PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

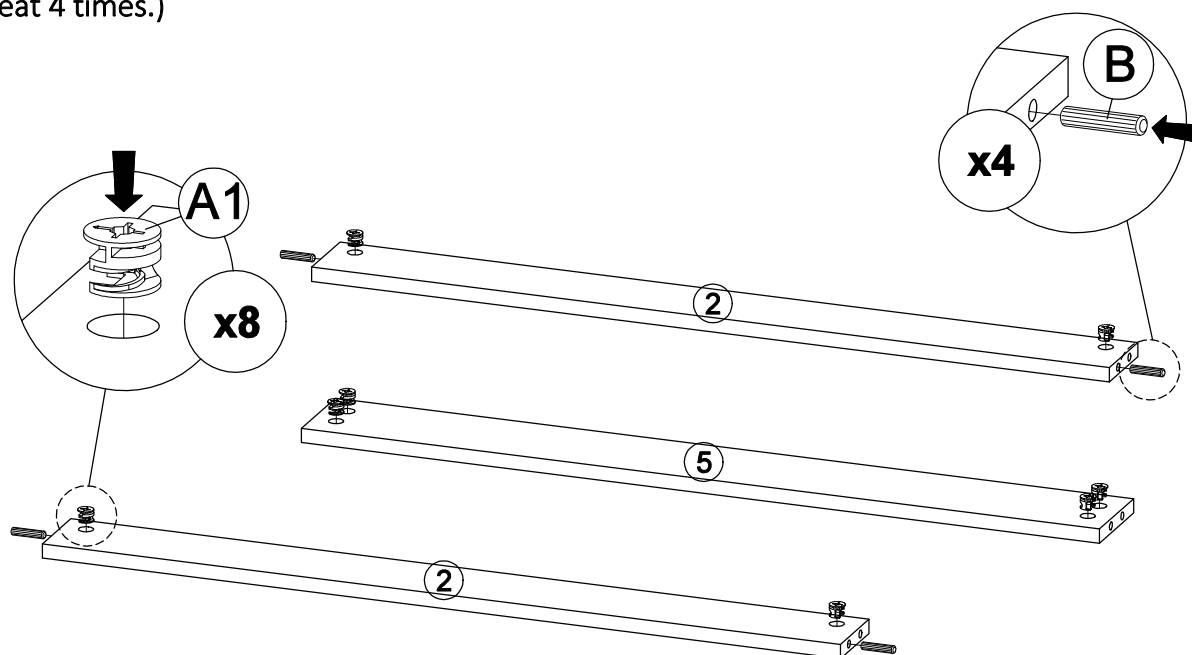
STEP 1:

- Insert hardware **A1** onto panel (6).
(Repeat 6 times.)
- Insert hardware **A2** onto panel (1).
(Repeat 6 times.)
- Insert hardware **B** onto panel (6).
(Repeat 8 times.)
- Fix hardware **J** into panel (1) with hardware **D** and **H**.
(Repeat 2 times.)



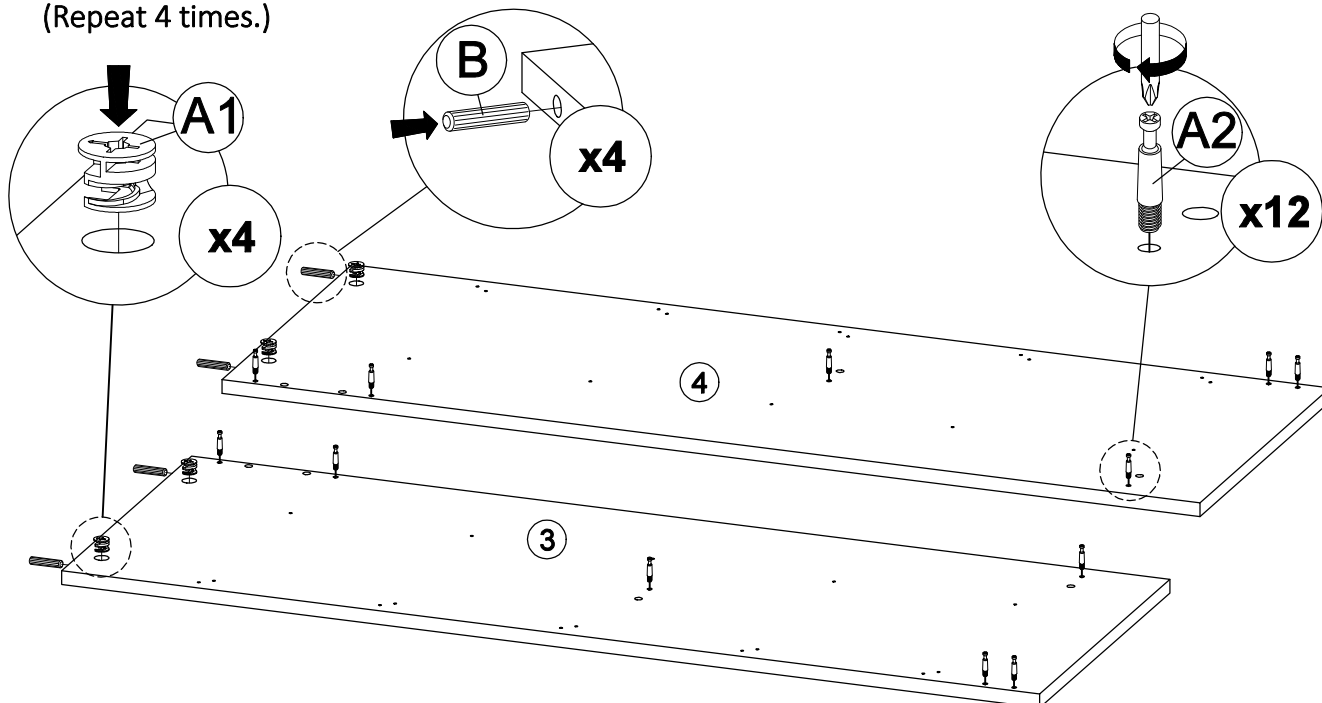
STEP 2:

- Insert hardware **A1** onto panel (2) and (5).
(Repeat 8 times.)
- Insert hardware **B** onto panel (2) and (5).
(Repeat 4 times.)



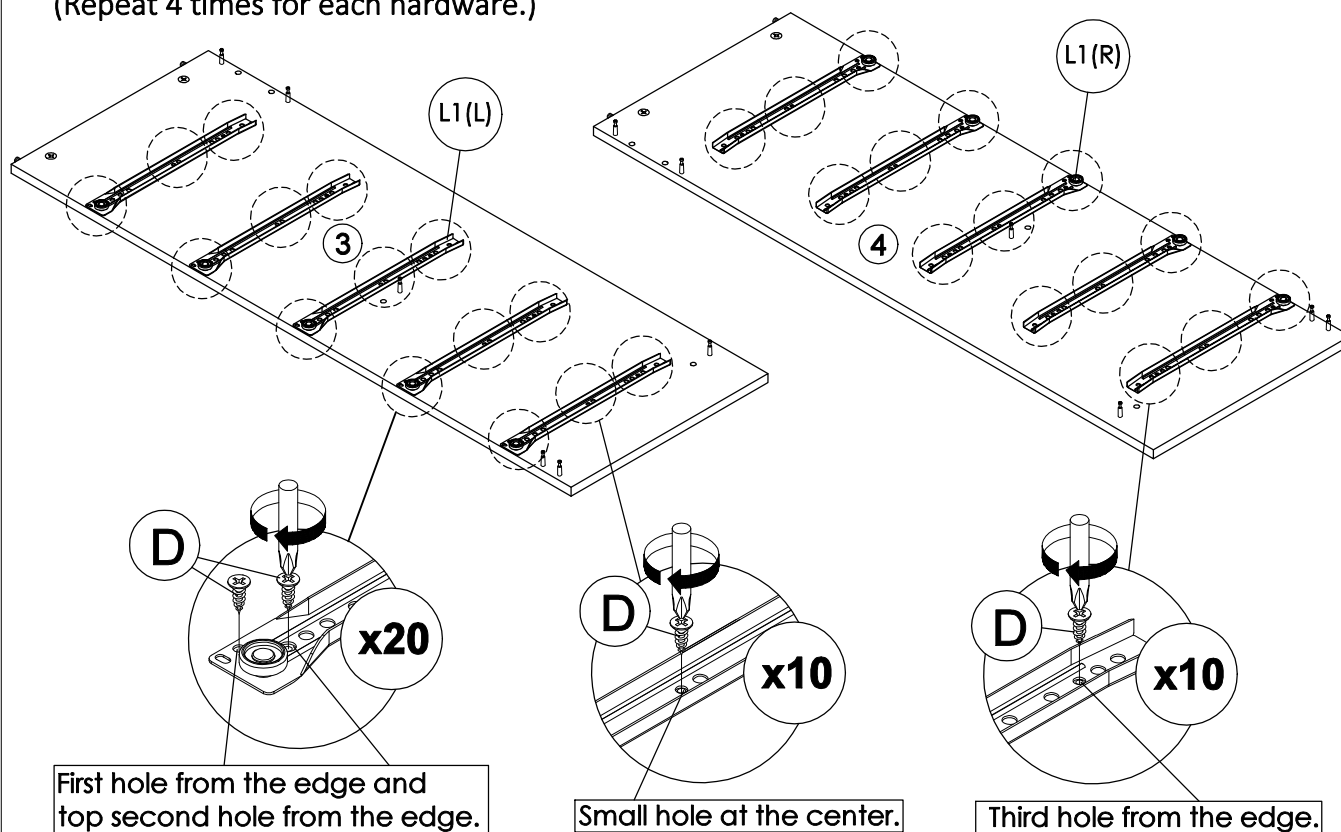
STEP 3:

- Insert hardware A1 onto panel (3) and (4).
(Repeat 4 times.)
- Insert hardware A2 onto panel (3) and (4).
(Repeat 12 times.)
- Insert hardware B onto panel (3) and (4).
(Repeat 4 times.)



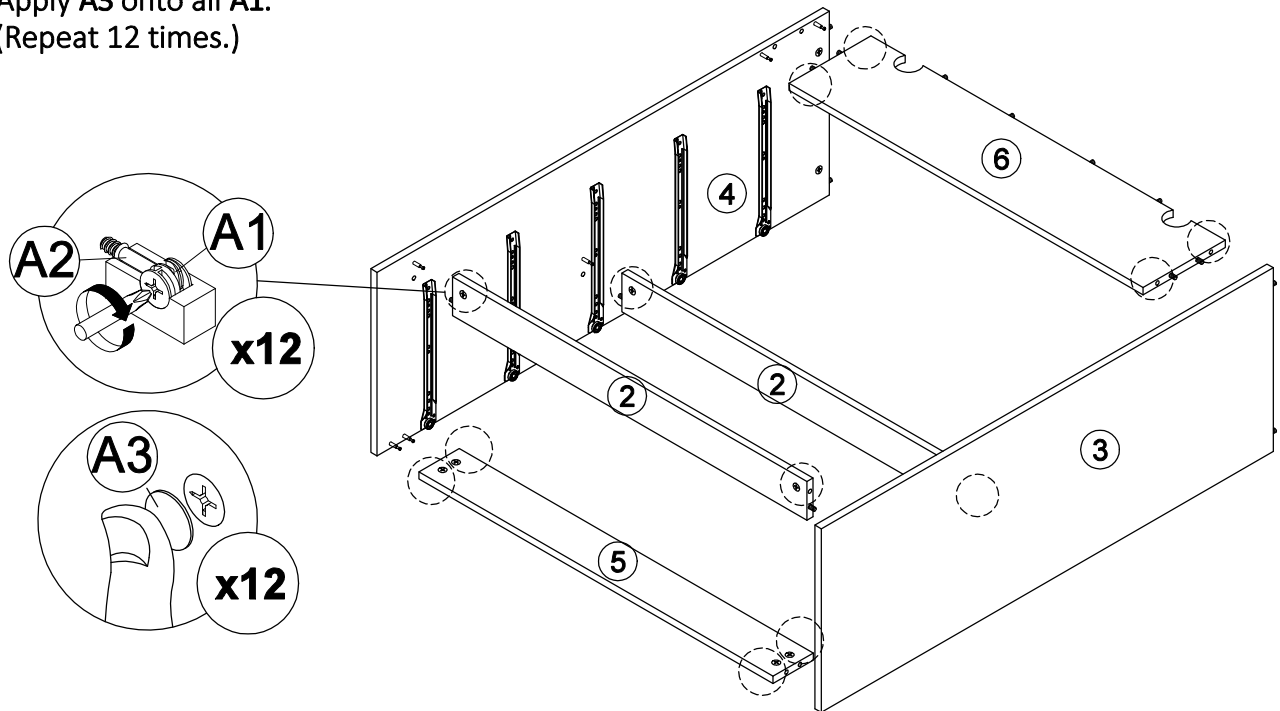
STEP 4:

- Fix hardware L1 (L/R) into panel (3) and (4) with hardware D.
(Repeat 4 times for each hardware.)



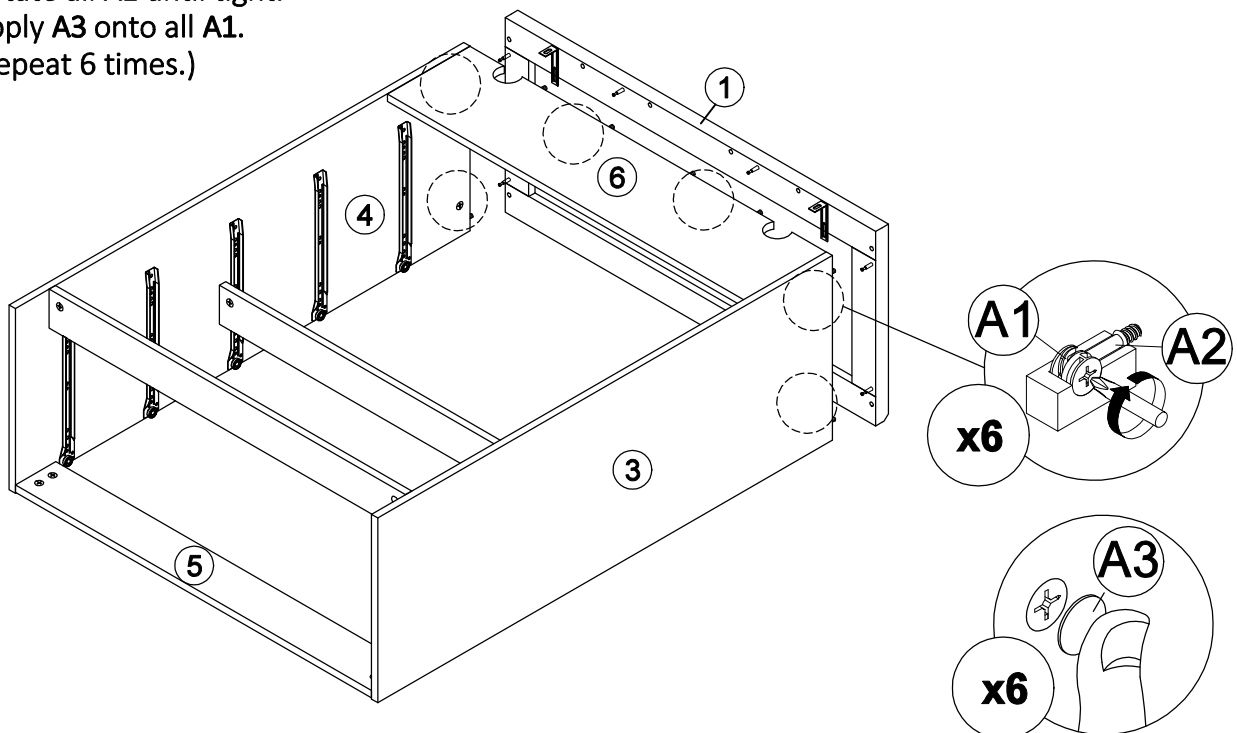
STEP 5:

- Attach panel (3) and (4) to panel (2), (5) and (6).
- Insert all hardware A2 into A1.
- Rotate all A1 until tight.
- Apply A3 onto all A1.
- (Repeat 12 times.)



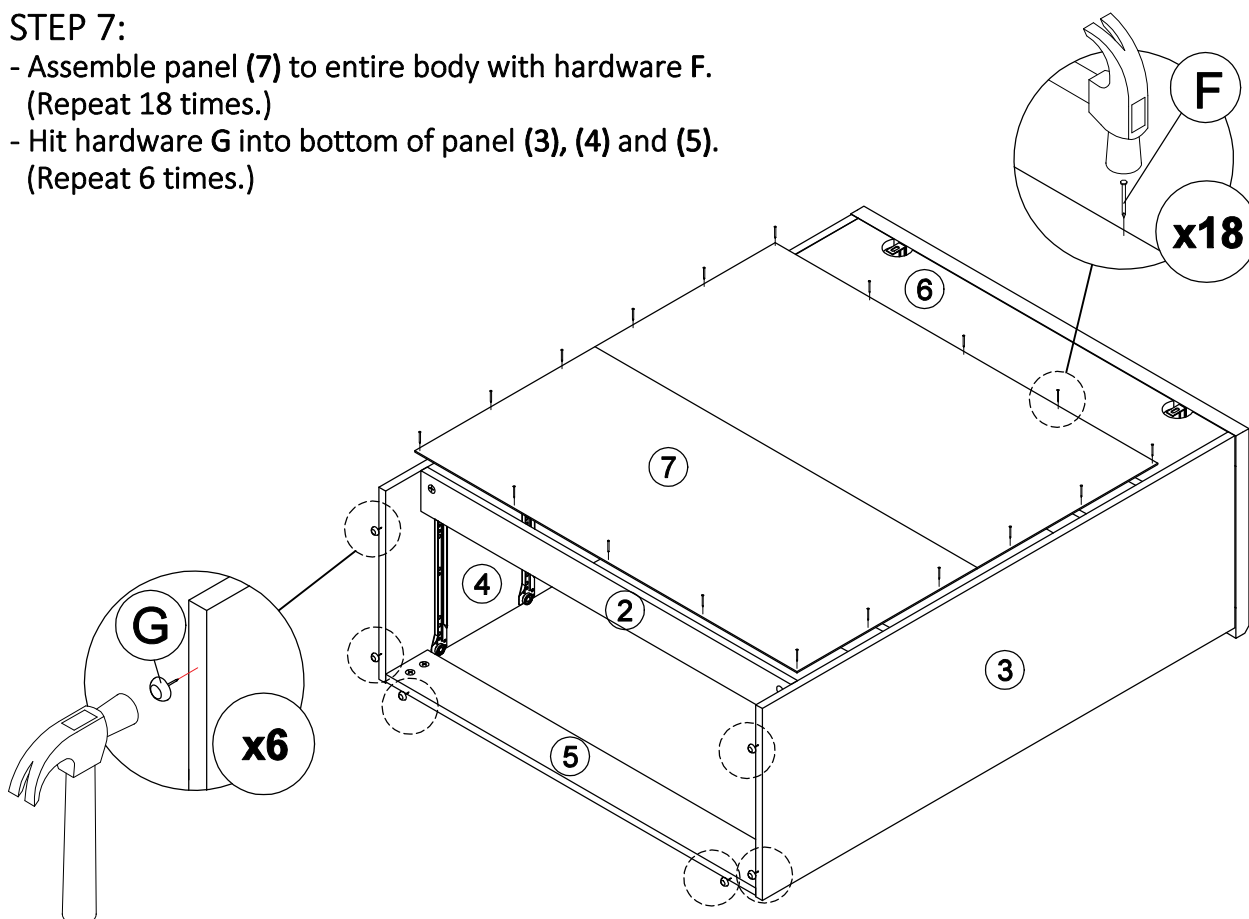
STEP 6:

- Attach panel (1) to panel (3), (4) and (6).
- Insert all hardware A2 into A1.
- Rotate all A1 until tight.
- Apply A3 onto all A1.
- (Repeat 6 times.)



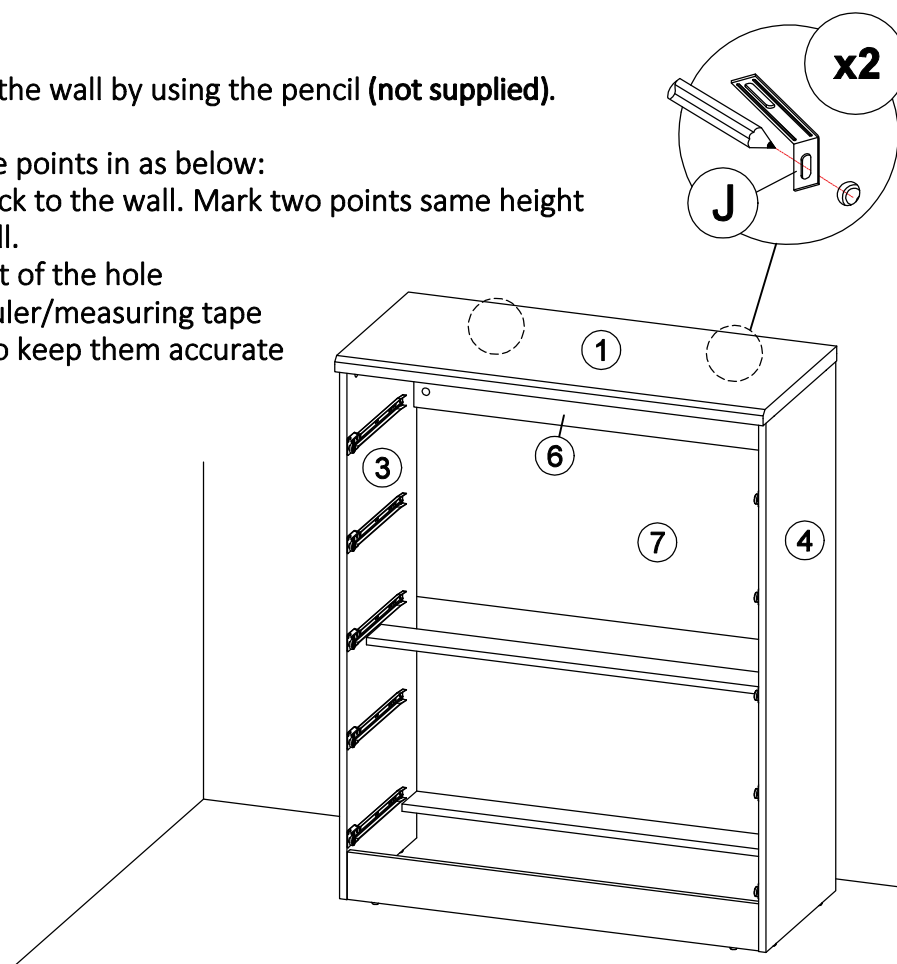
STEP 7:

- Assemble panel (7) to entire body with hardware F.
(Repeat 18 times.)
- Hit hardware G into bottom of panel (3), (4) and (5).
(Repeat 6 times.)



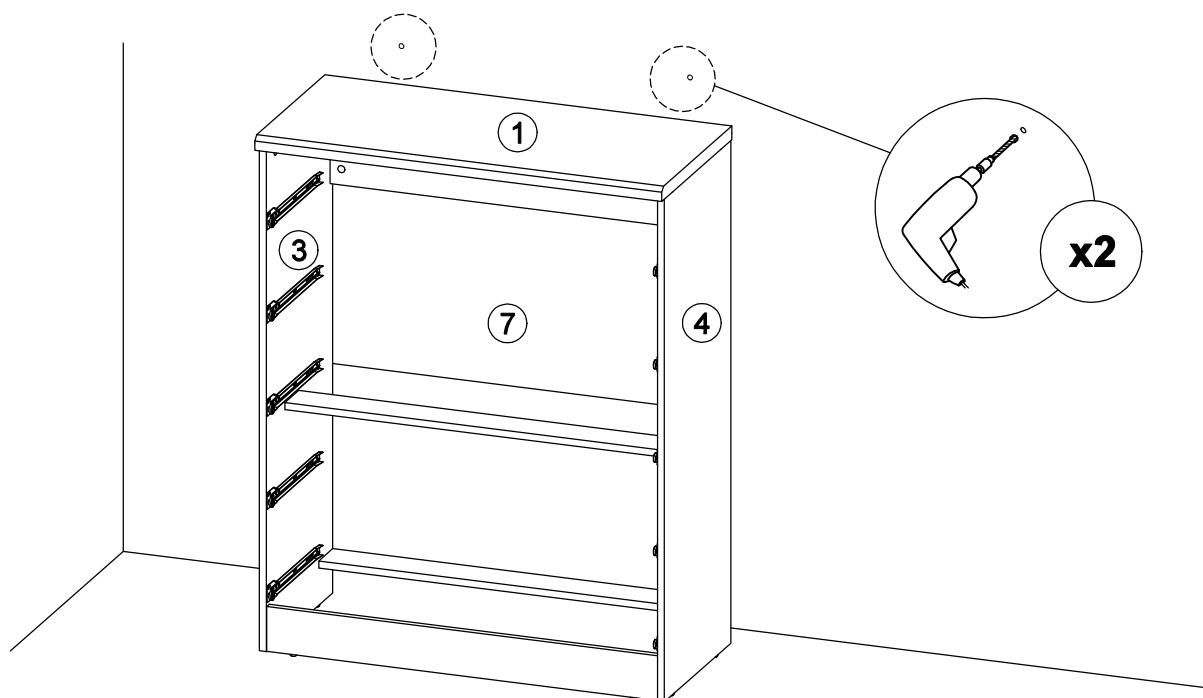
STEP 8:

- Mark the holes on the wall by using the pencil (not supplied).
(Repeat 2 times.)
- You can mark these points in as below:
 - 1) Move the Chest back to the wall. Mark two points same height as Chest on the wall.
 - 2) Measure the height of the hole on panel (6) with ruler/measuring tape and mark on wall to keep them accurate and same height.



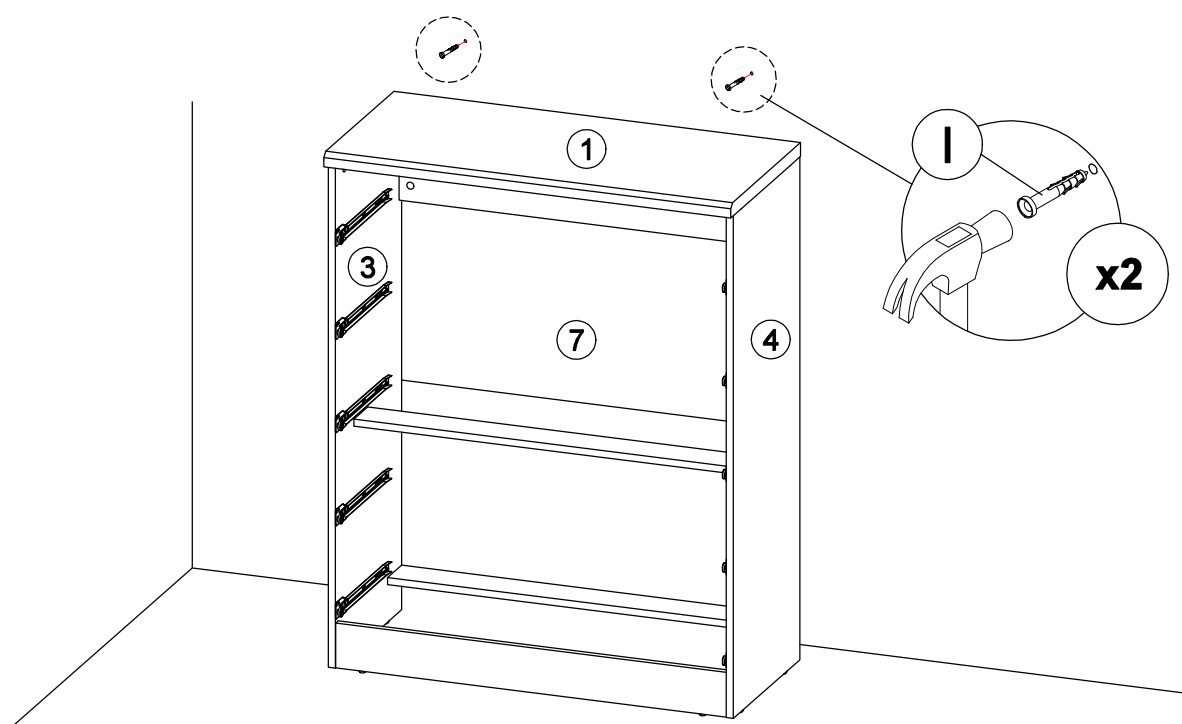
STEP 9:

- Use the power drill to drill the marking point on the wall.



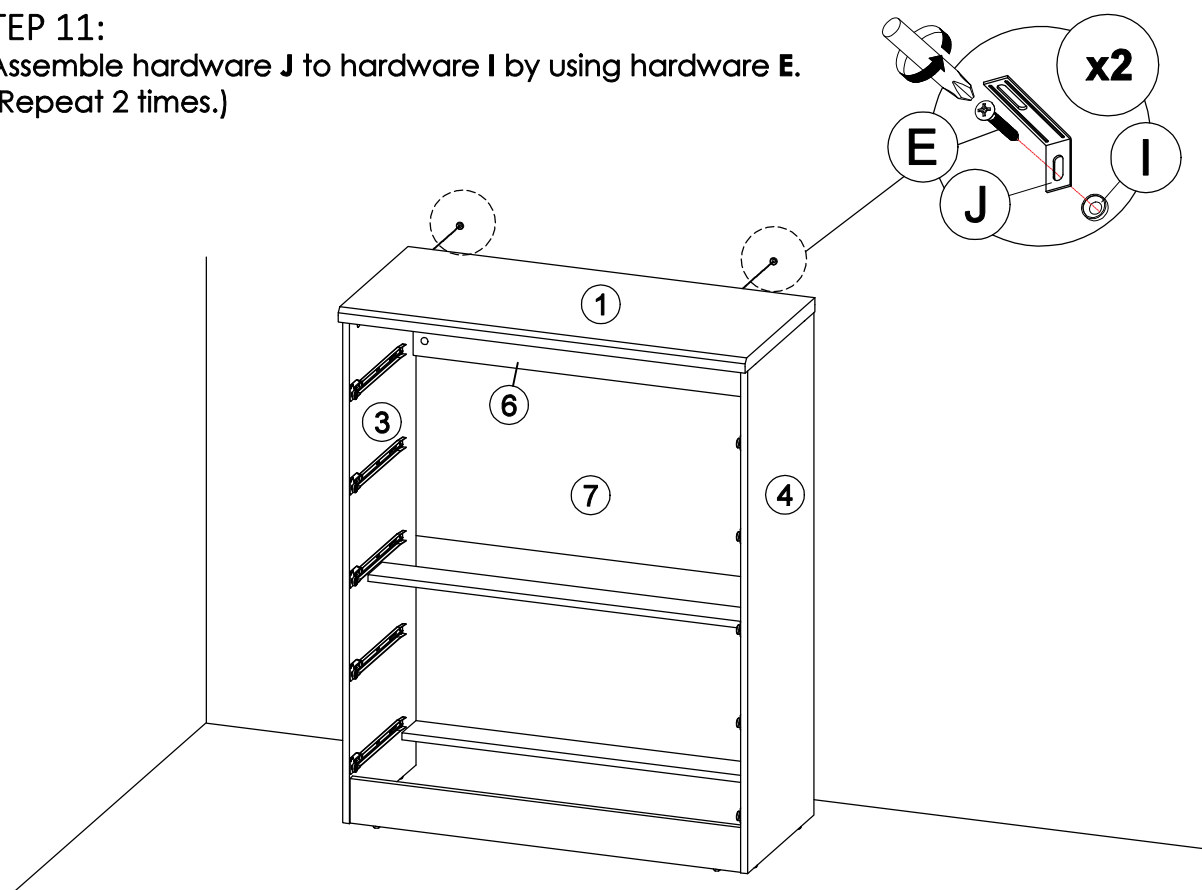
STEP 10:

- Hit hardware I into the wall.
(Repeat 2 times.)



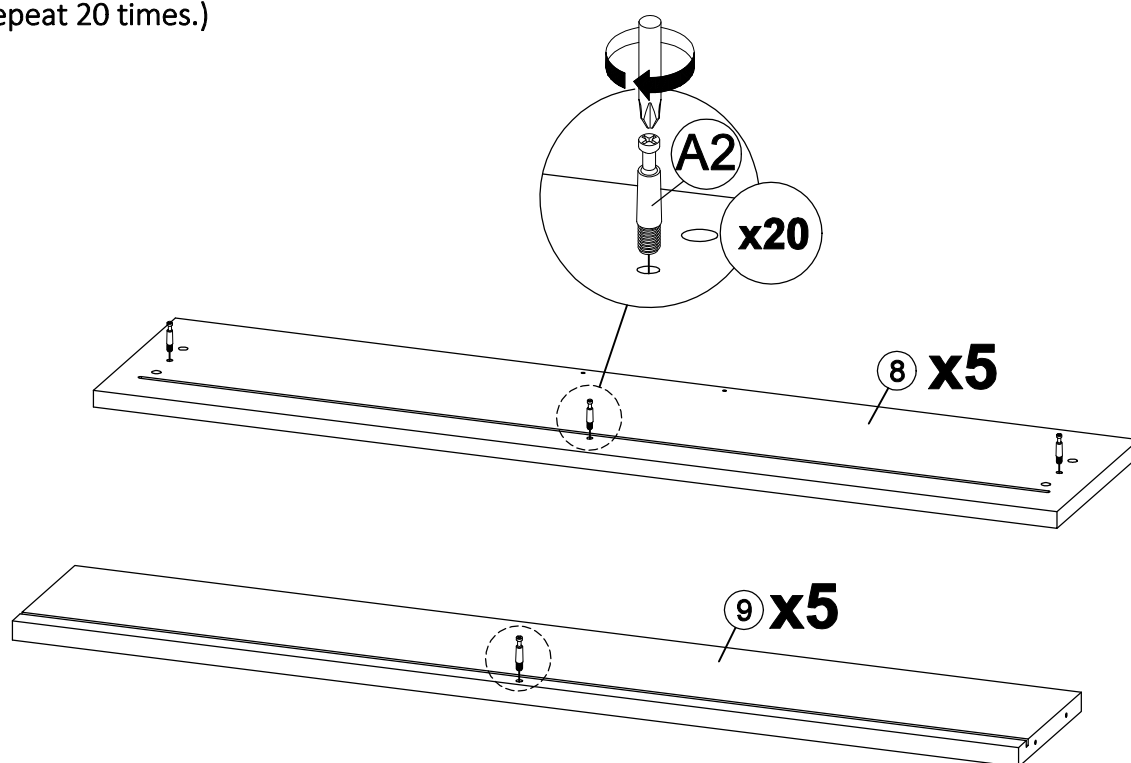
STEP 11:

- Assemble hardware **J** to hardware **I** by using hardware **E**.
(Repeat 2 times.)



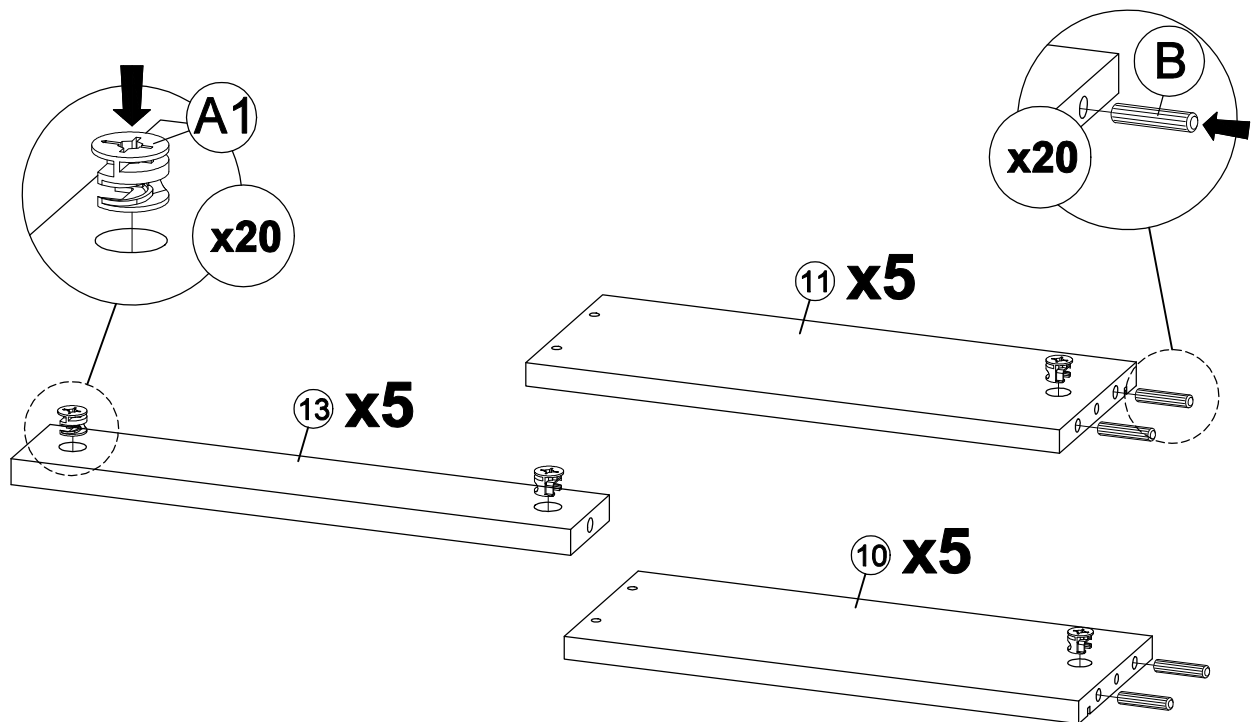
STEP 12:

- Insert hardware **A2** onto panel (8) and (9).
(Repeat 20 times.)



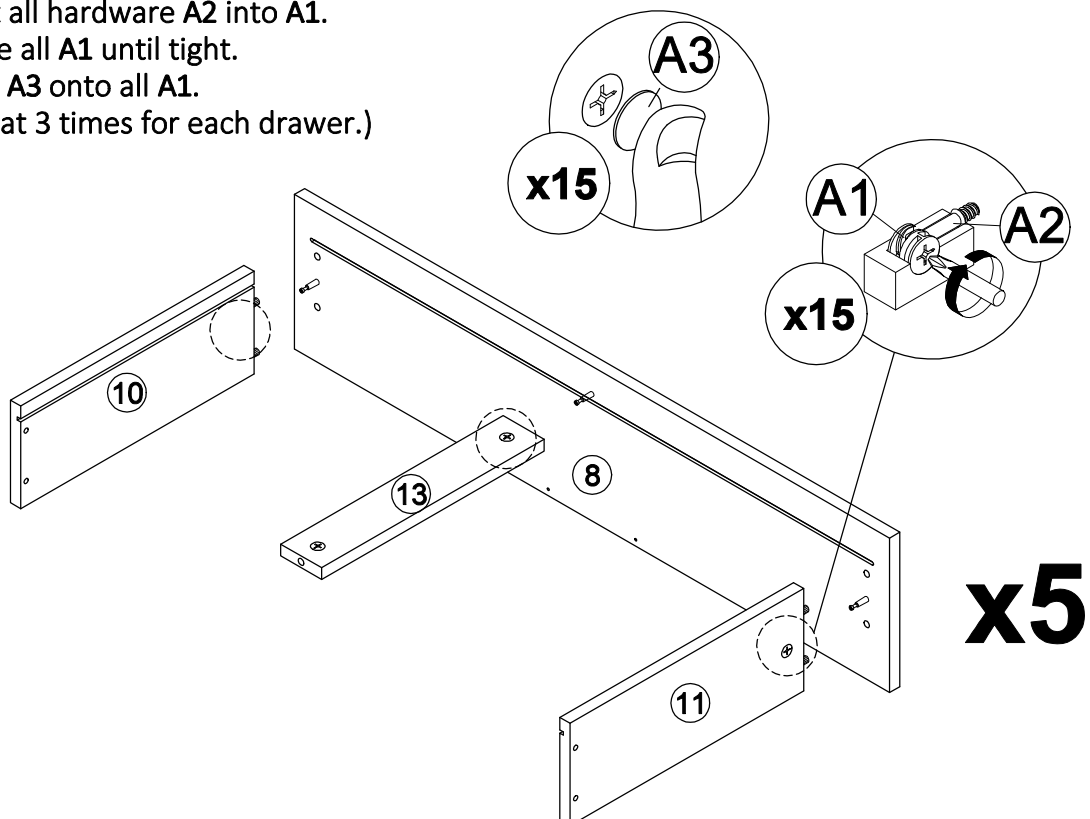
STEP 13:

- Insert hardware **A1** onto panel (10), (11) and (13).
(Repeat 20 times.)
- Insert hardware **B** onto panel (10), (11) and (13).
(Repeat 20 times.)



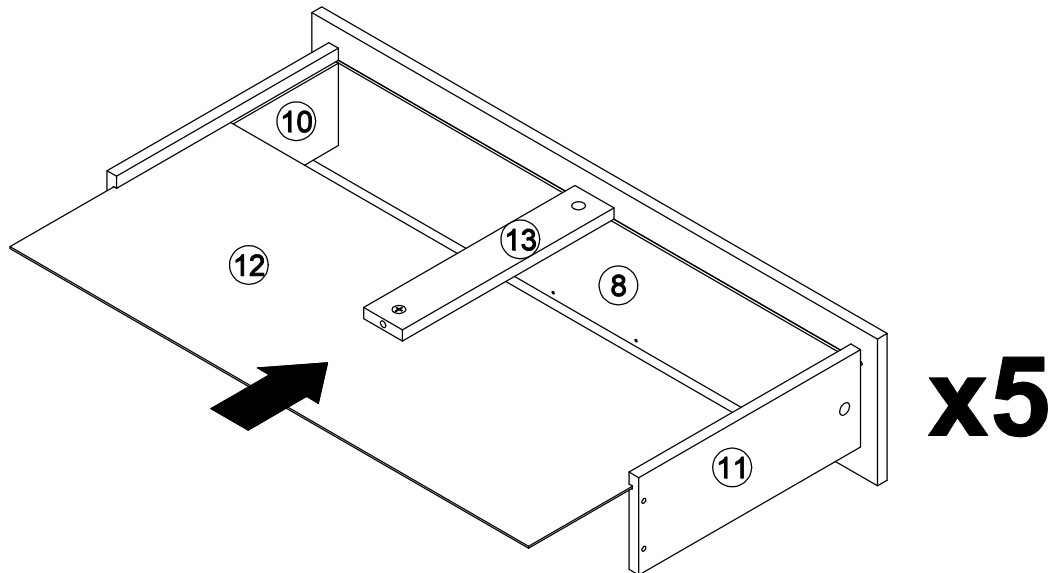
STEP 14:

- Attach panel (8) to panel (10), (11) and (13).
- Insert all hardware **A2** into **A1**.
- Rotate all **A1** until tight.
- Apply **A3** onto all **A1**.
(Repeat 3 times for each drawer.)



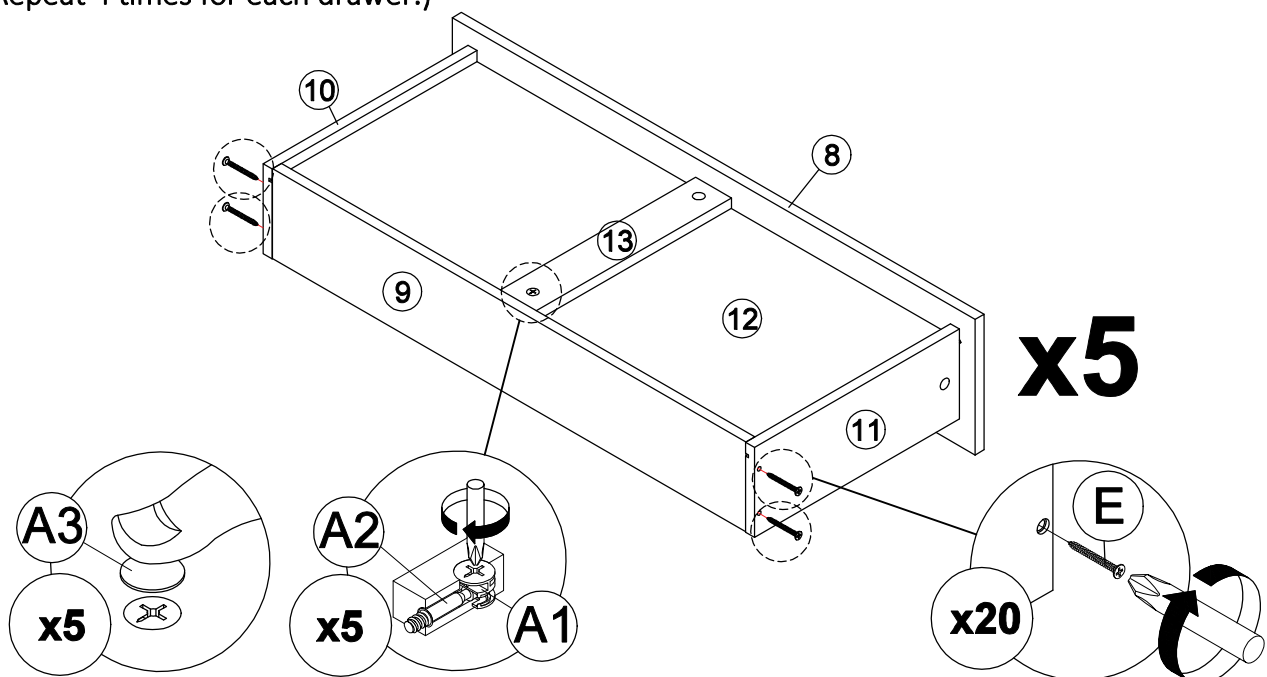
STEP 15:

- Insert panel (12) along the slot.
(Repeat 1 times for each drawer.)



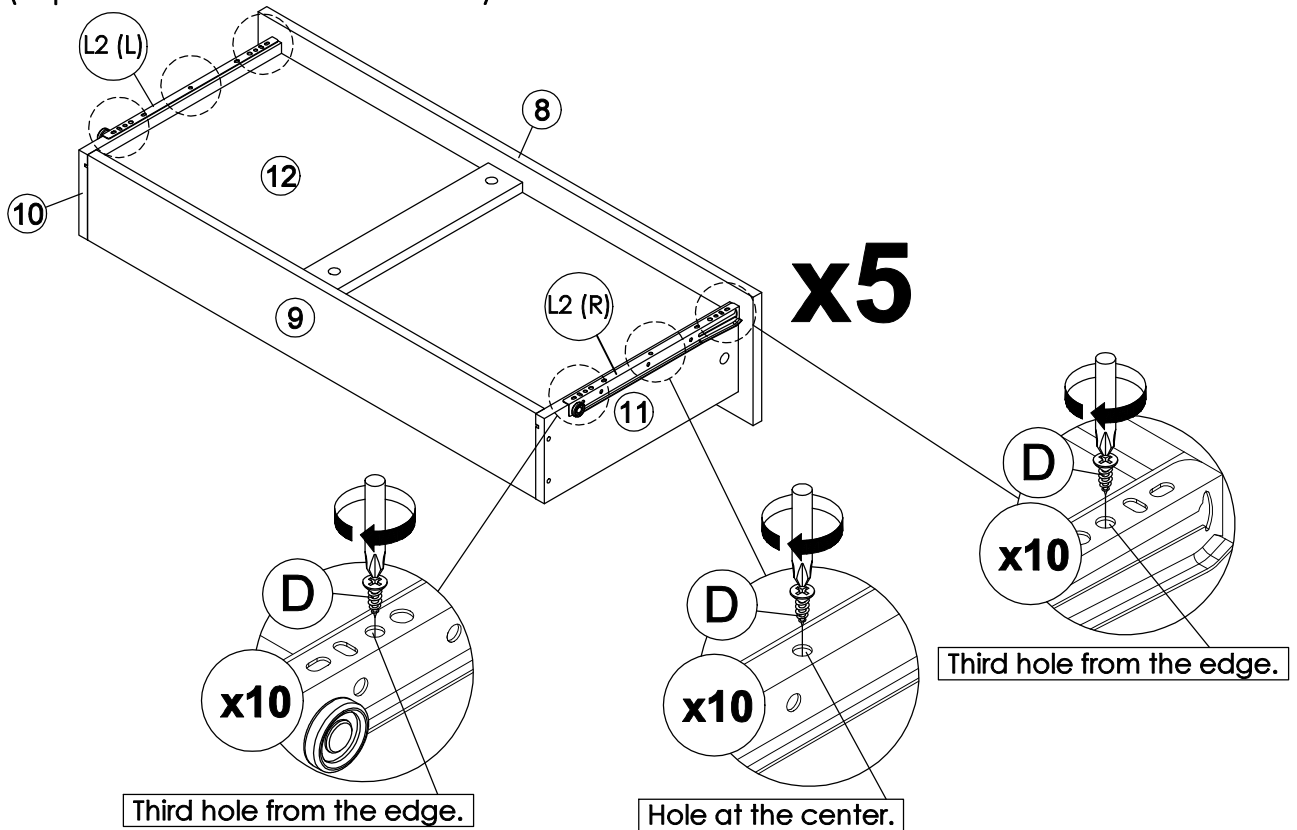
STEP 16:

- Attach panel (9) to panel (13).
- Insert all hardware A2 into A1.
- Rotate all A1 until tight.
- Apply A3 onto all A1.
- Assemble panel (9) with panel (10) and (11) by using hardware E.
(Repeat 4 times for each drawer.)



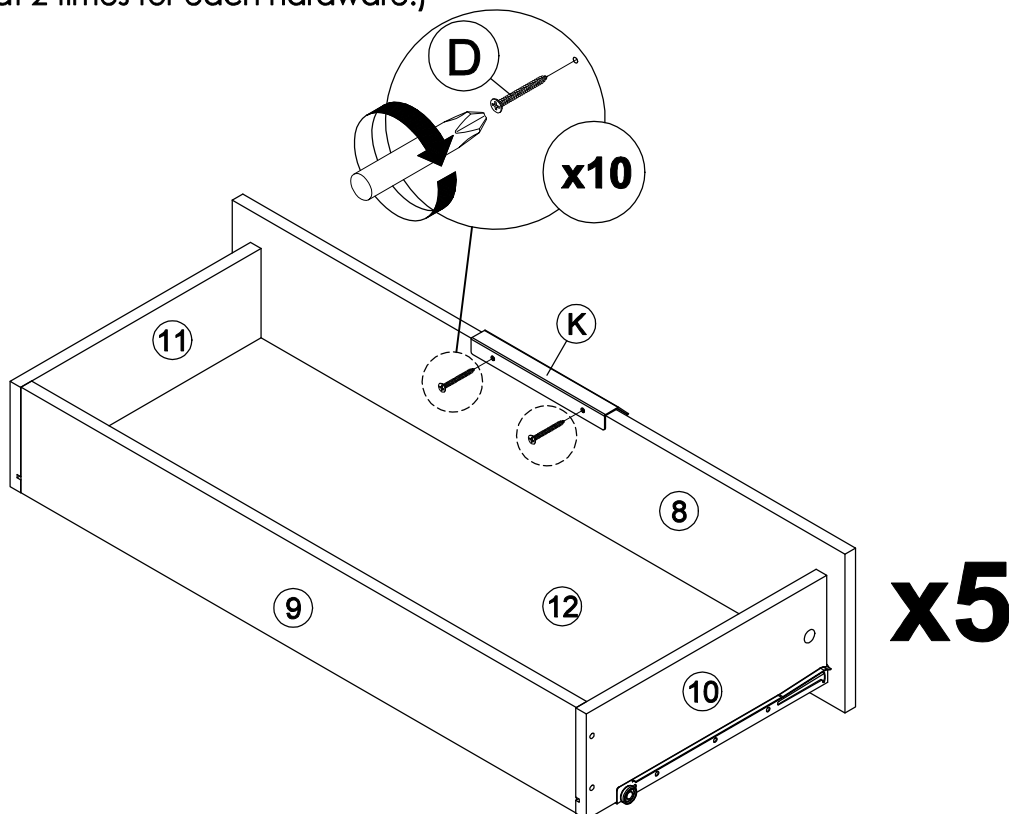
STEP 17:

- Assemble hardware **L2 (L/R)** to panel **(10)** and **(11)** by using hardware **D**.
(Repeat 3 times for each hardware.)



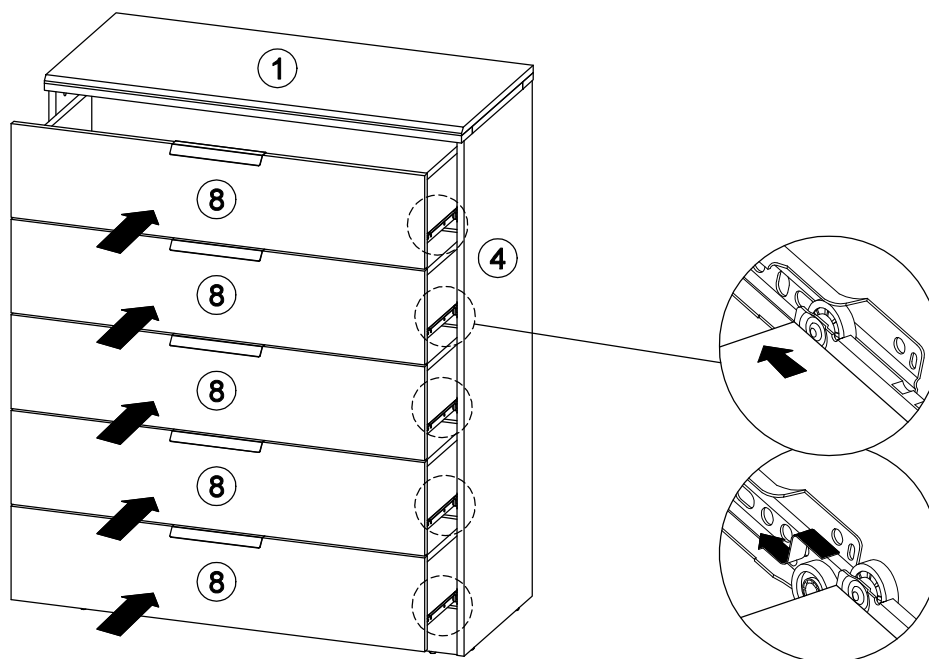
STEP 18:

- Fix hardware **K** onto panel **(8)** by using hardware **D**.
(Repeat 2 times for each hardware.)

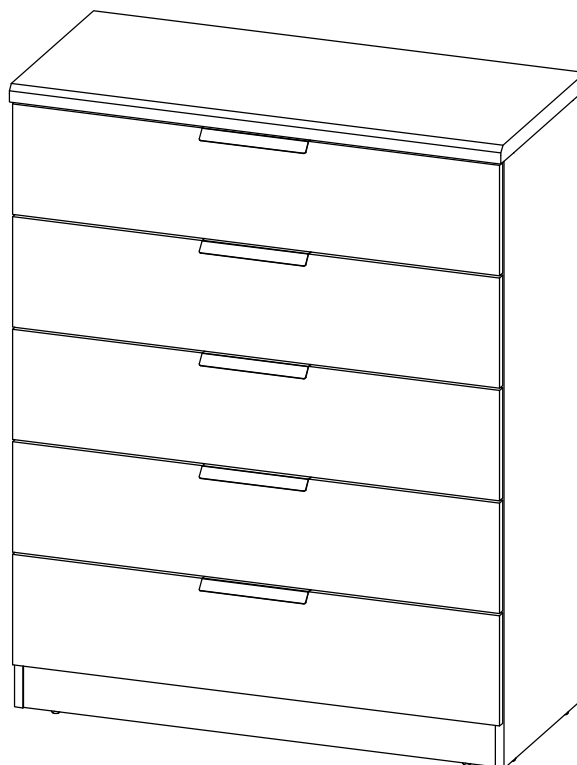


STEP 19:

- Put all the drawer in place along the drawer slides.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To protect your furniture, we suggest the following :

- Avoid placing your furniture in direct sunlight.
- Do not place furniture directly under window.
- Do not place sharp materials (knife, fork, etc.) directly onto your furniture as sharp material may scrape and damage the finish.
- Do not place material with high temperature directly onto the surface of your furniture.
- Clean up spills quickly. Water left over a prolonged period of time may cause damage. Alcohol, perfume, nail polishes, aftershave and some medication may cause server finish damage if not cleaned immediately.
- Use a clean, soft, dry, lint free absorbent cloth to clean your furniture. Do not use any detergent as they may contain ingredients that may react and damage the finish.
