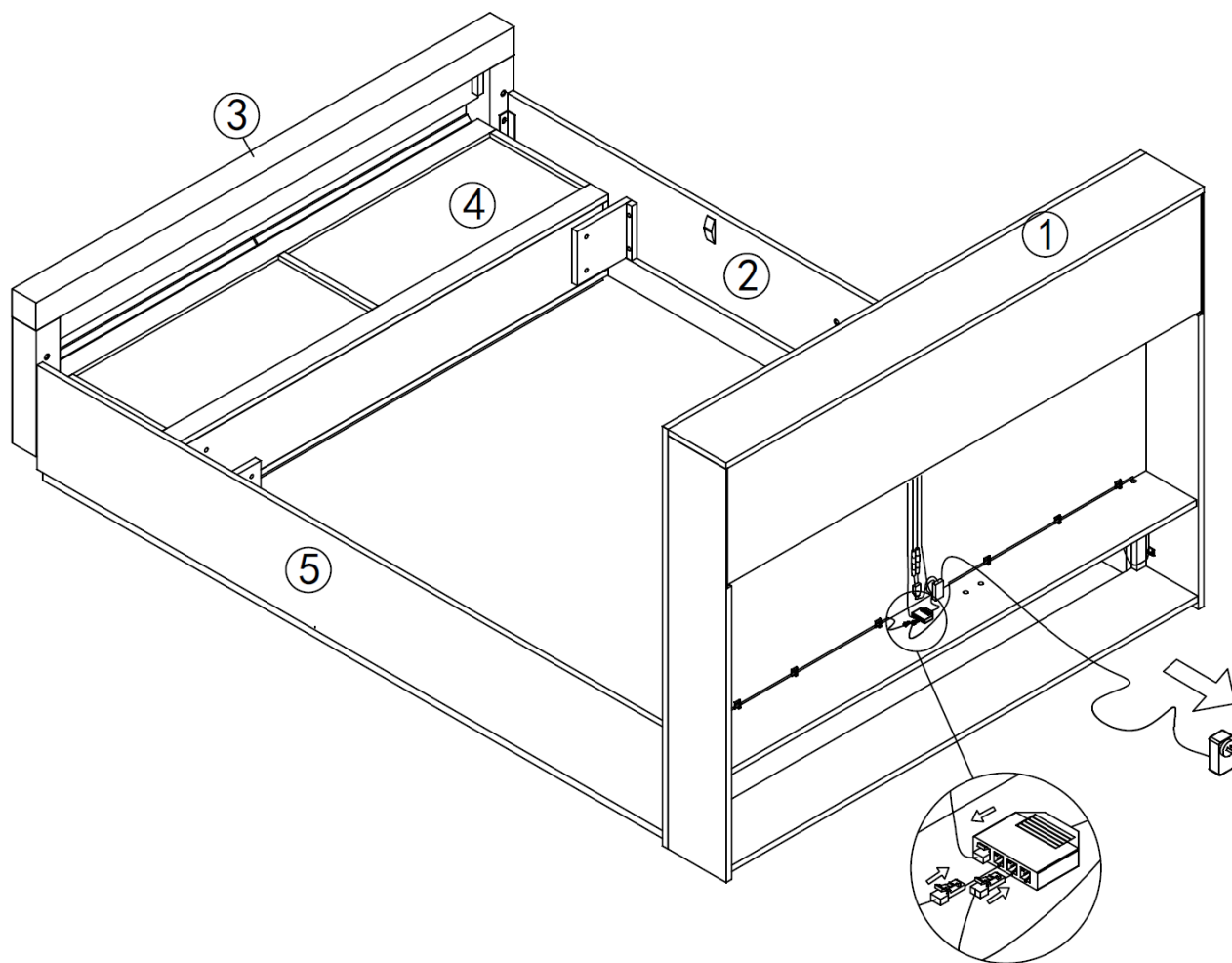
# 6.

- Connect the LED light wires on the drawer and the siderail.
- After passing the LED light wires on the siderail(2)(5) through the wire holes from the headboard support board, drag them near the cable box and fix them with wire managers.







# 7.

- Insert the LED light wire of the siderail (2)(5) into the cable box.
- Unfasten and drag out the adapter to the length you need.



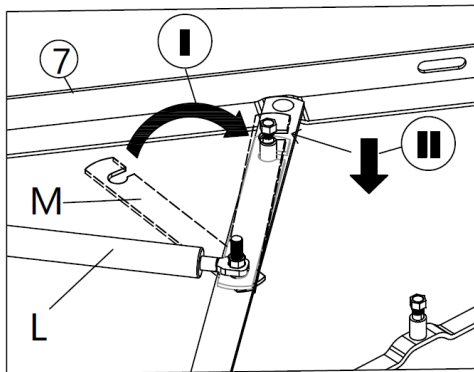

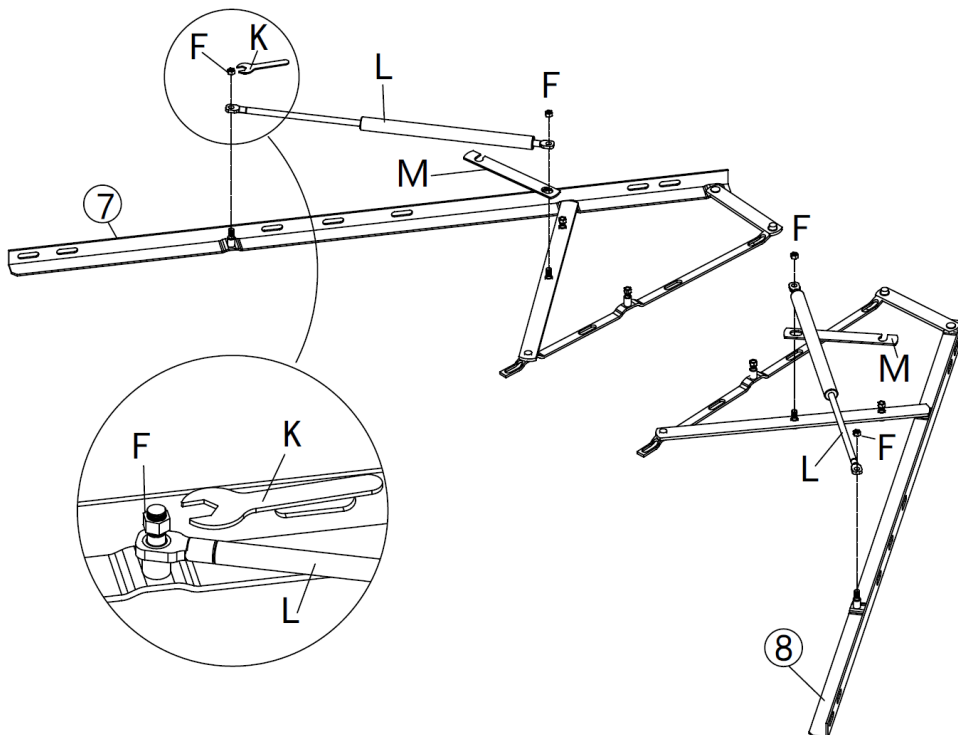
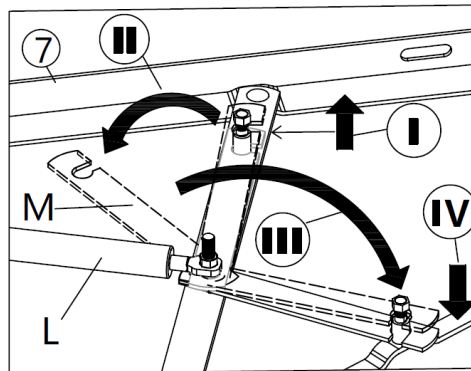

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- Fix the lift (L) and safety lock (M) to lift bracket (7)(8) with nut (F), and pay attention to the opening direction of the safety lock.
- Tighten with wrench (K).
- Note: The safety lock also needs to be placed in a fixed position after being unlocked. Please refer to the usage method of the safety lock in the image.





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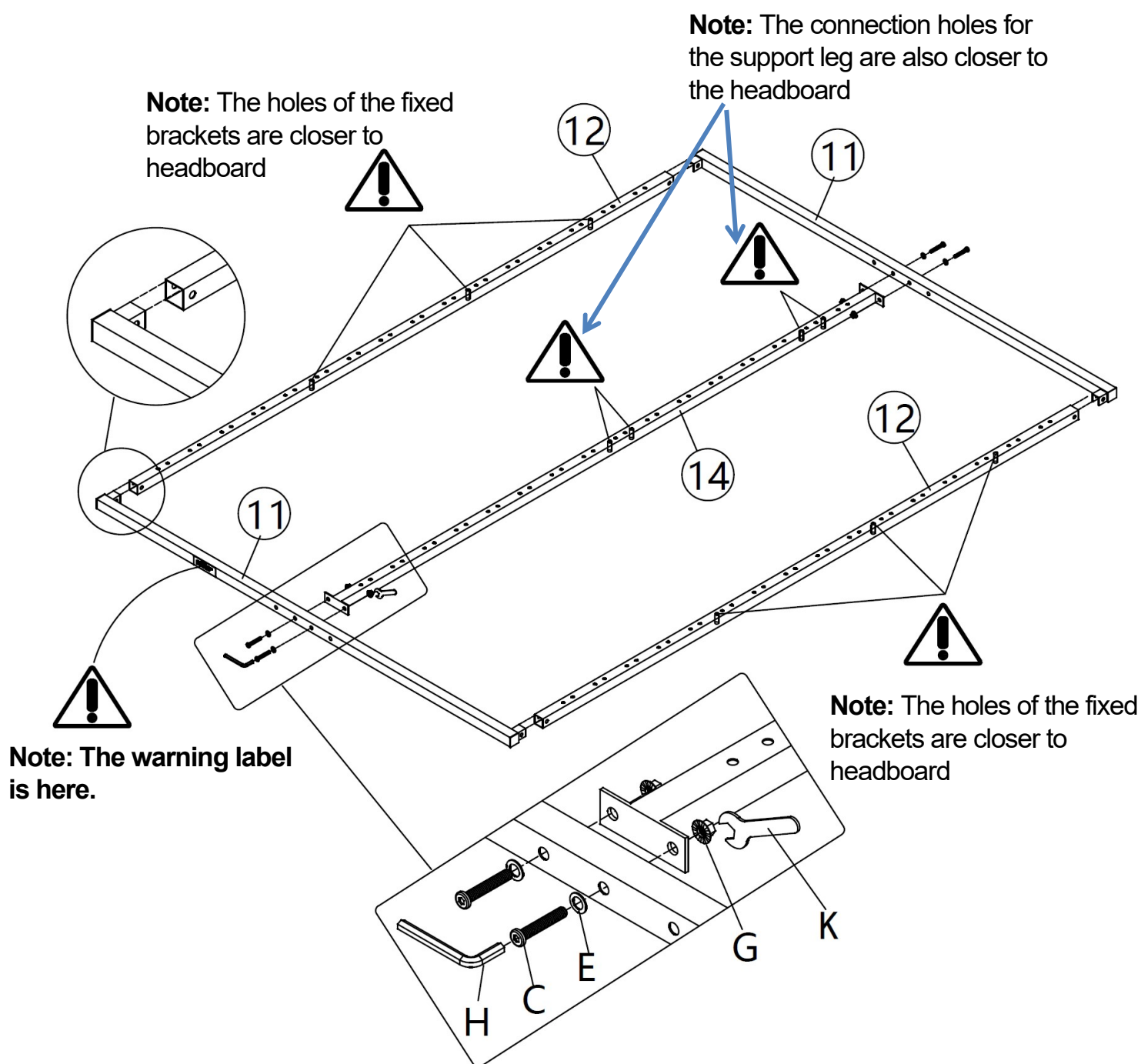
- Fix the lift bracket (7)(8) to the siderail (2)(5) with flat washer (E), lock washer (D) and bolt (A).
- Adjust the distance between the two lift brackets and the headboard to keep them the same, and then tighten all the bolts with allen key (H).






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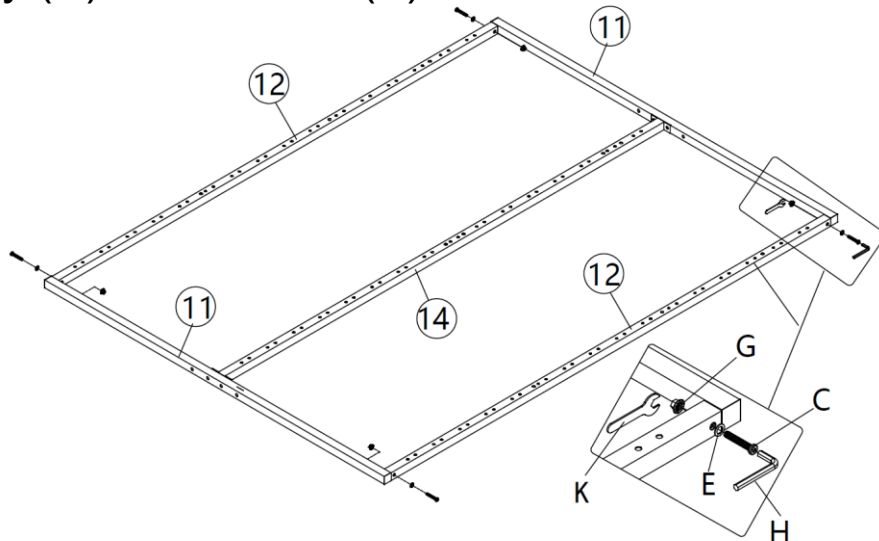
- Adjust the directions of the two metal parts(12) ensure that all the holes on them correspond to each other, and then insert the metal part (11) into the metal part (12).
- After adjusting the direction of the metal part (14), fix it to metal parts (11) with with flat washer (E) bolt (C) and nut(G).
- Tighten with allen key (H) and wrench (K).

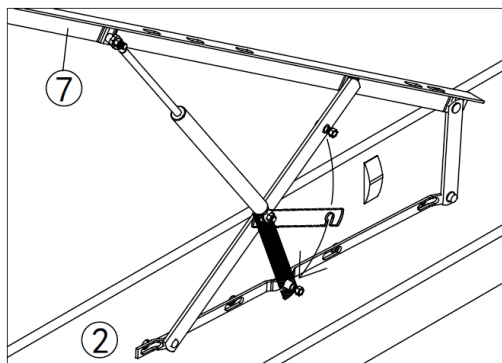


## SAFETY CAUTION WARNING

Unlock it before you want to put the bed base back into normal position.



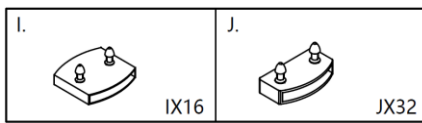
UN LOCK POSITION



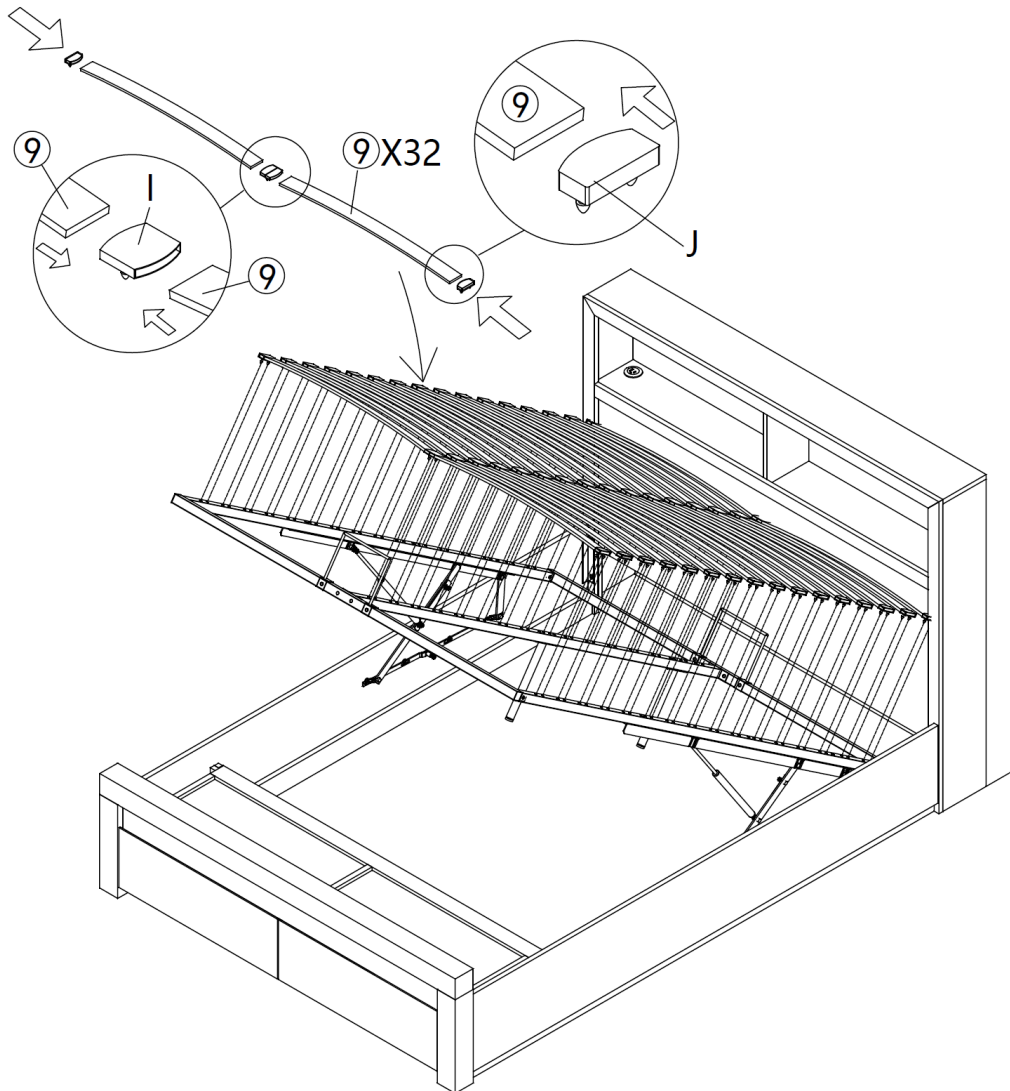

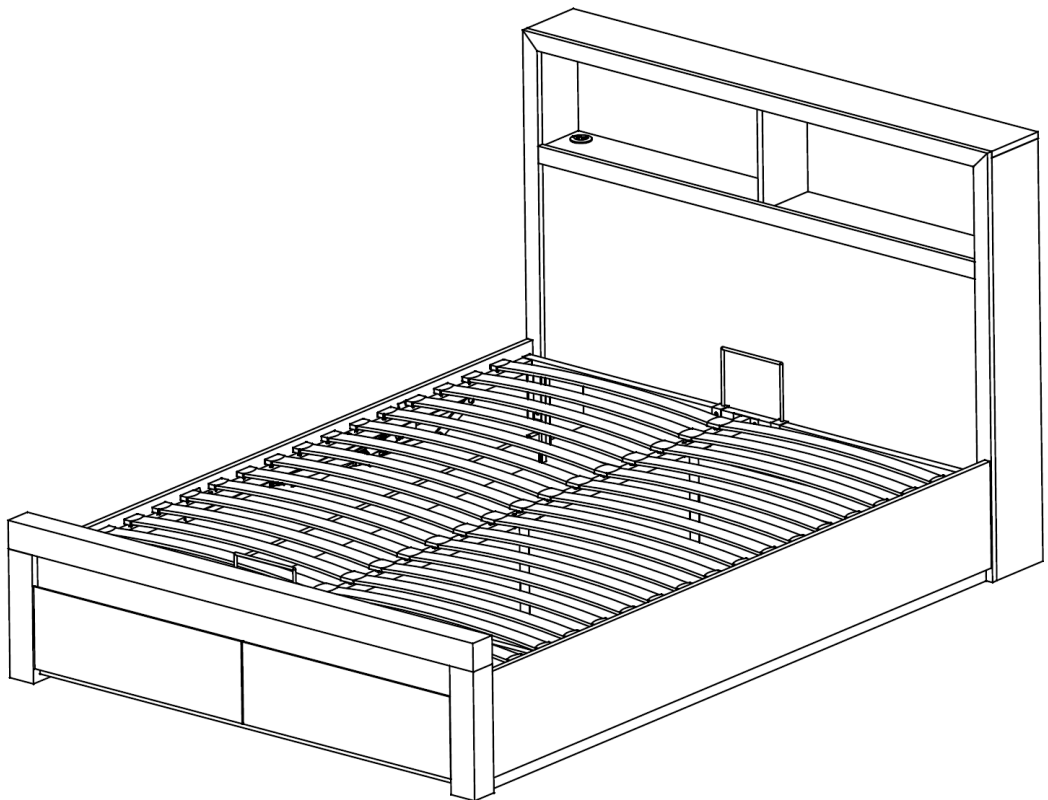
- Connect the slats (9) with plastic caps(I)(J) and then fix them to the metal bed frame.

# Care and maintenance



As our timber is supplied from sustainable forests there will be natural variations in surface texture and grain like knots, mineral streaks and sap runs that may affect the finish. These differences in character are not defects, but distinctions that make each piece of furniture unique

Our furniture is built to last. Following these steps for basic care should protect your investment for years to come

- Dust frequently with a clean damp lint-free cloth. This will help remove abrasive build up which can damage a finish over time
- Do not place hot objects on any furniture surface. Always use a hot plate or placemat. Laminate and lacquer finishes on table tops provide added scratch and heat resistance to our furniture, but they can still be damaged without proper care
- Avoid exposing your furniture to strong sunlight, heat outlet, open windows or dampness. Prolonged exposure to direct sunlight can fade the finish of your furniture, while extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause cracking or splitting
- Do not expose your furniture to any liquids. Never allow water to sit on your furniture. Alcohol, nail polish and perfume are also dangerous as they will dissolve the lacquer finish on contact and may require professional repairs
- Do not allow plastic to come in direct contact with your furniture. Chemicals in the plastic of placemats etc. may soften and mark the finish if left in contact with the furniture for a period of time
