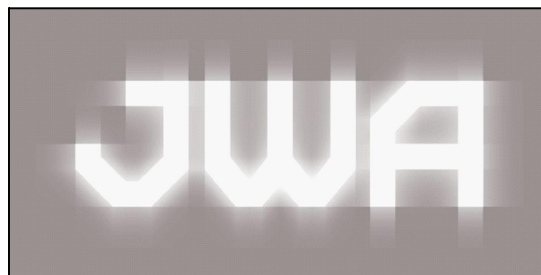
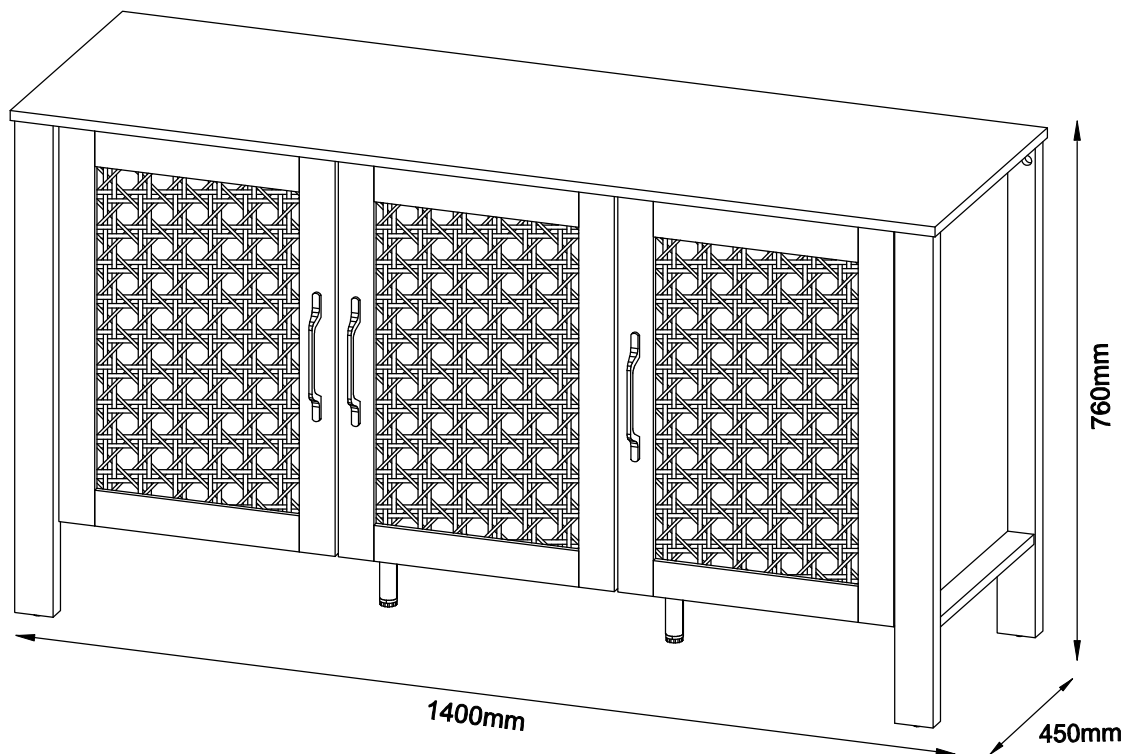

PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

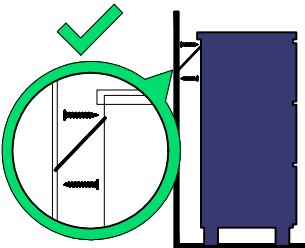
Before you start:

10. Please keep the instructions for future reference.

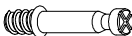
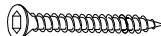
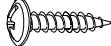
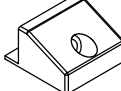
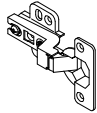
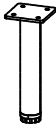
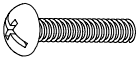

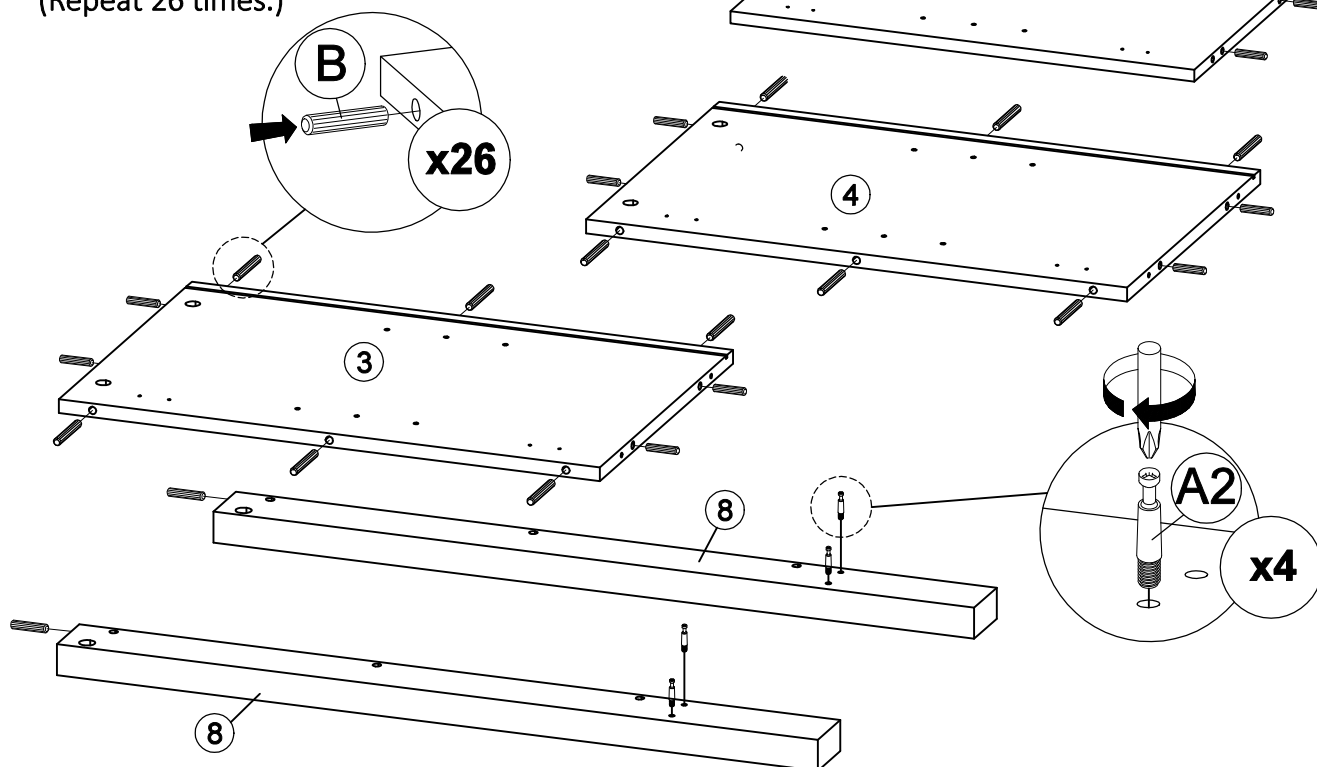
STEP 2:

- Insert hardware A2 into panel (1) and (7).
(Repeat 16 times.)
- Insert hardware B into panel (5) and (7).
(Repeat 6 times.)



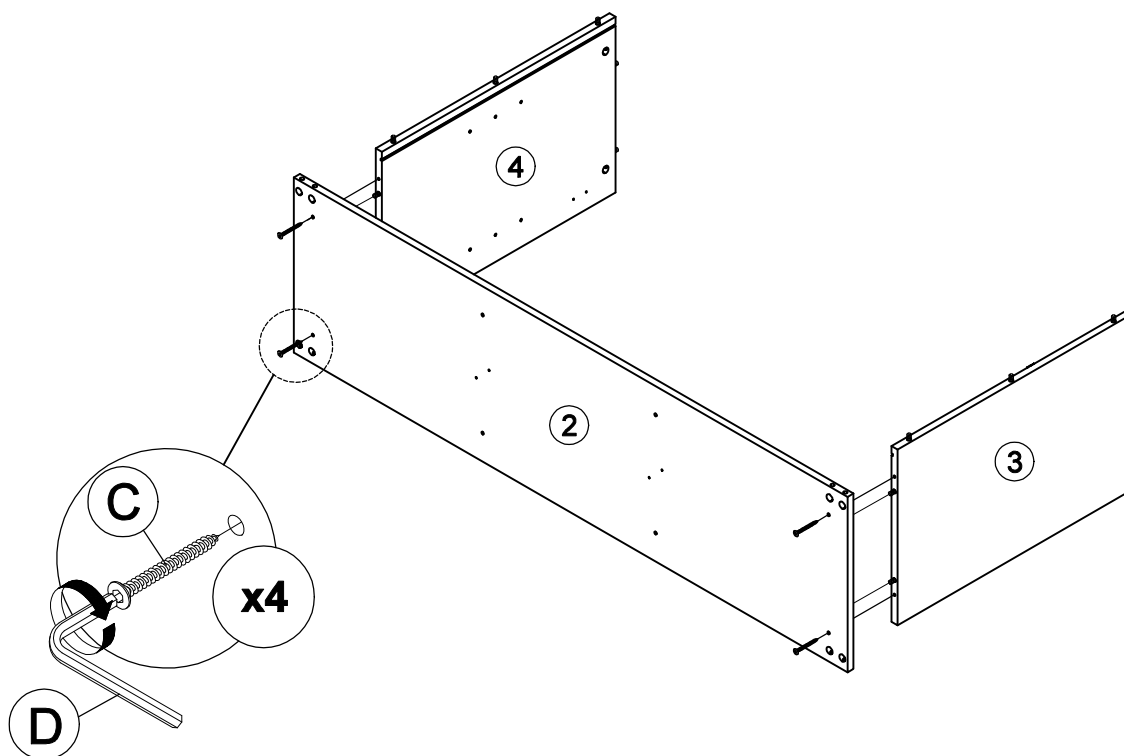
STEP 2:

- Insert hardware A2 into panel (8).
(Repeat 4 times.)
- Insert hardware B into panel (3), (4), (6) and (8).
(Repeat 26 times.)



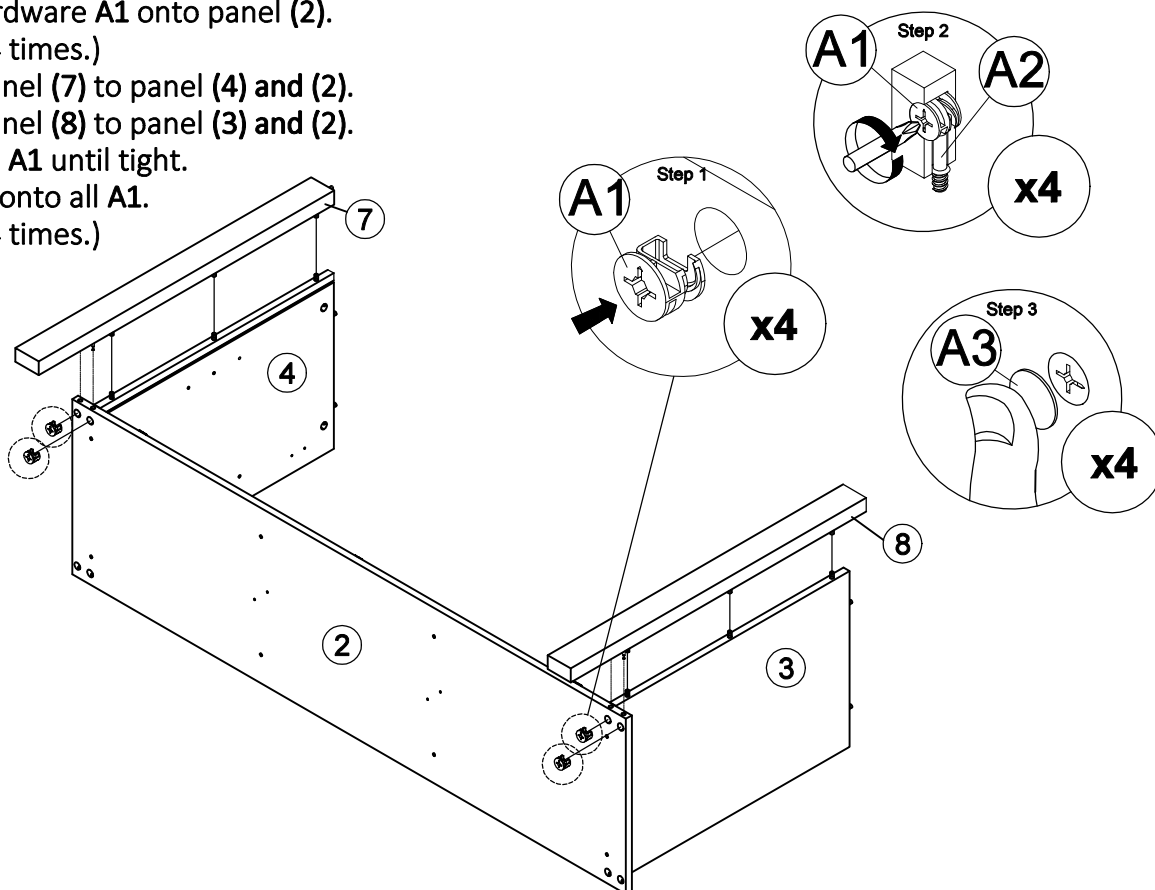
STEP 3:

- Connect panel (2) to panel (3) and (4) by using hardware C and D.
(Repeat 4 times)



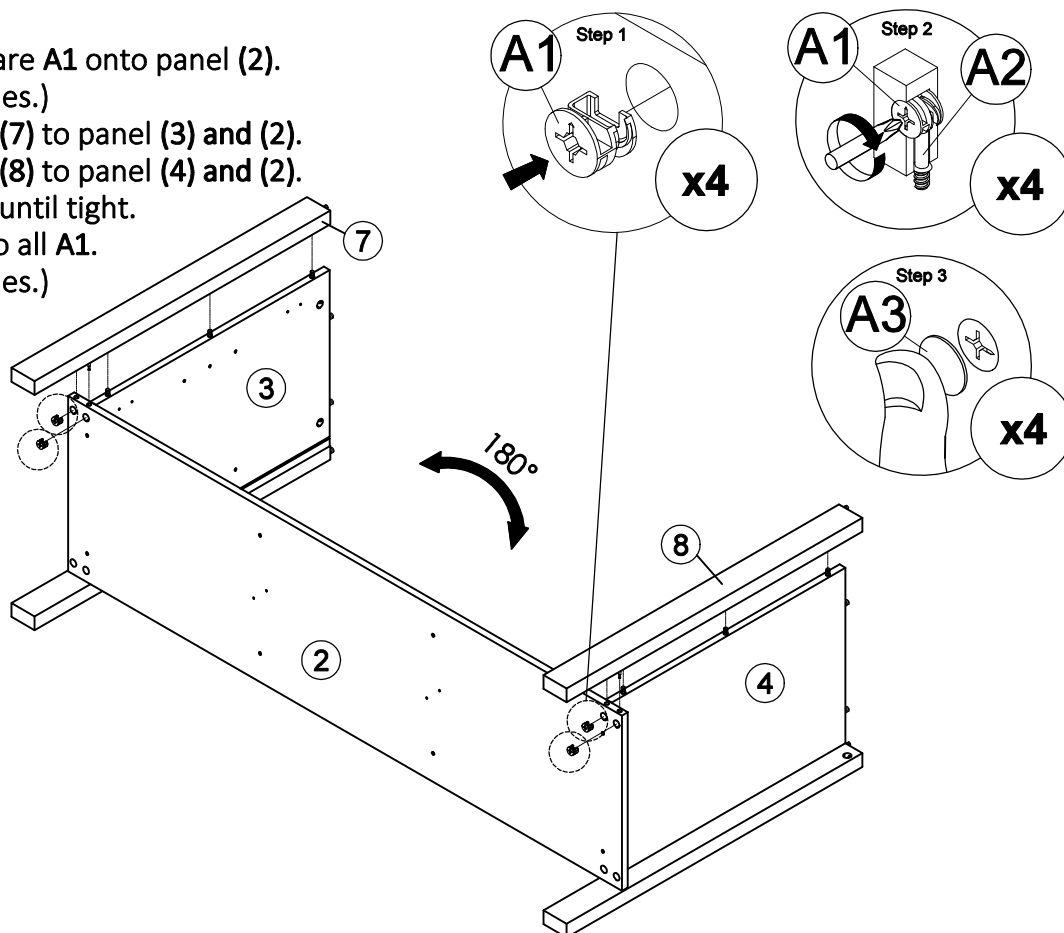
STEP 4:

- Insert hardware **A1** onto panel (2).
(Repeat 4 times.)
- Attach panel (7) to panel (4) and (2).
- Attach panel (8) to panel (3) and (2).
- Rotate all **A1** until tight.
- Apply **A3** onto all **A1**.
(Repeat 4 times.)



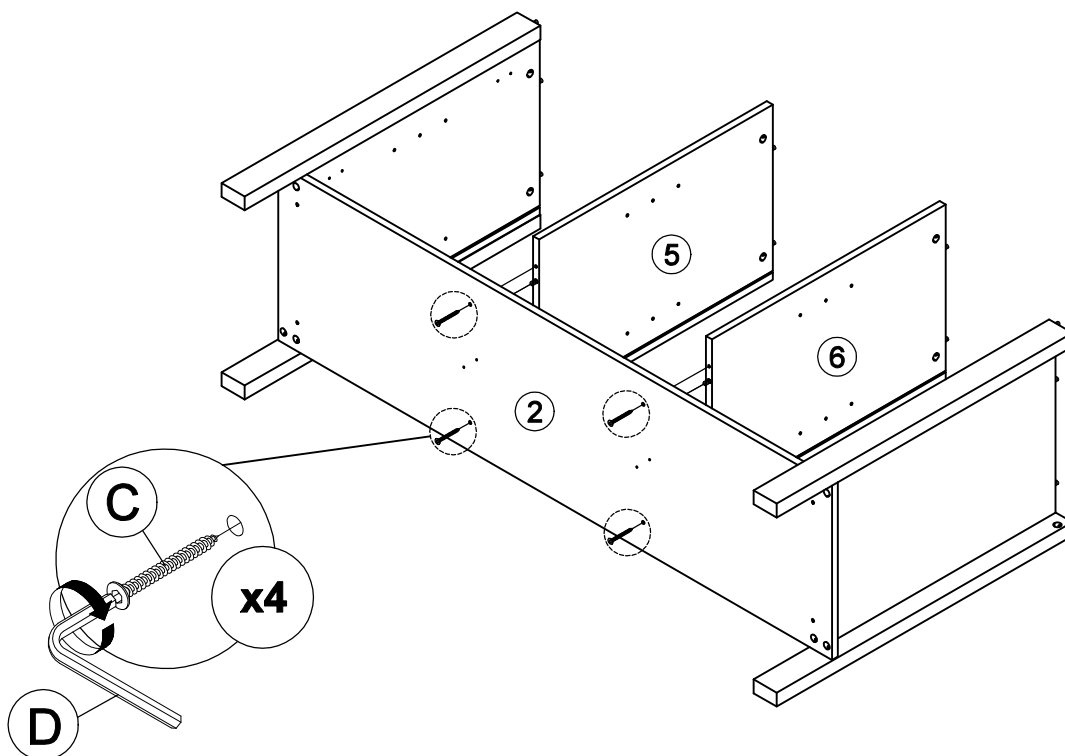
STEP 5:

- Insert hardware **A1** onto panel (2).
(Repeat 4 times.)
- Attach panel (7) to panel (3) and (2).
- Attach panel (8) to panel (4) and (2).
- Rotate all **A1** until tight.
- Apply **A3** onto all **A1**.
(Repeat 4 times.)



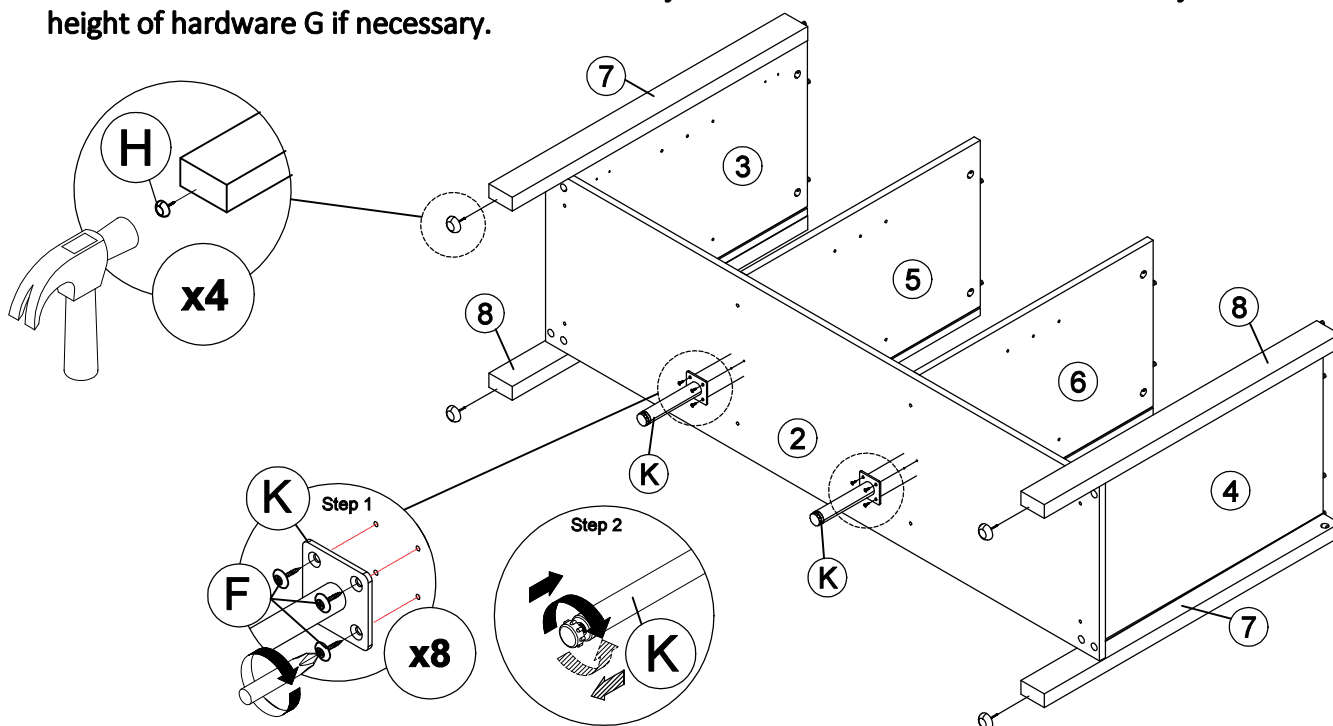
STEP 6:

- Connect panel (2) to panel (5) and (6) by using hardware C and D.
(Repeat 4 times)



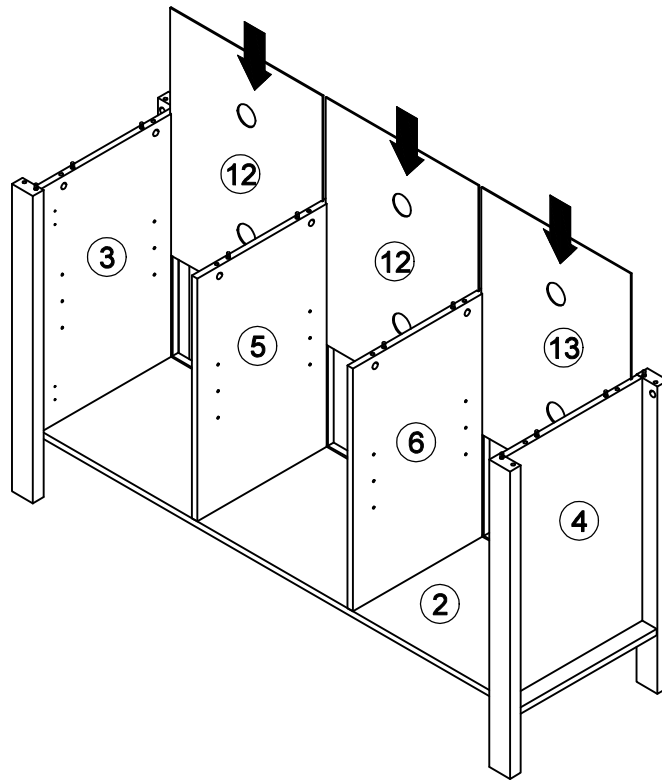
STEP 7:

- Hit hardware H into bottom of panel (7) and (8).
(Repeat 4 times.)
- Fix hardware K onto panel (2) by using hardware screw F.
(Repeat 4 times for each hardware.)
- * Please note that the hardware G has a Plastic adjuster at the bottom to unscrew and adjust the height of hardware G if necessary.



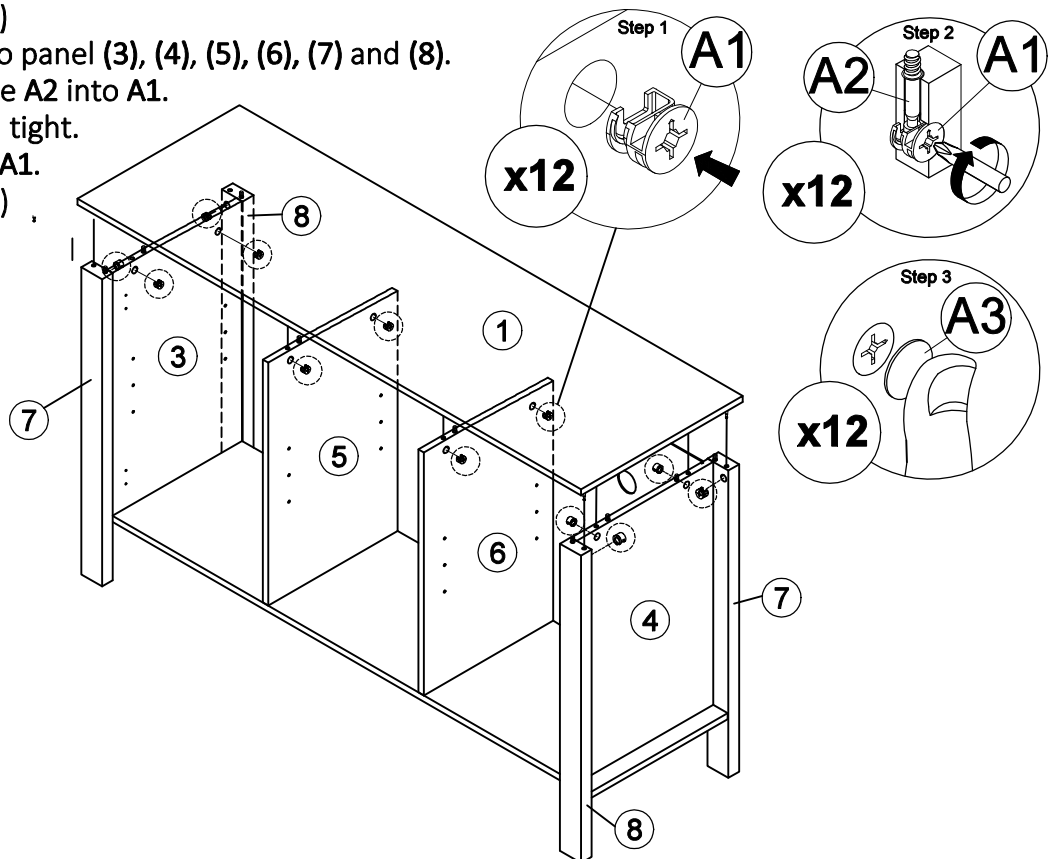
STEP 8:

- Insert the panel (12) and (13) along the slot.
(Repeat 3 times.)



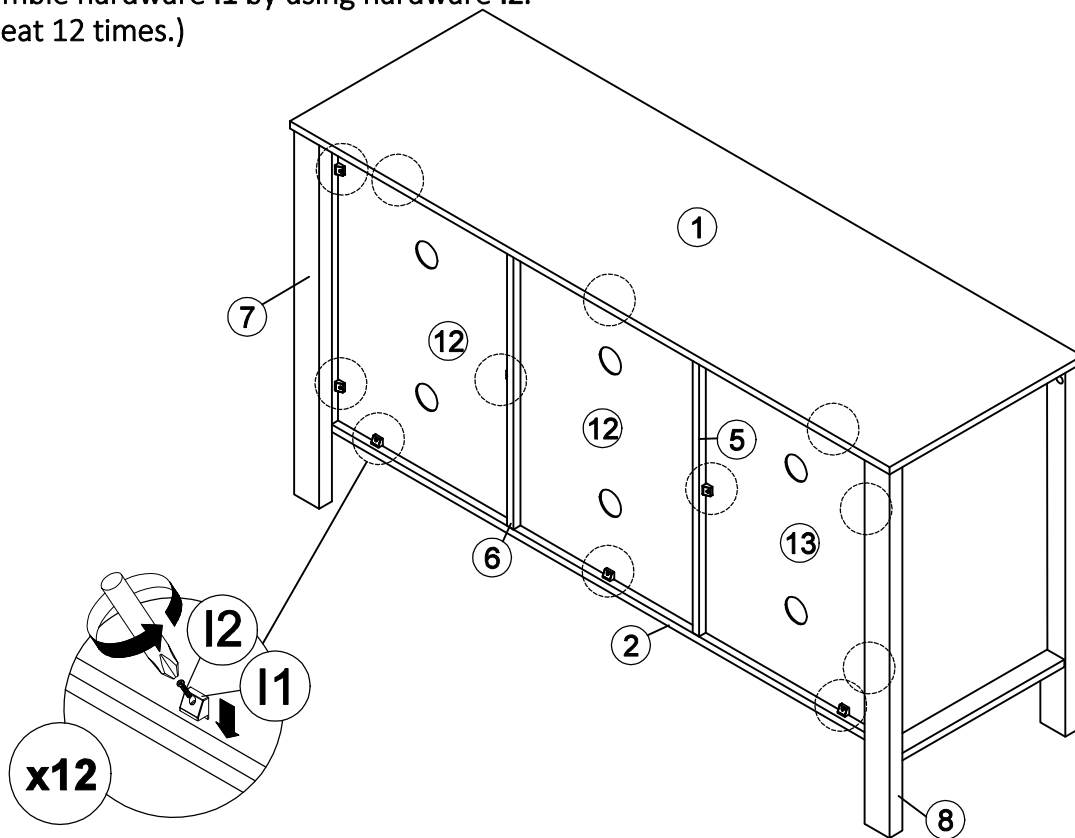
STEP 9:

- Insert hardware A1 onto panel (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) and (8).
(Repeat 12 times.)
- Attach panel (1) to panel (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) and (8).
- Insert all hardware A2 into A1.
- Rotate all A1 until tight.
- Apply A3 onto all A1.
(Repeat 12 times.)



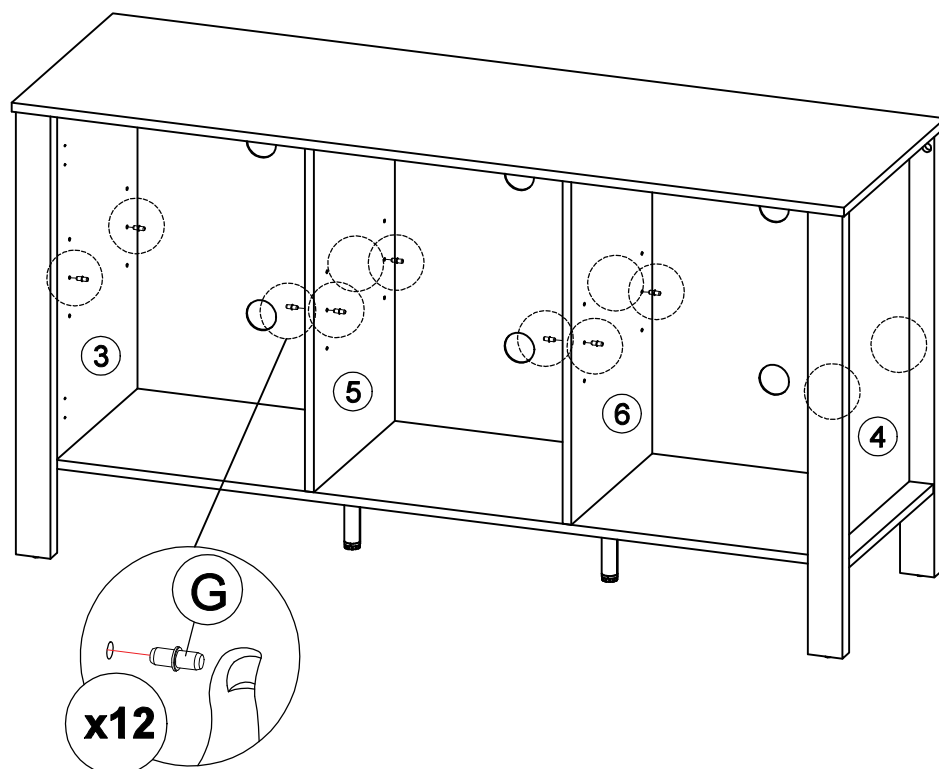
STEP 10:

- Insert hardware I1 into slot at panel (1), (2), (5), (6), (7) and (8).
- Assemble hardware I1 by using hardware I2.
- (Repeat 12 times.)



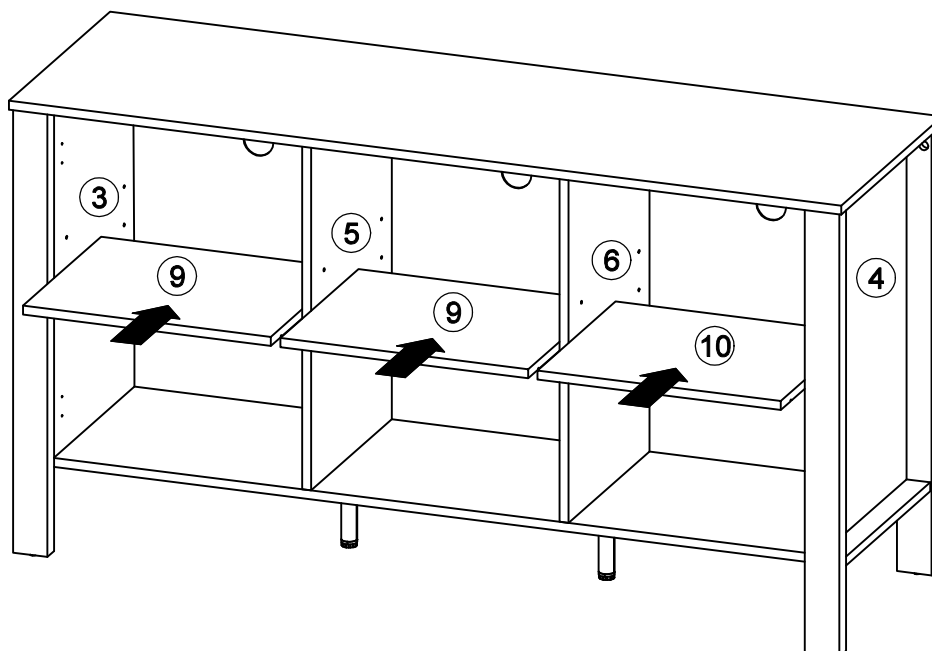
STEP 11:

- Insert hardware G into mounting positions on panel (3), (4), (5) and (6) by hand.
- (Repeat 12 times.)



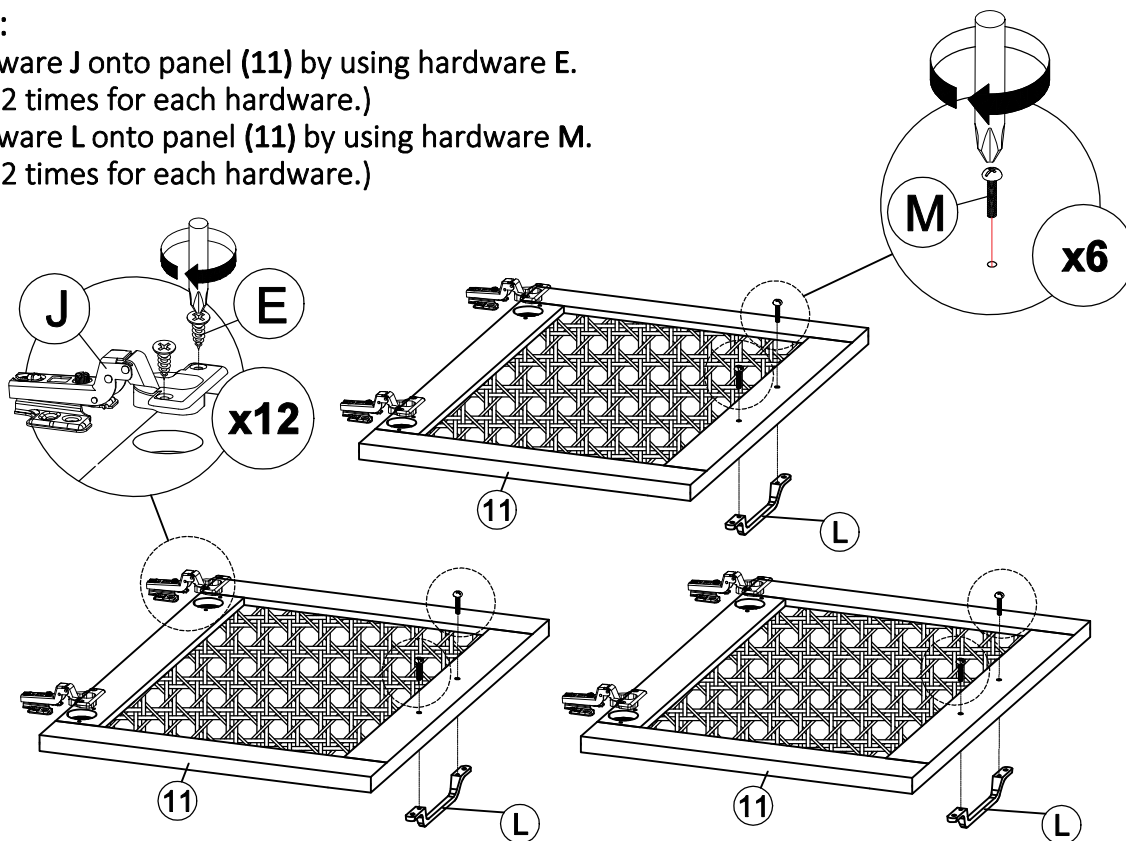
STEP 12:

- Assemble panel (9) into between panel (3) and (5).
(Repeat 1 times.)
- Assemble panel (9) into between panel (5) and (6).
(Repeat 1 times.)
- Assemble panel (10) into between panel (6) and (4).
(Repeat 1 times.)



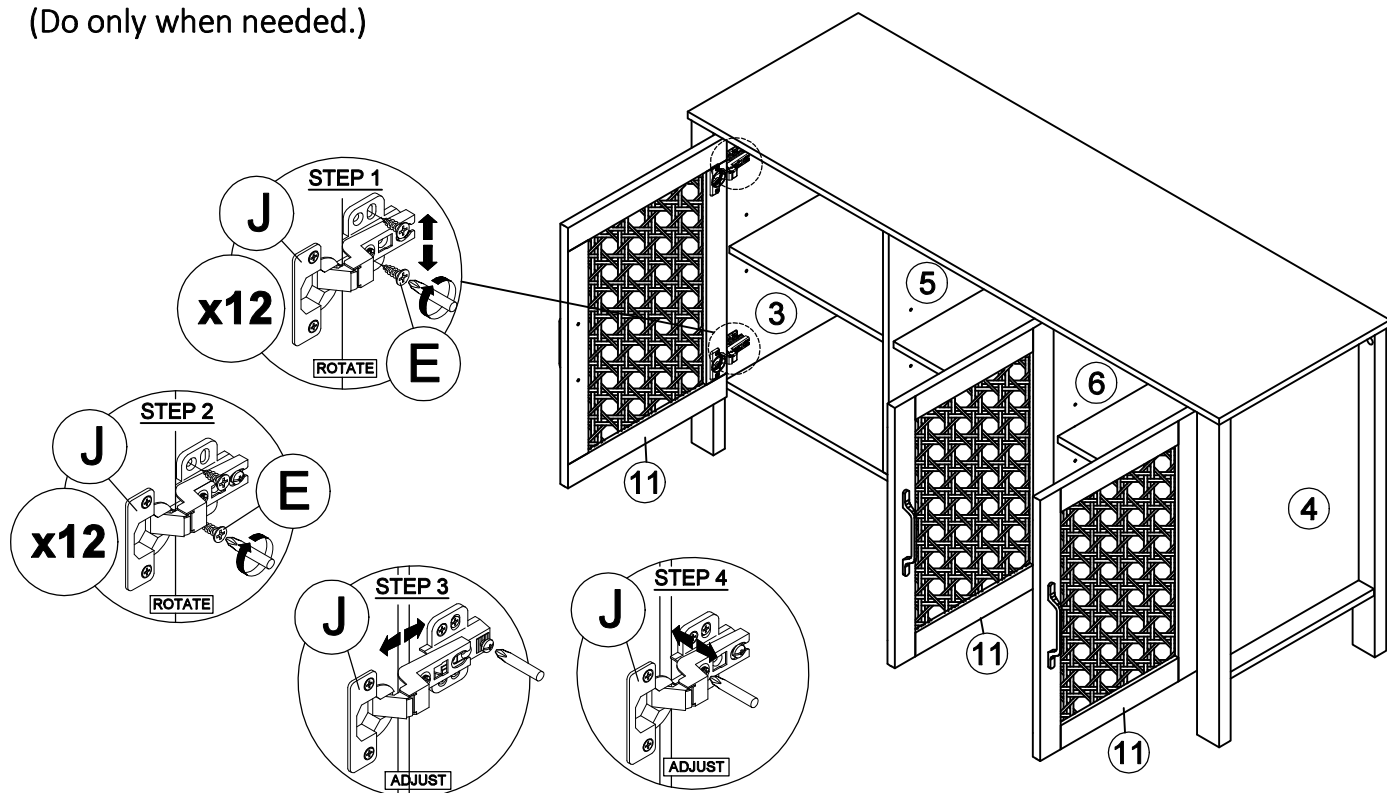
STEP 13:

- Fix hardware J onto panel (11) by using hardware E.
(Repeat 2 times for each hardware.)
- Fix hardware L onto panel (11) by using hardware M.
(Repeat 2 times for each hardware.)

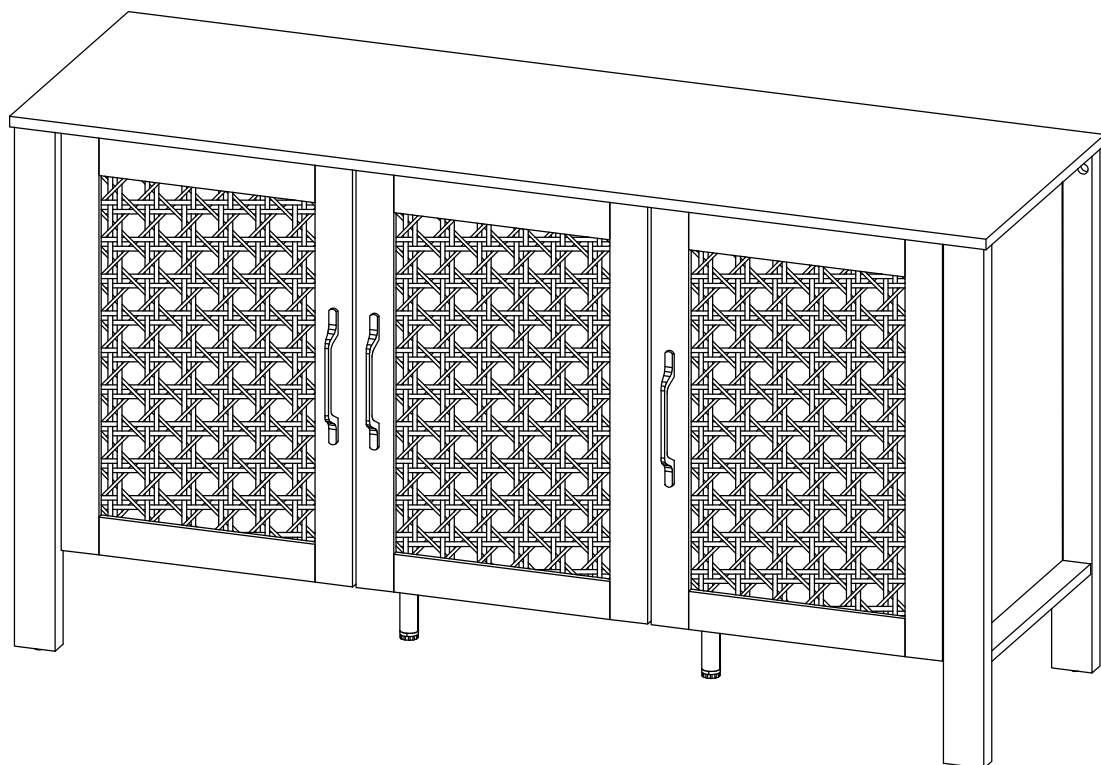


STEP 14:

- Fix hardware J into panel (3), (4) and (6) by using hardware E.
(Repeat 4 times for each hardware.)
- Tighten or loosen the screw to adjust position of panel (11).
(Do only when needed.)

SAFETY BRACKETS INSTRUCTIONS

1. Attach one Metal Bracket to the wall with the Wall Screw. Make sure to attach the Metal Bracket into a stud. If mounting into brick or masonry you will need to acquire wall anchors.
2. Attach the second Metal Bracket to the back of furniture frame with the Pan Head Screws.
3. Move the furniture to its final position. Thread a Cable Tie through the both Metal Bracket and tighten until snug. Do not over tighten.
4. Make sure that the Metal Bracket are firmly attached to the wall and furniture and that the Cable Tie is snug.

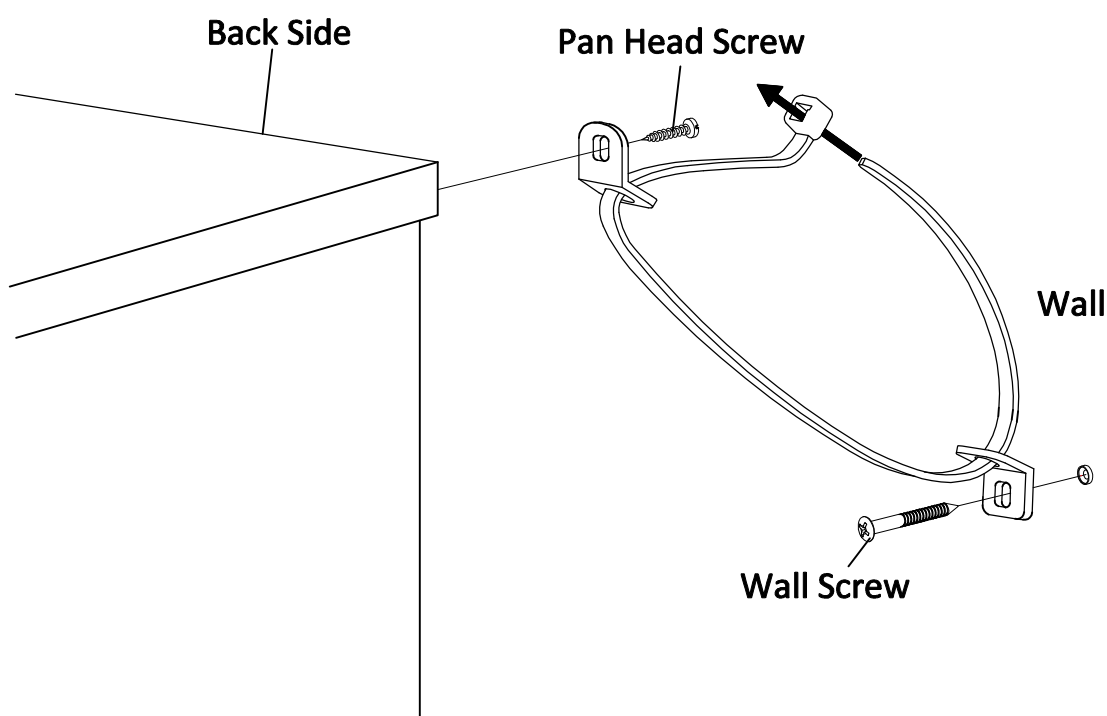

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To protect your furniture, we suggest the following :

- Avoid placing your furniture in direct sunlight.
- Do not place furniture directly under window.
- Do not place sharp materials (knife, fork, etc.) directly onto your furniture as sharp material may scrape and damage the finish.
- Do not place material with high temperature directly onto the surface of your furniture.
- Clean up spills quickly. Water left over a prolonged period of time may cause damage. Alcohol, perfume, nail polishes, aftershave and some medication may cause server finish damage if not cleaned immediately.
- Use a clean, soft, dry, lint free absorbent cloth to clean your furniture. Do not use any detergent as they may contain ingredients that may react and damage the finish.
